Owing to the decayed condition of the Book of Presentments (1768) the paper was extremely fragile and liable to break on lifting: indeed many fragments were already separated and lying loose. For this reason it was necessary to unbind the volume and to repair it almost leaf by leaf so that none of the loose fragments might be misplaced or lost.

When paper decays through age, damp or exposure it is the 'size' which holds the particles of paper together that goes and an important part of the repair process is to strengthen the paper again.

As the folios were separated, the stronger ones were immersed in hot size and hung upon lines to dry.

This process cleaned and stiffened them before repair work was begun. Those too fragile to stand such treatment were first mounted on gauze and afterwards painted with size.

Here is the process by which a typical decayed and fragile folio was repaired:

The folio was laid on dampened glass, sponged lightly with cold water and flattened evenly with a spatula. Any turned-back part of the edges or around holes in the paper were moved into position by means of a palette knife. When all the creases were removed a piece of silk gauze, slightly larger than the page was placed over it and pasted to it with freshly made paste. (This gauze was specially made in France for the Academy). The folio was then gradually lifted from the glass (care being taken that the under surface of the paper did not cling). It was replaced with the gauze underneath and again pressed flat on

the glass. At this stage the folio was regarded as safe to handle and could be repaired. Any fragments of the pages which had been found missing from their places were now traced, if possible, and pasted in to where they belonged. It was usually the edges and centre of the folio which had perished most and to repair these thick Jap paper was pasted on to the gauze. This is a special paper made of the fibres of the rice plant. It comes from Japan and is now very difficult to obtain. Fine transparent Jap was used to join together tears through portions of the pages covered by writing. To bring up any holes and missing portions at the edges to the thickness of the original paper and to strengthen the edges and centre, the folio had then to be turned over again on the dampened glass, and the thick Jap paper pasted on accordingly. The folio was then peeled off the glass and hung on a line to dry. After this it was again laid on the glass, brushed lightly with cold size on the side to which the gauze had not been pasted, and was hung to dry.

When several folios had been repaired in this way they were pressed thus: Each folio was dampened evenly by sponging lightly and then placed between squares of special pressing tissue paper and cardboard. They were put in layers and then the whole was placed between boards in a hand press. After a day they were removed and the process repeated as often as was necessary to remove all creases from the pages. Finally, ragged edges of the repair were trimmed with a scissors, and the folios folded to their original shape and pressed.
