The meeting was specially summoned by direction of the Chairman to consider the Local Government Board's letter of the 25. Nov. 1915 No. L11597. 191:1915. The Local Government Board forwarded with their letter extracts from the report of their Architect, Mr King, on his inspection of the cottages, erected and in course of erection, under the improvement Scheme authorised by the orders of 1912 and pointed out that the seriously defective condition of many of the cottages calls for the immediate and earnest attention of the Council. They also pointed out that according to returns furnished by the Engineer in last August it appeared the cottages were then practically all completed and that in many cases he had certified for payment of the contract amounts in full and they consider the Council should take serious notice of the manner in which this official seems to have carried out his duties.

A copy of this letter with the Report of the L. G. B. Architect had been sent to each member of the Council and also to the Council's Engineer, Mr Kelly.

Mr Kelly appeared before the Council and submitted a report on the defects pointed out by the L. G. B. Architect. On the motion of Mr Vance seconded by Mr Henderson it was decided to send this report to the Local Government Board.

Mr Kelly was directed to measure plot No. 14 in Drumahatty, reported as being 7 perches short and if he finds plot too small to have it made right.
