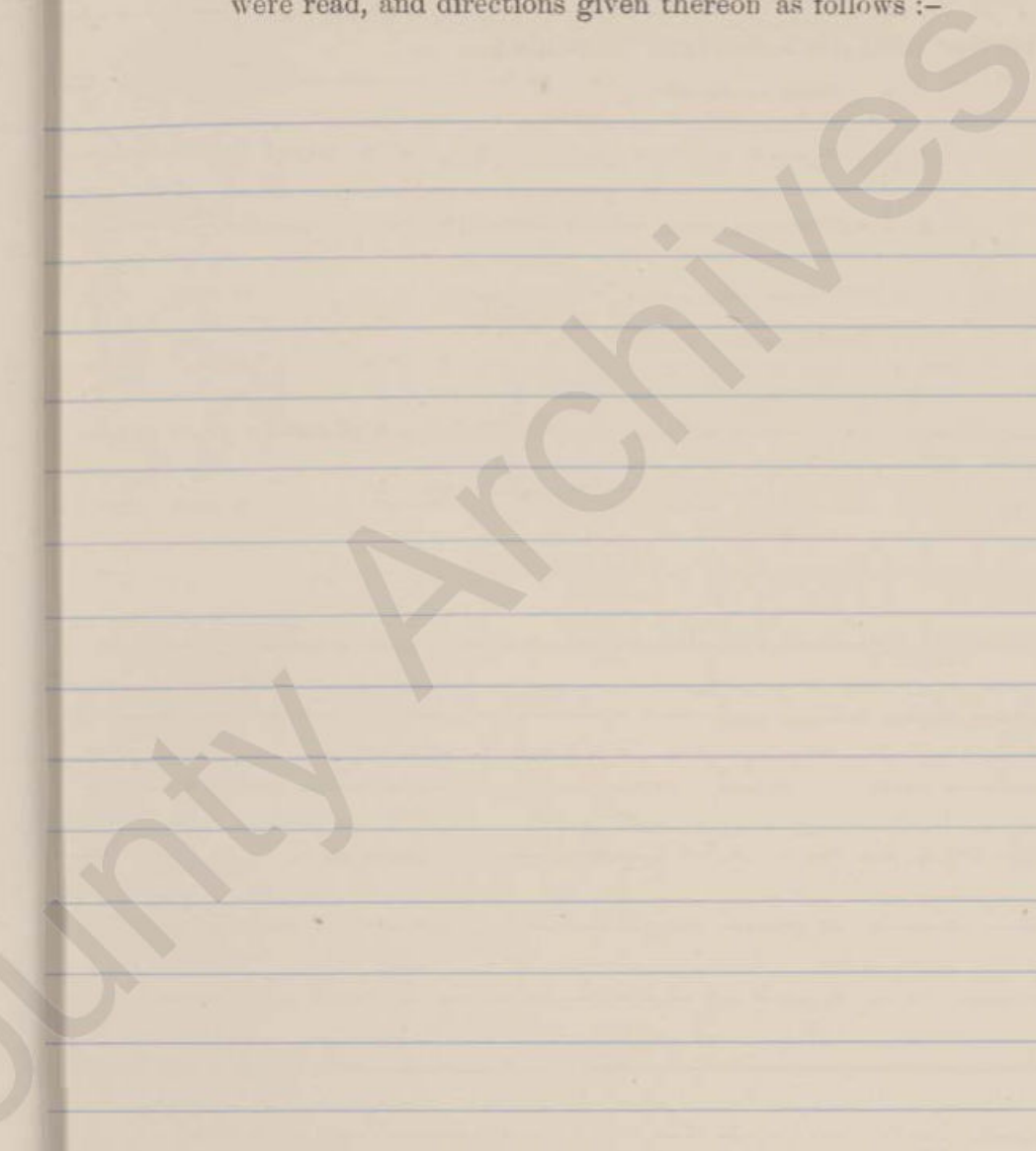

Messrs. Duly, Meehan, and Doherty were appointed as a Committee to take steps for the abatement of a nuisance at the bridge in Bundoran, and also to make arrangements for the removal to the Workhouse of some surplus pipes belonging to Bundoran Water Works.
