Letters from the Secretary of Public Works with reference to the applications of the Council for a loan of £1900, under the Labourers Act were read as follow:  
Date 6<sup>th</sup> Novr 1901 stating - that the Accountant of the Board has called attention to the unpunctuality on the part of the Council in paying instalments on advances already made as shown by the following statement:

Instalment due 1 <sup>st</sup> May 1900	-	Paid 21 <sup>st</sup> July 1900
" " 1 <sup>st</sup> Novr 1900	-	" 13 <sup>th</sup> Feb. 1901
" " 1 <sup>st</sup> May 1901	-	Paid 19 <sup>th</sup> Oct. 1901

The Secretary then requests an explanation as to the circumstances under which the several instalments were not paid at the dates when they became due, and states that the Board of Works acting under Treasury's directions are precluded from submitting the Council's application for a loan of £1900, for their Lordships' approval unless some assurance is given that in future

instalments will be paid on the due days at which they become due.

The Clerk reported that on receipt of the above letter he had written to the Board of Works stating - that the rate made to meet the instalments of the loan, is only remitted to the Council in quarterly instalments that it takes two instalments to make up the half yearly amount due to the Board of Works and as the Council is not allowed to overdraw the Bank Account the amount due to the Board cannot be remitted till two quarterly instalments of rates are on hand.

In reference to the Clerk's letter a further letter date 15<sup>th</sup> June<sup>1901</sup> 1901 was received from the Board of Works stating - that the Board are absolutely precluded from submitting to the Treasury the application for the loan of £1900 under the Labourers Act under the circumstances of continual default and the absence of assurance that payments will be punctually made in future. The Board further point out that other Rural Districts make arrangements for punctual payment though they work under the same financial regulations, and add that if the Council is hampered in paying its debts by the regulations of the Local Government Board they should make representation to that Department.

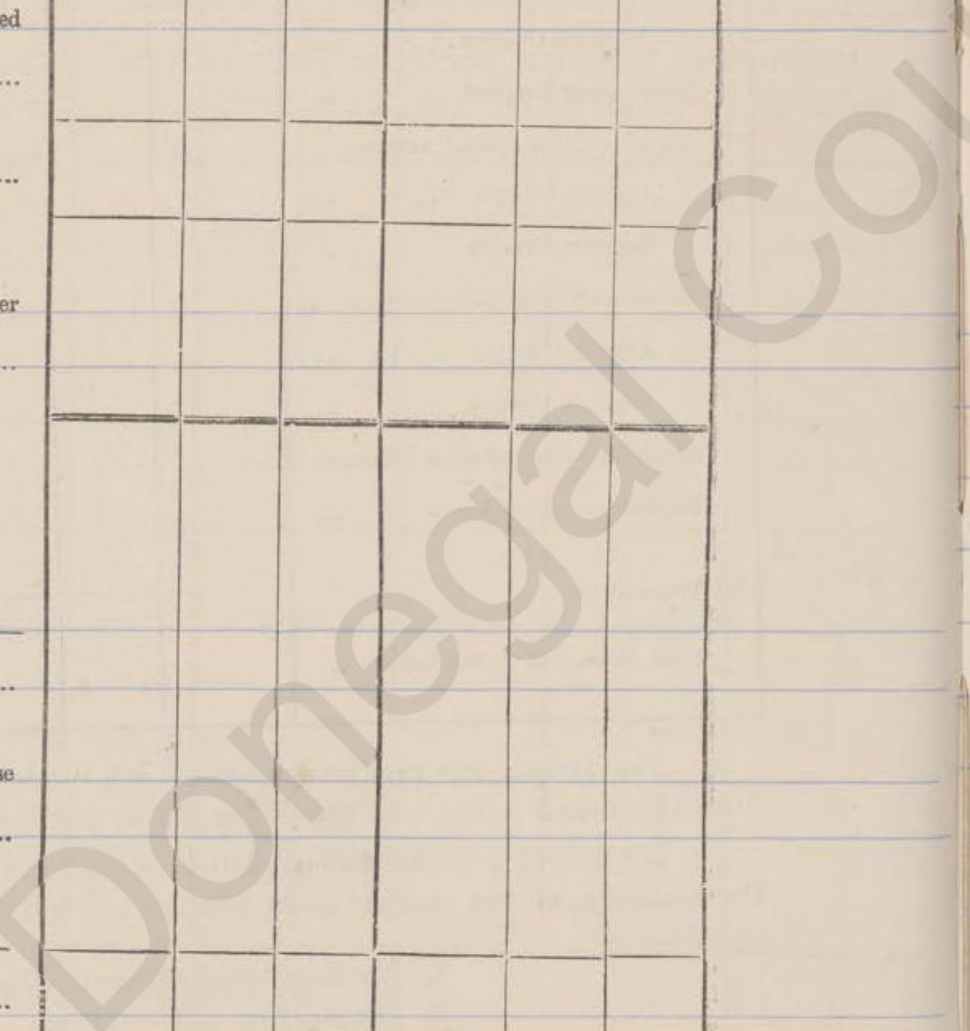

Dr. Hamilton recommends that a new line of pipes be laid from each end of College St. and another sewer made to carry off the sewerage from those pipes.

An estimate and specification for the sewers as recommended by Dr. Hamilton to be procured and advertisements for tenders for carrying out the work to be issued. Tenders to be considered on 28<sup>th</sup> Decr. next.

The Report of Mr. Steadman C. E. on the sewerage of Bundoran was laid before the Council.

Mr. Daly proposed and Mr. Meenan seconded that the report be adopted the area of charge to be the area of charge as already fixed by the sealed Order of the Local Government Board.

As the matter does not affect the County at large an appeal will probably be made by the Solicitor for the County Council.

It was unanimously agreed that M<sup>r</sup> Lippitt Sol. be instructed to appeal on behalf of this Council against the decision of the County Court Judge in the case above referred to.

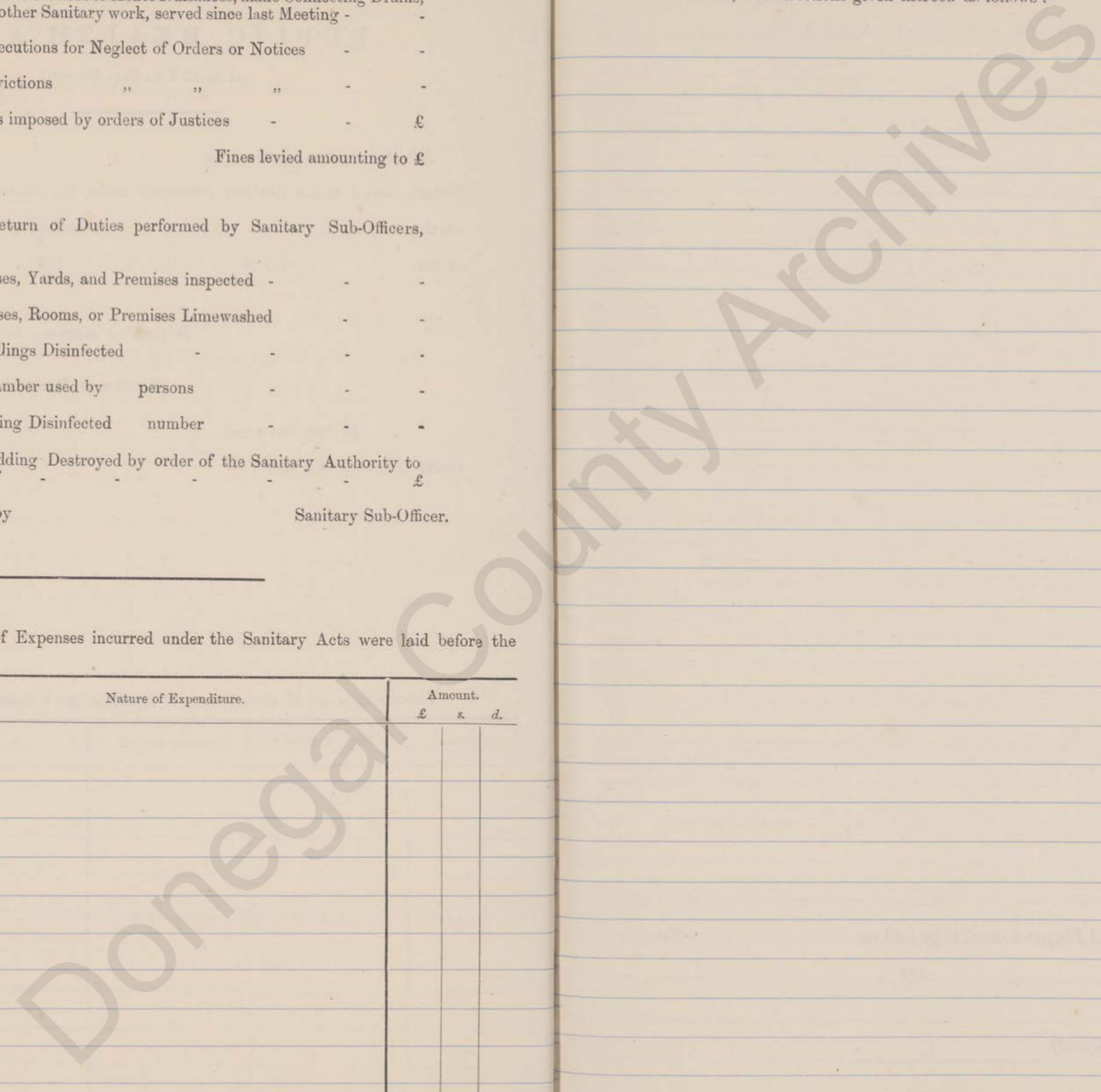
