From Mr. John Higgins Sanitary Sub Officer date 14th Decr. 1903, with reference to the Local Govt. Board's letter of 20th Ult. requesting the Council to call on Mr. Higgins for an explanation as to his failure to send any report to the Medical Officer of Health of Ballintra District during the Quarter ended 30th September 1903.

Mr. Higgins states that as can be seen by his fortnightly reports to the Council he had visited the District regularly, any nuisances he had reason to complain of were abated by the parties in fault without his being obliged to take any further action.

The Council considered the explanation satisfactory.

He had caused disinfectants to be used for the present, and requested the teacher of the School to refuse admission to pupils coming from houses where illness of any kind existed until he got authority from Medical Officer to admit them.

The Clerk reported that the Arbitrator appointed to consider the claim for compensation and way leave, made by Mr. John Green of Lurgan on his lands, in carrying out works connected with Ballyshannon Water Supply, had awarded Mr. Green the sum of £8.5.0 as compensation and costs.

In reference thereto the Board state that it is the duty of the Sanitary Authority of every District to provide such District with a sufficient and wholesome supply of water, if the same can be obtained at a reasonable cost, the Council must therefore deal with the requirements in this respect of the portion of the village which is in Ballyshannon Rural District, irrespective of any consideration as to whether the Donegal Rural District Council have sufficiently discharged their duty with regard to the portion of the village situate in that Rural District. Although the latter have not performed their duty in providing a proper water supply in as satisfactory a manner as the Board would desire, yet, as the Council are aware the Board after due Local Inquiry by their Inspector felt unable to

declare that the Donegal District Council were in default within the meaning of Sec. 15 of the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1896.

While the Board regret that Donegal District Council have declined to cooperate with the Ballyshannon District Council with the view of providing a supply of water, by gravitation, for the whole village they desire to state, that they are unable to alter the decision arrived at by them so far as Ballyshannon Rural District is concerned.

The Board in conclusion state, that, therefore vests with the Council to determine by what means the portion of the village comprised in this Rural District can be provided with a proper water supply at the least expense, and to proceed to carry out the necessary works with that object without any further delay.

Mr. P. McNulty C.E. to be instructed to prepare a plan and specification for the supply of water for the portion of Ballintra in Ballyshannon Rural District.

The Scheme to be as little cost to the District as possible.

Notice of a claim for the sum of £5- for malicious injury to a sheep was sent in on behalf Mr. J. S. Ellis by Mr. A. Stubbs Solicitor.

Mr. R. H. Reid to be instructed to oppose the claim on behalf of the Council.

The Bundoran Improvement Committee wrote date 7th May 04 requesting the Council to extend the Bundoran Water Mains in several directions in the town. The length of the extensions is stated to be 376 yards.

Mr. McNulty C.E. to visit and report as to the necessity of the proposed extension.

From Local Government Board date 14th May 04, referring to the application of the Council for the Board's sanction to a loan of £2800 for the construction of sewerage works at Bundoran the Board state that they deem it expedient, before sanctioning such loan to cause an Inquiry to be made in relation to the proposed Scheme, the Board will accordingly instruct their Inspector Mr. Cowan to hold a Local Inquiry with respect to the application for the loan referred to, and the Inquiry will be held at the Workhouse on Friday 20th Inst at 12 O'clock, noon. Notice of the Inquiry will be published.

On the consideration of the report and the evidence taken at the inquiry the Board are satisfied that a strong case has been made out in support of the application for a loan. A difficulty however arises in consequence of the margin of borrowing power available in respect of the area of charge.

From the particulars furnished on behalf of the Council it appears that the Valuation of the Area is £3,530.13.0 and the gross borrowing power under Section 238 (2) of the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878, is therefore £7,061..6..0 and that the outstanding liabilities on the area amount to £4,680.0.2. The margin of borrowing power available is therefore only £2,380.5.10, and the Board are unable to sanction a loan of the amount required.

In these circumstances it appears to the Board that as the existing margin of borrowing power is not sufficient to enable the Council to obtain the loan required to carry out the entire works, while the execution of at least a portion of the scheme is urgently required, the Council should direct their Engineer to prepare plans for the most necessary sewers and attached works, which could be carried out at an inclusive cost not exceeding £2,380, and the Board will be prepared on receipt of such plans, with a Specification and Estimate, to consider the question of sanctioning a loan for that amount.

Mr. Steadman C.E. the Engineer of the Council who attended the Meeting was instructed to prepare plans &c. in accordance with the directions contained in the Local Government Board's letter.
