CASUAL TRADING ACT, 1995

Buncrana Town Council Casual Trading (Licence Fees)

Bye-Laws, 2009

Buncrana Town Council in exercise of its powers under Section 6 (1) and (2) (d) of the Casual Trading Act, 1995 hereby makes the following Bye-Laws in relation to the fixing of fees in respect of casual trading licences:-

1. **DEFINITIONS**

In these Bye-Laws the following definitions shall apply:-

"the Act" means the Casual Trading Act, 1995.

"the Council" means Buncrana Town Council.

"the functional area" means the administrative area of the Council.

"an event" means an event or events within the meaning of Section 4 (1) (a) (iii) of the Act.

2. **FEES**

(a) The fee for a licence in accordance with Section 4(1)(a)(i) of the Act authorising a person to engage in casual trading in the functional area on specified days during the period of twelve months from the date of commencement thereof shall be €1,500 payable to the Council with the application made pursuant to Section 4 of the Act containing the information described in subsection (9), which fee shall be refunded to the person applying in the event that the Council refuse to grant the Licence.

(b) The fee for a licence authorising a person to engage in casual trading in accordance with Section 4(1)(a)(iii) of the Act on specified day(s) at an

event specified in the licence shall be \in 150 per day payable to the Council with the application made pursuant to Section 4 of the Act containing the information described in subsection (9), which fee shall be refunded to the person applying in the event that the Council refuse to grant the Licence.

3. **REVOCATION**

The Buncrana Urban District Council Casual Trading (Licence Fees) Bye-Laws 1996 are hereby revoked.

4. **COMMENCEMENT**

These Bye-Laws shall come into force on the First day of July 2009.
