Appointment of Members to
County Donegal Vocational Education Committee

Donegal County Council has decided to re-advertise and seek further nominations for the above.

The Vocational Education Act 1930, as amended by the Vocational Education Act, 2001, provides for the appointment by the County Council of four members (2 men and 2 women) to the VEC from among persons, nominated by bodies as, in the opinion of the Council, are representative of:-

- (i) Students
- (ii) Any class of trustee of community colleges maintained by the vocational education committee concerned,
- (iii) Members of the staff of the vocational education committee (other than members of staff belonging to the same class of members of staff to be elected under Section 8 (1) (d) of the Vocational Education Act, 1930, as substituted by Section 7 of the Vocational Education (Amendment) Act, 2001).
- (iv) Voluntary organisations, community organisations or Irish language interests, or
- (v) Persons carrying on, in places with the vocational education area concerned, trades, professions or commercials or industrial activities

Nominations are, therefore, invited from representative bodies stating the name of the body, the interest group it represents, the name and address of its nominee, any supporting documentation of the nominee's special knowledge, qualifications or experience and a contact number.

Please note nominations must be by Bodies, not by individuals.

Bodies who have already submitted nominations do not need to re-submit an application.

Nominations should be sent to the County Secretary, County House, Lifford, Co. Donegal, to be received not later than 4.00pm on Friday 19th March, 2010.
