**EA 48/06 CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES HELD ON 24TH JANUARY
2006**

On the proposal of Cllr. Enda Bonner, seconded by Cllr. Brian Ó Domhnaill, the minutes of meeting of the 24th of January 2006 were agreed subject to Minute GEA 41/06 (Speed Limits) reading as follows:

“Cllr. Pearse Doherty requested the Roads Service to liase with the CEO in the NRA in relation to speed limit requirements on the Gweedore Road, Dungloe, Loughanure and also that the Coshclady speed limit sign be moved to the entrance of Eugene Gallagher’s house.”

GEA 49/06 REPORT FROM WORKSHOP – 10TH FEBRUARY 2006

On the proposal of Cllr. David Alcorn, seconded by Cllr. Terence Slowey, the report from the Workshop on the 10th of February was agreed.

GEA 50/06 REVISION OF BYE-LAWS AND HARBOUR DUES AT BURTONPORT AND THE INTRODUCTION OF BYE-LAWS AND HARBOUR DUES AT SPECIFIED PORTS

The Committee discussed the report circulated with the agenda regarding proposals to amend the Bye-laws and harbour dues at Burtonport Harbour and harbour dues at specified harbours in accordance with the Local Government Act, 1994 as amended and the Harbours Act, 1996.

In response to Members queries regarding the proposed charges, the Senior Marine Technician advised the Committee that the aim of the Bye-laws is to regulate indiscriminate use of harbours.

On the proposal of Cllr. David Alcorn, seconded by Cllr. Pearse Doherty, the Committee agreed to the publication in local newspapers of a notice of the Council's intention to introduce Bye-laws and charges.

Members requested the public display of the draft Bye-laws on Arranmore, library in Gweedore and at the post offices in Magheroarty and Derrybeg.

WATER, ENVIRONMENT AND EMERGENCY SERVICES

GEA 51/06 DUNGLOE & GLENTIES SEWERAGE SCHEMES

Peter Donaghey, Senior Executive Engineer, Water Capital Services made a presentation to the Committee and stated that preliminary reports are available for both of the above schemes.

The presentation dealt with:

- Review of preliminary report
- Population review
- Site Investigation/Studies
- Network upgrade extensions
- Receiving waters
- Treatment options
- Environmental considerations
- Costs/Procurement

In response to queries from Members regarding the transportation of thickened sludge from Dungloe to Gweedore, Peter Donaghey stated that this policy was in accordance with the sludge management plan adopted by the Council. Cllr. Pearse Doherty stressed the importance of community consultation at all stages of this process.

GEA 52/06 FALCARRAGH SEWERAGE SCHEME

Cllrs. Bonner and Ó Domhnaill requested a presentation from the Water Capital Services section in respect of the above scheme, at the next area meeting.

GEA 53/06 GWEEDORE SEWERAGE SCHEME

Cllr. Pearse Doherty reiterated his previous requests that Council Officials and DOE Inspectors convene a meeting to expedite the Gweedore Sewerage scheme.

Cllr. Alcorn requested a report from the Director of the Water Service in respect of this matter.

GEA 54/06 SMALL CAPITAL SCHEMES

The Committee noted the report circulated previously in respect of small capital schemes.

GEA 55/06 GROUP WATER SCHEMES

The Committee noted the report circulated with the agenda in relation to the above.

GEA 56/06 GROUP WATER SCHEMES UNDER CONSTRUCTION

Members noted the report circulated with the agenda.

GEA 57/06 CIVIC AMENITY SITE – DUNGLOE

In response to a query from Cllr. Bonner regarding the status of this project the Area Manager, Water Environment stated that he would refer the matter to Donal Casey and Bernard Cuning for an update.

GEA 58/06 ILLEGAL DUMPING

The Area Manager advised the Committee that the Environment Service are utilising a mobile camera to monitor different locations at which illegal dumping is prevalent.

GEA 59/06 NARIN BEACH

The Area Manager advised Members that a quotation has been sought from the ESB for the provision of an electric supply and that the caretaker had also been contacted regarding the upgrading of toilets at Narin. Cllr. Pádraig Doherty also requested the installation of toilet facilities at Mageraclogher and Port Arthur beaches and at Bunbeg and Magheragallen Piers.

ROADS AND TRANSPORTATION

GEA 60/06 PROPOSED ROADS PROGRAMME

- 60.1** The Roads Manager circulated Members with a copy of the proposed Roads Programme (Appendix 1) agreed at the workshop on the 20th of March 2006.
On the proposal of Cllr Bonner, seconded by Cllr Slowey, the Committee agreed the Programme.
- 60.2** Cllr. Bonner informed the Roads Services of a discrepancy in the allocation of monies to Area Supervisors for local road flood prevention and drainage.
- 60.3** On the proposal of Cllr. Alcorn, seconded by Cllr. Bonner, the Committee agreed to seek authorisation from the DOE for transfer of the allocation of funding in the sum of €20,000 from Toberkeen – Curran Hill (L-17232) to the Caravan Road, Dungloe.
- 60.4** Cllr. Pearse Doherty criticised the amount of funding (€15,000) allocated to the Cronaguiggy Road (L-57931) on the grounds that agreed funding would not repair the damage caused to the road by the Housing Service.
- 60.5** Cllr. Pearse Doherty requested the Council to liase with the local co-operative and Chamber of Commerce to obtain greater value for money for funding allocated for litter collection in Gweedore.
- 60.6** Cllr. Terence Slowey informed the Committee that he will not support any future roadworks programme until the Ardara – Ardaghey road is prioritised for funding.
Cllr. Bonner also criticised the apparent lack of prioritisation of this road.
The Roads Manager stated that the E.U Co-Financed priority list is considered at the September meeting to decide priorities for the following year and that the Roads service is guided by the Members in this regard.

GEA 61/06 DESTRUCTION OF ROAD NETWORK

Cllr. Alcorn expressed disappointment that the Planning Manager was not in attendance to hear his concerns regarding the destruction of the road network by developers and asked the Planning & Roads Services to co-operate to curtail this type of activity.

GEA 62/06 CO-OPERATION WITH DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEES

The Committee requested the Roads Service to liase with Loughanure and Coshclady Development Committees who are working voluntarily for the benefit of small local communities.

GEA 63/06 PUBLIC LIGHTING

Cllr. Slowey and Cllr. Ó Domhnaill requested that Members requests for public lighting be forwarded to the ESB for quotations and that the type of lighting required also be determined by the ESB.

GEA 64/06 LOCAL IMPROVEMENT SCHEMES

Cllr. Ó Domhnaill and Cllr. Slowey expressed disappointment at the stringent interpretation of the LIS criteria by the Roads Service resulting in the refusal of applications.

The Roads Manager advised the Committee;

- that schemes are subject to audit and verification by DOE Inspectors
- of the poor quality of maps accompanying applications
- that the majority of LIS schemes are carried out in the Glenties Electoral area.

GEA 65/06 MEMBERS REPRESENTATIONS

Cllr. Slowey and Cllr. Alcorn both expressed extreme annoyance and frustration due to their representations not being responded to by the Roads Service.

The Roads Manager informed the Committee that due to the Dungloe office having responsibility for the majority of roads expenditure in the county, that the preference is to provide a verbal response due to the workload.

GEA 66/06 TEMPORARY CONTRACTS – OUTDOOR ROADS STAFF

In response to Cllr. Pearse Doherty's query regarding amendments to temporary contracts, the Area Roads Manager undertook to forward explanatory guidelines to the Committee.

GEA 67/06 N56 – 5 YEAR PLAN

The Area Roads Manager informed the Committee that he would ask Brendan O Donnell, Senior Executive Engineer to attend the next area meeting.

GEA 68/06 COASTAL PROTECTION WORKS – LR. MEENACLADDY & CURRANSPORT

The Area Roads Manager agreed to liase with the Marine Service regarding requirements at the above locations.

GEA 69/06 BALLYNESS PIER

In response to a query from Cllr. Ó Domhnaill the Senior Marine Technician agreed to provide safety rings and warning signs at this location.

GEA 70/06 REGIONAL ROAD SIGNAGE

In response to a query from Cllr. Alcorn, the Roads Manager advised Members that a request has been sent to HQ requesting the timeframe for implementation of the regional road signage scheme.

GEA 71/06 ROAD MAINTENANCE

In response to queries from Members, the Roads Manager advised that bitmac has to be surface dressed for safety reasons in accordance with NRA and DOE circulars and that documentation in this regard will be issued to Members.

The Committee highlighted roads throughout the electoral area that require urgent repairs and requested the Roads Service to seek emergency funding to carry out essential maintenance.

PLANNING AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
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GEA 72/06 PLANNING REFUSALS

The Committee noted the planning refusals for the period 26/10/05 to 12/01/06 circulated at the meeting.

GEA 73/06 STAFFING OF THE PLANNING OFFICE

Cllr. Alcorn requested the Council to employ additional staff in the Planning Service and expressed disappointment that the Area Manager was unable to attend the meeting.

GEA 74/06 WORKSHOP – SECTION 140 MOTIONS

The Committee agreed to hold a workshop in Falcarragh on the 4th of April 2006 at 12 O'clock.

HOUSING AND BUILDING

GEA 75/06 CENTRAL HEATING PROGRAMME 2006

Members welcomed the report circulated at the meeting, listing Scheme and SI houses for which tenders will be sought for the installation of central heating.

The Area Housing Manager advised the Committee that it is proposed to proceed with the works where there is no application from the tenant to 'buy out' and where there is compliance with the tenancy agreement.

GEA 76/06 HOUSING CAPITAL PROGRAMME

The Committee discussed the report circulated with the agenda and the Area Manager responded to Members queries in respect of scheme proposals in Dungloe, Burtonport, Meenaniller and Lettermacaward.

Cllr. Pearse Doherty requested the Council to provide playground facilities in housing developments.

GEA 77/06 SOCIAL HOUSING PROGRAMME

Cllr. Pádraig Doherty requested the Council to liaise with the contractor to complete the provision of electricity and water to specific instance cottage No. 6518.

Cllr. Alcorn requested the Council to encourage additional contractors to tender for SI housing developments.

GEA 78/06 CASUAL VACANCIES

Members noted the report circulated previously listing casual vacancies as at the 10th of March 2006.

CORPORATE SERVICES

GEA 79/06 REQUEST FROM ARDARA PARISH COUNCIL TO MAKE A PRESENTATION TO ELECTED MEMBERS

On the proposal of Cllr. Ó Domhnaill, seconded by Cllr. Pearse Doherty the Committee agreed to receive a deputation from Ardara Parish Council on the morning of the electoral area meeting on the 23rd of May.

GEA 80/06 ACTIVITY REPORT – CORPORATE SERVICES

Members noted the report circulated with the agenda detailing business transacted by Corporate Services staff throughout the county.

GEA 81/06 GWEEDORE FIRE STATION

1 (a) National Secondary (N56) Pavement Improvements

The NRA has allocated €3,550,000, to the following projects. This represents a 34% increase on our initial allocation in 2005.

Doochary Junction to Dungloe

€500,000

Permanent surfacing on section from junction to Sweeney's, completion of accommodation works with combination of online and offline realignment towards Dungloe. 1800m

Gweebarra Bridge to Gweebarra Bar

€150,000

Bitmac overlay from the bridge to the Gweebarra Bar, including surface dressing and lining. 800m.

Glenties to Kilraine

€500,000

Online widening from Kilraine junction to the '05 works and from the '05 works to Owenea Trading. This will include temporary surfacing of section widened in 2005 and 2006. 1900m

Ardara at Doohill

€250,000

Permanent surface on sections widened over the previous 3 years and completion of accommodation works. 800 m.

The Nick

€50,000

Permanent surface on section widened in 2004 and completion of accommodation works. 500m

Ballyboe

€225,000

Continuation of widening from Derryreel Cross Roads towards Falcarragh. Approx 800m

Cassidy's Quarry - Dunfanaghy

€400,000

Continuation of widening from Murroe towards Corcreggan, 800 m.

Crollly – Loughanure

€400,000

Permanent surface on section widened in 2005 and completion of accommodation works.

Crollly – Dore Junction

€250,000

Permanent surface on section between Dore Junction and the end of Crollly tarmac, 800m

To continue widening and temporary surface towards Fanaboy Junction, 600m.
Permanent surface on part of section widened in 2005 and completion of accommodation works.

Tirlin – Drumnaraw School**€400,000**

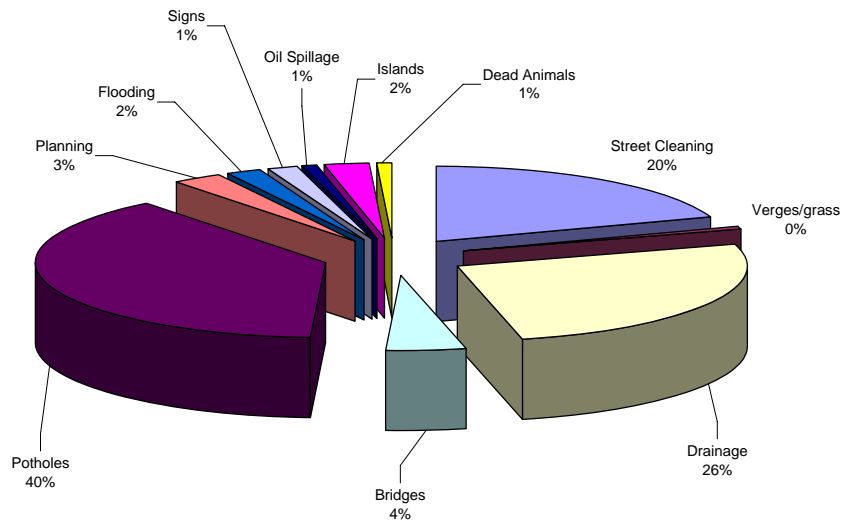
