



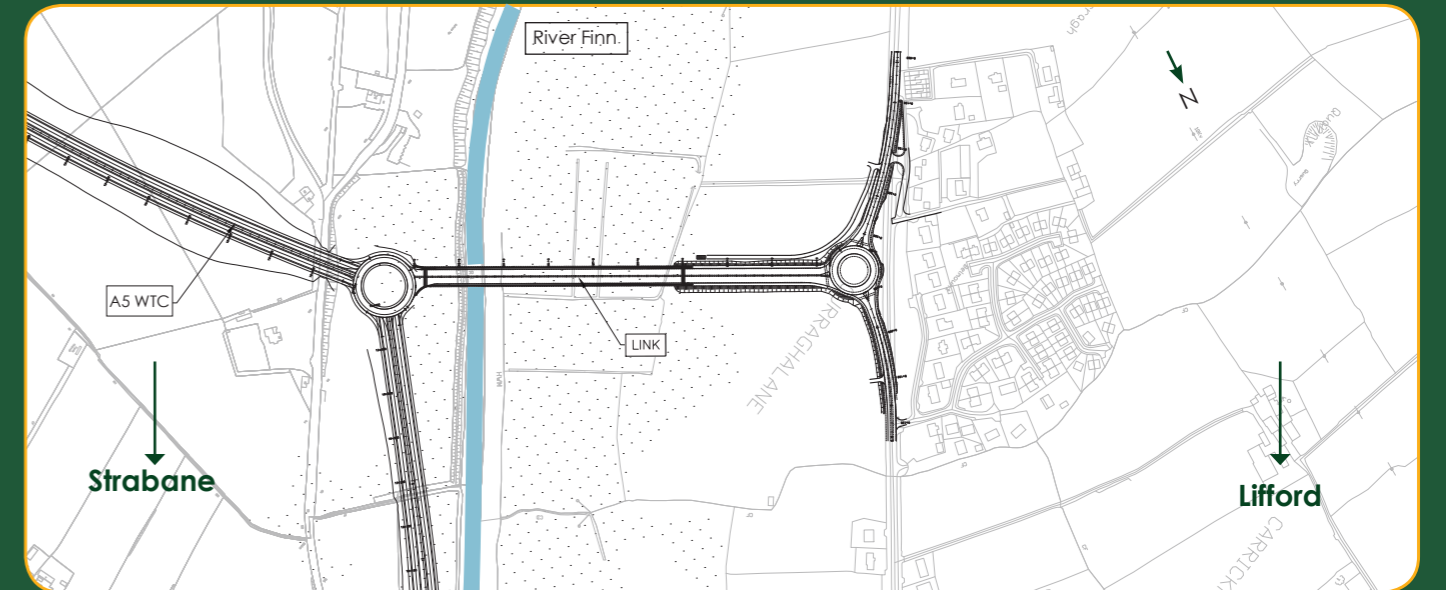
Description Of The Scheme

The N14 / N15 to A5 Link provides a road linking the existing N15 in Lifford, County Donegal to the proposed A5 Western Transport Corridor in County Tyrone, Northern Ireland. The scheme includes a 300m long bridge crossing the River Finn and floodplain.

Scheme Objectives

The primary objectives for the scheme are:

- To remove a bottleneck on the national road network;
- To improve facilities and provide linkage for strategic, cross border traffic;
- To improve safety for all road users;
- To improve economic efficiency and journey time reliability;
- To reduce impacts on local residents;
- To improve the local environment for residents, commercial businesses and tourism.



Proposed Alignment

Current Status

Roughan and O'Donovan Consulting Engineers were commissioned in Summer 2010 to undertake the design and Environmental Impact Assessment of the scheme. Since then the scheme has been developed as illustrated and we are now seeking your views.

Bridge Design

The proposed bridge design has been developed based on the requirement to minimise the impacts on the following key environmental constraints:

- Ecology – Impact on the River Finn candidate Special Area of Conservation;
- Flooding Issues;
- Landscape and Visual Impacts;
- Archaeology and Cultural Heritage.
