MQ1 Can I buy an Ordnance Survey map from the Council?

MA1 Ordnance Survey maps are now available to purchase at the front Counter in the Letterkenny Public Services Centre, Neil T Blaney Road, Letterkenny.

MQ2 Can I get Land Registry Folio Numbers or details of land ownership from the County Council?

MA2 The County Council does not maintain general records of land ownership in the county; you should contact the Land Registry and Registry of Deeds, Chancery Street, Dublin 7.

Folio and filed plans for registered land in County Donegal are available on-line through the Electronic Access Service (EAS).
