Guidance Notes:

- Groups organising clean ups can collect bags, gloves and litter pickers from their nearest area office or urban council office during office hours Monday - Friday. All groups must complete the registration form even if they are just requesting bags and gloves.
- Groups are advised to store collected waste in a secure location until the Mobile Litter Unit can collect the bags.
- Skips will only be issued on approval from the Litter Warden from the main council offices at Lifford, Carndonagh, Dungloe, Milford, Donegal Town and Letterkenny.
- Those Groups requiring a skip must give the Council at least 10 days notice to allow practical arrangements to be made.
- Multiple Skips will not be provided unless the area being cleaned is deemed to be in very poor condition and have a lot of bulky items deposited e.g. furniture, kitchen goods etc. and a visit from the litter warden will be required to assess the site
- Skips will not be left overnight unless it is in a secure location. This is to prevent the deposition of household or commercial waste overnight.
