Mr. Francie Coyle, Director Planning & Economic Development read into the record his report dated 11<sup>th</sup> May 2004 recommending that the Carndonagh Development Plan 1997 (Variation No.3) be contravened to comply with the provisions of Section 34(6a) of the Planning & Development Act, 2000, and that permission be granted subject to the conditions set out in the schedule to his report.

In response to a query from Clr. McGuinness in relation to condition no. 20 i.e. Development Contribution Levy, Mr. Francie Coyle, Director Planning & Economic Development clarified that the charges levied would be index linked from 1<sup>st</sup> January each year and that the total contribution was to be paid to the Council prior to commencement of the development unless the Council agreed, in writing, beforehand to facilitate the phased payment of contributions.

On the proposal of Clr. McGuinness, seconded by Clr. McDonald, the following resolution was put to the meeting:-

“That in accordance with Section 34 6(a) of the Planning & Development Act, 2000, Donegal County Council resolves that a decision be made to grant planning permission to Inishowen Co-op Society Ltd, Moville Road, Carndonagh, for the erection of stores and shop at Churchland Quarters, Moville Road, Carndonagh, Co. Donegal, subject to the Schedule of Conditions attached to Mr. Coyle's report of 11<sup>th</sup> May, 2004.

A recorded vote was taken on the motion resulting in 22 for and none against.
