

What can I do if I am unhappy with the valuation placed on my property or if my property has reverted to domestic or agricultural use?

The valuation and rateable description of a property is determined by the:

Commissioner of Valuations
Valuation Office
Irish Life Centre
Abbey Street Lower
Dublin 1

Only the Commissioner of Valuations is entitled to amend the rateable valuation on a property. It is not within the authority of the county council to do so.

It is important to note that a revision of the valuation on a property can only be sought in the event of a material change having taken place since the last valuation. This can be as a result of renovation/extension works or whenever the property has reverted to domestic or agricultural use. A revision of valuation currently costs €250.
