Welcome

Clr Niamh Kennedy, Chairperson, welcomed everyone and thanked the members present for participating in the meeting.

1. Draft minutes of the LCDC meeting of 15th March 2022

The minutes of the previous LCDC Meeting were considered with no matters arising. On the proposal of Padraic Fingleton, seconded by Joe Boland, the minutes of LCDC Meeting of 15th March 2022 were adopted with no matters arising.

2. Inclusion Strategy for Black and Minority Ethnic Communities

Liam Ward advised members that a very successful launch of the Inclusion Strategy for Black and Minority Ethnic Communities had been held on 25th March. He confirmed to members the importance of the Strategy and confirmed that Donegal County Council were committed to working with the various agencies to implement the Strategy.

Siobhan McLaughlin acknowledged the work of all the partners involved in devising the plan and there would be a national remembrance and reflection event held over St Patrick's Weekend to remember those who lost their lives during the pandemic. Local Authorities had been requested to host local services and reported the positive response of the individual groups to the launch of this strategy in the County.

Charles Sweeney joined the meeting and made a presentation to members on the Inclusion Strategy for Black and Minority Ethnic Communities. Charles set out the background of the strategy to members and advised of the responsibilities on Local Authorities as set out in the National Migrant Integration Strategy. Charles advised that the Strategy vision was advancing the achievement of equality for Black and minority ethnic communities in County Donegal through securing their active inclusion in the community and full participation in the wider Society.

He advised members that the Key Actions of the Strategy were:

- Valuing People, Building Community
- Enabling Dialogue, Empowering Voice
- Recognising Diversity, Enabling Access and Participation
- Achieving Outcomes, Providing Opportunities

Charles went on to detail how the strategy would be implemented as follows:-

- Cross Sectoral interagency implementation group
- Secretariat comprising the lead organisations identified for the seven flagship initiatives
- Annual implementation plan of priority actions
- Systems to pool resources of individual public bodies to support and enable action that have a cross agency relevance
- Monitoring template to track implementation progress

Charles advised members that it was proposed to establish a Committee under the auspices of the LCDC which would function as a Migrant Integration Forum and an Implementation Group for the Black and Minority Ethnic Inclusion Strategy. He confirmed that this Committee would be similar to the existing Steering Group and requested suggestions from members for stakeholders who should form the membership of the Committee.

On the proposal of Seamus Bonner, seconded by Michael MacGiolla Easbuig, members agreed the membership of the Black and Minority Ethnic Inclusion Strategy Committee should include Representatives from the following:-

- Inishowen Development Partnership
- Donegal Local Development Company
- Donegal Intercultural Platform
- Health Service Executive
- Donegal Education and Training Board
- Early and Primary Education sector

3. Community Activities Fund

Seamus Canning advised members Donegal Local Community Development Committee received a fund of €318,923 for the Community Activities Programme from the Department of Community & Rural Development. The programme guidelines indicated that the LCDC should award small and large grants to Community Groups as follows:-

- €194,897 Current funding (Non-Pay) for use towards running/operating costs
- €124,026 Capital funding for use towards carrying out necessary repairs and improvements to facilities, energy efficiency type projects, purchase of equipment etc.

At the LCDC Meeting in January members agreed that funding should be divided equally between each MD resulting in $\in 63,784.60$ being available for each MD, with $\in 38,980$ per MD ring fenced for award as small grants for operating/running costs of between $\in 500$ and $\in 1,500$ with the balance of $\in 24,804.60$ being awarded as large Capital grants ranging from $\in 5,000$ to $\in 10,000$.

On the proposal of Michael MacGiolla Easbuig, seconded by Michael Tunney, members of the LCDC approved the award of Large and Small Grants under the Community Activities Fund as set out above.

4. Community Response Forum in Donegal – Ukrainian Refugee Response

Liam Ward provided member with an update on the establishment of a Community Response Forum in the County to co-ordinate efforts and share information to assist and support the Ukrainian Refugees arriving in the County. He advised that an initial meeting of all agencies had taken place with additional meetings scheduled. He advised that it was very clear that a lot of good work was taken place with the response on the ground being led by DLDC, IDP and the Intercultural Platform.

He appraised members of the situation in relation to accommodation for Refugees.

John McLaughlin advised that all agencies in the County had done a great job to date but there was more to do and advised that we owe it to all to do our best in this unprecedented humanitarian Crisis.

Padraic Fingleton made a short presentation to members on the actions being taken by DLDC and set out the possible implications for the delivery of the SICAP Programme and the agreed targets and budgets for same by the redirection of funding and staff to assisting the Ukrainian Refugees.

Members noted the possible impact on Targets and Budgets and agreed that any formal amendments required could be agreed when the situation became clearer.

A discussion in relation to the supports available for Refugees and a central contact point took place with all member contributing. Liam Ward confirmed that all queries could be submitted to <u>communityforum@donegalcoco.ie</u>;

He confirmed that members would be kept updated on developments in relation to the management of this crisis in the County.

5. Peace Plus Update

Paddy Doherty confirmed that members had agreed the updated Peace Plus Partnership Structure at the last LCDC Meeting as follows:-

Members were advised that this matter would be considered at the May Council meeting with 5 elected members being nominated for Membership of the Partnership.

He advised that the LCDC would now seek nominations for Social Partners to form the membership of Pillar 3 and Pillar 4 of the structure through the PPN. He confirmed that the LCDC would seek nominations from the various Organisations and complete the selection process. He confirmed that the first partnership meeting would be scheduled for June 2022.

Paddy advised that the Programme Document had been submitted to the EU at the end of March and it was expected that a funding call would be opened in June to which donegal would be invited to apply.

6. MICA

Clr Niamh Kennedy invited Clr Martin McDermott, Chairperson of the Council's MICA Committee to bring a proposal to members on this issue.

Clr McDermott proposed that the LCDC host a meeting with all the agencies involved in the provision of supports and assistance to families effected by the MICA Crisis to establish how a co-ordinated approach can be taken to deal with this crisis. He suggested that the LCDC were best placed to being all the agencies together to develop a strategy to develop and deliver an interagency support network to address all the needs of people as they navigate the redress and rebuild process.

Andrew Ward concurred with Clr McDermotts suggestion. He advised that the groups already providing support needed support to expand the services they provide.

James O Donnell suggested that the number of people needed support would increase significantly once the new redress scheme was launched. Siobhan McLaughlin proposed that the MICA Action Group be invited to make a presentation to the LCDC.

Following a discussion it was agreed that Clr McDermott would meet with Chief Executive and Liam Ward to bring a proposal on this matter to the next LCDC Meeting.

7. Retirement of Michael Tunney

On behalf of all the member of the LCDC, Clr Niamh Kennedy expressed their best wishes to Michael Tunney on his forthcoming retirement and thanked him for his service to the LCDC Committee.

This concluded the business of the meeting.
