#### PATRICK SCOTT: IMAGE SPACE LIGHT

Celebrated Irish artist Patrick Scott, sadly died in February of this year on the eve of the opening of a major retrospective exhibition of his work, 'Patrick Scott : Image Space Light', at the Irish Museum of Modern Art and at Visual, Carlow.

The exhibition at the Regional Cultural Centre features works completed by Patrick Scott from the 1960s to the recent past. The show's focus is on Scott's mature style, epitomized by his iconic gold leaf paintings. It also features a number of tapestries - mainly from the late 1970s - and a series of ash tables from the early 1990s.

Earlier this year, the Orchestra's performance at the National Concert Hall, as part of the IAYO's Festival of Youth Orchestras, was very well received.

Several unique and much-praised compositions have been created for the CDYO by composers and artists such as Vincent Kennedy, Little John Nee and Neil Martin. The Vincent Kennedy/Little John Nee adaptation of Oscar Wilde's 'The Happy Prince' earned the Youth Orchestra a Special Achievement Award at the 2013 Festival of Youth Orchestras.
