-- Hazard Awareness and Planning Ahead - While driving you should constantly be scanning all around. Early recognition of potential hazards will mean you are able to anticipate problems early and take appropriate action in plenty of time. This will help you avoid late braking and harsh acceleration, both of which lead to higher fuel consumption.

-- Keep rolling - stopping then starting again uses more fuel than rolling. Slow early for traffic lights or approaching a queue and you might not have to stop completely.
