Guidance Notes

Collection of Clean Up Materials:

- Groups organising clean ups can collect bags, gloves and litter pickers from their nearest Council Office at Lifford, Carndonagh, Dungloe, Donegal Town and Letterkenny during office hours Monday – Friday.

Skips:

- Skips will only be issued on approval from the Litter Warden from the main Council offices. Those Groups requiring a skip must give the Council at least 10 days notice to allow practical arrangements to be made.
- Multiple skips will not be provided unless the area being cleaned is deemed to be in very poor condition and have a large amount of bulky items deposited. A visit from the Litter Warden will be required to assess the site.
- Skips will not be left overnight. This is to prevent the deposition of household or commercial waste overnight.
