

Enhanced Defective Concrete Blocks Grant Scheme

Monthly Report to Elected Members

Date: 29th February 2024

Background

The Minister for Housing, Local Government & Heritage announced the commencement of the Enhanced Defective Concrete Block Grant Scheme on the 3rd July 2023.

Donegal County Council is tasked with administering the Enhanced Scheme, on behalf of the Department of Housing, Local Government & Heritage.

This report provides an update on the implementation of the Enhanced Defective Concrete Block Grant Scheme and covers the period up to and including 29th February 2024.

At the commencement date, Donegal County Council had 1,296 applications received under the Previous Scheme which required transitioning to the Enhanced Scheme.

Overview of Approved Remediation Options under the Enhanced Scheme

Remedial Option	Remedial Works Description
Option 1	Demolish entire dwelling and rebuild (in the exact position on the land
	on which the relevant dwelling was situated before it was demolished
Option 2	Demolish and rebuild external walls (both outer and inner leafs) down
	to foundation on a phased basis and re-render
Option 3	Demolish and rebuild external walls (both outer and internal leafs)
	down to top of rising wall on a phased basis and re-render
Option 4	Demolish and rebuild external walls (outer leaf only) down to top of
	rising wall on a phased basis and re-render
Option 5	Demolish and rebuild outer leaf of affected walls only and re-render

Status of Transitional Applications

Of the 1,296 applications received, 849 applications were approved by Donegal County Council under the Previous Scheme.

The current status of these 849 applications is outlined in Table 1.

This table also provides detail on the Grant Calculations / Recalculations completed to date by Donegal County Council under the terms of the Enhanced Scheme, where applicants have submitted the required documentation.



Referral of Applications to the Housing Agency

Under the provisions of the Enhanced Scheme, Donegal County Council has an administrative role. The technical assessment of validated applications is the remit of the Housing Agency.

The initial step for an application, following validation and referral to the Housing Agency, is the Housing Agency's Determination of Damage Threshold of the relevant dwelling.

For those applications that meet the Damage Threshold, the Housing Agency provides an indicative timeline for determination of the Remediation Option & Grant Amount.

The Determination of Damage Threshold and the Remediation Option Grant as decided by the Housing Agency is communicated to the applicant by the DCB Grant Office.

Where it is deemed by the Housing Agency that an application has not met the Damage Threshold or where an applicant is not satisfied with the Approved Remediation Option, the applicant may submit an appeal to the Independent Appeals Panel.

Further detail is contained within the Tables under Section 2 of this report.

Payments Processed since the introduction of the Enhanced Scheme

Table 3 provides an overview of Payments issued to applicants since the introduction of the Enhanced Grant Scheme in July 2023.

The Payments represent reimbursement of Professional Fees and costs associated with approved remediation works.

Overview of Defective Concrete Block Grant Scheme

Table 4.1 provides an overview of the number of applications received by Donegal County Council since the commencement of the Enhanced Scheme.

Tables 4.2 provides an overview of submitted applications on the Enhanced Scheme together with applications from the Previous Scheme which are subject to transitional arrangements.

Assistance to Applicants

The DCB Grant Office continues to actively engage with applicants across the full scope of the Scheme including in respect of Validation of Applications, Validation of Payment Claims, Processing Payments, Change of Competent Building Professional and all other general queries.

The DCB Section of Donegal County Council's Website is updated regularly and contains all the information and links that an applicant may require at various stages of the application process. The Monthly Activity Reports are also included on the website.

The telephone clinics are available to applicants every Tuesday and Thursday (9am – 12.30pm) to assist applicant with any queries and the DCB Grant Office Team follow up on applicants queries outside of the specific telephone clinics.

In addition, both Community Facilitators continue to provide assistance and support to applicants in their respective geographical areas. This is a welcome resource for applicants in their communities. The DCB Office meet with the Facilitators on a monthly basis to discuss emerging issues.

Donegal County Council continues to contribute to the Enhanced Scheme National Implementation Steering Group. This Group provides a forum for the discussion of emerging issues with the key stakeholders ensuring a consistent approach across all Designated Local Authorities on the rollout of the Enhanced Scheme.

The Department of Housing, Local Government & Heritage is currently preparing a Six Month Progress Report on the rollout and implementation of the Enhanced Scheme across the four current Designated Local Authorities and it is expected that this report will be published shortly.

- For the 849 applications which received Confirmation of Eligibility and Remediation Option by Donegal County Council under the provisions of the Previous Scheme, 62% of applicants were approved for Option 1.
- 46% of all approved applicants have submitted the required information to allow Grant Calculation by Donegal County Council.
- To date 92% of Grant Calculations have been processed or returned to the applicant for follow up.
- The Grant Calculations are ongoing with required resources allocated. This important aspect of the Scheme will be kept under review.

To date, **97.8%** of applications assessed by the Housing Agency have been determined to meet the Damage Threshold.

2.2 Remediation Option & Grant Amount

To date, the Housing Agency have decided the Remedial Option Grant on **29.7%** of the applications which have been determined to have met the Damage Threshold under the provisions of the Enhanced Scheme.

This further development enables all approved applicants to submit their Payment Claims to Donegal County Council, in respect of remediation works and ancillary grants, via their Online Portal facility.

Figure 4.1: Overview of Applications received under the Enhanced DCB Scheme




Under the Remediation of Dwellings Damaged by the Use of Defective Concrete Blocks Act 2022, applicants are required to submit their Notice of Commencement of their Remedial Works to the Council. This facility is available to approved applicants through their Online Portal and in accordance with the Act, Notices of Commencement must be submitted not more than 14 days prior to commencement of their remedial works and not less than 7 days prior to the commencement of remedial works.
