I write with regard to the current Variation of the County Donegal Development Plan which seeks to place some reasonable restraints on the future rollout of wind turbines in the county. I fully support the proposals that the Gweebarra River Valley, Areas of Especially High Scenic Amenity, St John's Point, areas prone to landslides and our Freshwater Pearl Mussel River catchments will be EXCLUDED from areas open to wind farm development for the remainder of the 2018-2024 Plan, and furthermore, I use this same submission to ask that these wind energy proposals in this Variation be carried forward into the 2024-2030 County Donegal Development Plans.

I wish to see our traditional farming practices continue. I don't want to see our landscapes despoiled by any more wind turbines.
