**Notice Pursuant to Article 81, Part 8 of the above Regulations, relating to a proposed development by Donegal County Council**

**Applicant:** Donegal County Council (Taking in Charge Unit)

**Location:** Dromore, Killygordon, Co. Donegal

**Proposal:** Pursuant to the requirement of the above, notice is hereby given of intention to demolish the existing defective and environmentally hazardous wastewater pumping station at Dromore Park estate and construct a new wastewater pumping station comprising of underground chambers, 2 no. 2m high kiosks, 2 no. 1.4m high kiosks, 6.5m vent stack, 2.4m high wire mesh boundary fencing, approx. 390m of 225mm diameter gravity sewer and 390m of 80mm diameter rising main laid in the adjoining L-2944-3 local road, and all associated site development works at Dromore, Killygordon, Co. Donegal.

Plans and particulars of the proposed development may be inspected or purchased at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy from Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> June to Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2021, during public opening hours at the offices of the Planning Authority at County House, Lifford, Co. Note that in accordance with Article 120(1)(b)(i) of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended) Donegal County Council has concluded, based on a preliminary examination of the nature, size and location of the development, that an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) is not required.
