Notice is hereby given that Donegal County Council intends to make an Order to have the following roads closed to traffic on the dates and times indicated to facilitate the Donegal Motor Club Harvest Stages Rally 2019.

Stages 1 + 4 + 7 - Iskaheen Stage (Closed from 09.15hrs to 18.35hrs):

Starting from “Keedy to Iskaheen to Gortin to Trabracken to Clonelly Roads” (L-1891-2, L-1911-1&2, L-7441-1, L-1791-2, L-72811-0, L1811-1, L-1821-2)

Alternative Route:

Local diversions in place during stages

Stages 2 + 5 + 8 - Coolcross Stage (Closed from 10.00hrs to 19.15hrs):

Starting from “Glassalts to Altashane to Stacummer to Gortaran to Coolcross Roads” (L-5511-1, L-5551-1, L-55511-0, L-11712-2, L-1171-1, L-5481-1, L-1181-1, L-5471-1, L-5461-1, L-1161-2, L-11611-0)

The Alternative Route:

Local diversions in place during stages

Stages 3 + 6 + 9 - Bailey’s Stage (Closed from 10.45hrs to 20.00hrs):

Starting from Drung to Ballyargus to Culleen to Tullyalley to Clar Roads” (L-1391-6&7, L-6191-3, L-6261-1, L-1441-1&2, L-6311-1/2&3)

Alternative Route:

Local diversions in place during stages

Any branch roads leading onto the Roads mentioned above may also be blocked at the junctions for a distance of up to 300m to ensure public safety on the closed roads.

Persons wishing to object to the closure should submit objections in writing to the Roads & Transportation, Donegal County Council, County House, Lifford before **4.00pm on 23rd September 2019.**

In the event of objections being made to the granting of proposed road closures, the Council reserves the right to make the details of the objections available to the licence applicant where it considers it necessary in order to fully consider the validity of any of the objections received.
