Cruinniú na nÓg

Bhí lá náisiúnta na cruthaitheachta do leanaí agus don aos óg ann Dé Sathairn an 13 Meitheamh. Iarradh ar dhaoine óga cuidiú leis an chlár imeachtaí a phleanáil lena chinntiú gur cuireadh a smaointe isteach sa phlean. Bhí an clár bunaithe ar imeachtaí le leanaí agus daoine óga ‘ag déanamh’, ‘ag táirgeadh’, agus ‘ag cruthú’. Toisc go raibh sé go hiomlán ar líne, tharla clár na bliana seo i seomraí suí agus cistineacha ar fud Chontae Dhún na nGall agus ar fud na hÉireann. Ghlac leanaí agus daoine óga páirt i gceardlanna ar líne, mionfhéile cheoil don óige, gearrscannán a eisiúint, agus ranganna teagaisc. I measc na gceardlann bhí scríbhneoireacht chruthaitheach, scríbhneoireacht amhrán, códú, agus craoltóireacht. Sa tionscadal *Recipes for Disaster* chuidigh cócairí óga le ríomhleabhar tiomanta a chur le chéile. Thug an mhionfhéile cheoil óige *Alone Together* deis do cheoltóirí agus leantóirí óga ceoil a bhféile féin a chur le chéile. Bhí an-éileamh go deo ar ghearrscannán *Gathering of the Force*, ní hamháin cionn is go léiríonn sé teacht aniar na ndaoine óga le linn na paidéime, ach fosta de bharr na n-íomhánna iontacha de cheann de na háiteanna is áille i nDún na nGall, Coróin Bhanba i gCionn Mhálanna.

Athbhreithniú

Go náisiúnta, bhí athbhreithniú eatramhach ann ar Phobail Ildánacha. Is é an cuspóir a bhí leis an athbhreithniú (i) machnamh a dhéanamh ar eispéiris agus éifeachtúlacht na bhfoirne áitiúla le cur ar chumas na n-údarás áitiúil an chruthaitheacht a neadú sa bheartas poiblí, agus leis an chruthaitheacht a úsáid mar straitéis don fholláine, comhtháthú sóisialta agus forbairt eacnamaíochta; (ii) an dea-chleachtas a leagan amach; agus (iii) machnamh a dhéanamh ar an chur chuige straitéiseach i dtaca le Colún 2 agus fiosrú conas a d’fhéadfaí an soláthar is fearr a dhéanamh i gcomhar le húdaráis áitiúla amach anseo. Rinneadh cúig mholadh, a bheidh mar bhonn le clár amach anseo.

Cruinniú na nÓg

The national day of creativity for children and young people took place on Saturday, 13th June. Young people were asked to contribute to planning the programme of activities to ensure that their ideas were incorporated into the plan. The programme was activity based with children and young people ‘doing’, ‘making’, and ‘creating’. This year’s programme, being entirely online, took place in living rooms and kitchens throughout County Donegal and across Ireland. Children and young people participated in online workshops, a mini youth music festival, short film release, and tutorials. Workshops included creative writing, song writing, coding, and broadcasting. *Recipes for Disaster* saw budding young chefs contribute to a dedicated eBook. The *Alone Together* youth mini music festival offered young musicians and music fans the chance to put together their very own festival. A short film *Gathering of the Force*, was a huge hit, not only because it represents the resilience of young people throughout the pandemic, but also for the breathtaking footage of one of Donegal’s most scenic areas, Banba’s Crown in Malin Head.

Review

Nationally, an interim review of Creative Communities took place. The purpose of the review was to (i) consider the experiences and effectiveness of the local teams to enable local authorities embed creativity in public policy, and to utilise creativity as a strategy for wellbeing, social cohesion and economic development; (ii) map good practice; and (iii) consider the strategic approach to Pillar 2 and explore how delivery in collaboration with local authorities could be optimised in future. Five recommendations were made, which will inform future programmes.

Seirbhís Leabharlainne

Cuireann Seirbhís Leabharlainne Dhún na nGall rochtain ar fáil do líonra náisiúnta de bhreis agus 333 leabharlann agus níos mó ná 15 mhilliún ní i stoc, chomh maith le bailiúchán náisiúnta de ríomhleabhair agus ríomh-chlosleabhair, nuachtáin ar líne, irisí, ábhar tagartha, cúrsaí teanga agus foghlama.

Mar a tharla do neart seirbhísí le linn 2020, bhí ar ár Seirbhís Leabharlainne dul in oiriúint go gasta agus chuireamar seirbhísí ar fáil ar bhealaí nua le linn na leibhéal éagsúil de shrianta mar thoradh ar an phaindéim COVID-19. Ar leibhéal éagsúla sholáthraíomar seirbhísí amháil: Brabhsáil agus lasacht, Teagmháil agus Bailiúchán agus Seirbhís chun Tí; agus leanúint de na seirbhísí a chuireamar ar fáil ar líne a thairiscint, a chur chun cinn agus a leathnú – acmhainní breise ar líne agus clár imeachtaí ar líne san áireamh.

Mar thoradh nádúrtha ar an phaindéim, bhí fás ollmhór sa tSeirbhís Leabharlainne in úsáid acmhainní ar líne i rith na bliana. Mar shampla, fás 139% i ríomhleabhair ó 2019 go 2020, le hardú ollmhór 512% in úsáid ár n-acmhainní ar líne ar an iomlán.

Library Service

Donegal Library Service provides access to a national network of over 333 libraries and over 15 million items of stock, as well as a national collection of eBooks and eAudiobooks, online newspapers, magazines, reference material, language and learning courses.

Like so many services during 2020, our Library Service had to adapt quickly and delivered services in new ways throughout the different levels of restrictions as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. At various levels we provided: Browse and Borrow, Contact and Collect and Doorstep Delivery services; as well as continuing to offer, promote and extend the services we offered online – including additional online resources and an online events programme.

As a natural consequence of the pandemic, the Library Service saw a huge growth in the use of online resources throughout the year. For example, 139% growth in eBooks from 2019 to 2020, with a whopping 512% increase in the use of our online resources overall.

Seirbhís chun Tí

Rinne an tSeirbhís Leabharlainne iarracht seirbhísí leanúnacha a sholáthar le linn na paindéime. I mí na Samhna tugadh isteach an *Seirbhís chun Tí*, a chuir seirbhís seachadta ar fáil do bhaill an phobail a bhí ag féin-aonrú. Rinneadh iarratais tríd an Aonad Freagartha Pobail COVID-19, a chuir na hiarratais ar aghaidh chuig an tSeirbhís Leabharlainne.

Clár Oiliúna

Le linn na dianghlasála, agus na leibhéil éagsúla de shrianta, thapaigh foireann na leabharlainne an deis le huasoiliúint agus d'fhreastail siad ar chláir oiliúna éagsúla ar líne. San áireamh san oiliúint bhí gach rud ón Fheasacht ar Aois agus Uathachas, go heagarthóireacht físe go *Tús Áite do Léitheoirí*.

Clár Ceart Chun Léitheoireachta

Déanann Seirbhís Leabharlainne Dhún na nGall, le heagraíochtaí comhpháirtíochta, *Plean Gníomhaíochta um Cheart Chun Léitheoireachta* áitiúil bliantúil a dhearadh agus a chomhordú, agus oibríonn leis na comhpháirtithe sin chun é a chur i gcrích.

I bhfianaise na gcúinsí le linn 2020, rinne foireann na leabharlainne oiriúnú an-ghasta agus an-díograiseach chun an clár a bhí beartaithe a chur ar líne. Tá roinnt buaicphointí sa liosta ar chúl an leathanaigh.

Doorstep Delivery

The Library Service strived to provide consistent services throughout the pandemic. In November, the new *Doorstep Delivery Service* was introduced, which provided a delivery service to those members of the community who were self isolating. Requests were made through the COVID-19 Community Response Unit, who referred these on to the Library Service.

Training Programme

During lockdown, and the various levels of restrictions, library staff took the opportunity to up-skill and attended various online training programmes. Training included everything from Age Friendly and Autism Awareness, to video editing, to *Putting Readers First*.

Right to Read Programme

Donegal Library Service, with partner organisations, draws up and coordinates an annual local *Right to Read Action Plan* and works with those partners towards its implementation.

Given the circumstances during 2020, library staff pivoted very quickly and enthusiastically to moving the planned programme online. Some highlights are listed overleaf.

Ghlac níos mó ná 2,000 duine ar fud Dhún na nGall páirt san eachtra chomhoibríoch léitheoireachta le linn Feabhra agus Márta 2020. Is é an leabhar a roghnaíodh *Hopscotch in the Sky*, leis an fhile, dearthóir agus údar Lucinda Jacob. Chuaigh an coiste i gcomhar le Laureate na nÓg Sarah Crossan, chun suim san fhilíocht a mhúscailt. Cé gur tharla an ócáid oscailte mar a bhí pleanáilte, leis an aoi speisialta Denise Blake sa Leabharlann Lárnach an 6 Feabhra, ar an drochuair cuireadh an searmanas deiridh ar ceal de bharr na paindéime. Read DL 2020

Over 2,000 people across Donegal took part in the collective reading adventure during February and March 2020. The book chosen was *Hopscotch in the Sky*, by poet, illustrator and author Lucinda Jacob. The committee teamed up with Laureate na nÓg Sarah Crossan, with the aim of sparking an interest in poetry. While the opening ceremony took place as planned, with special guest Denise Blake in the Central Library on 6th February, the closing ceremony was unfortunately cancelled due to the pandemic. Five workshops were delivered in primary schools across Donegal, and helped children create their own poems which are now housed in the National Laureate na nÓg Archive. Agencies who took part were: Donegal ETB, HSE, Parentstop, School Completion Programme (SCP), Home School Community Liaison (HSCL), LYIT, and the Donegal County Library Service.

Spring into Storytime

The Spring into Storytime programme went online in April due to COVID-19 restrictions. The Library Service delivered online storytelling sessions aimed at families to reinforce the importance of reading at home. The sessions were interactive, fun, and informative with almost 8,000 views of the sessions with Malachy Doyle, Karen Edwards and Boogie Bugs.

Eachtra Léitheoireachta Réaltaí Samhraidh

Is é *Réaltaí Samhraidh* an clár náisiúnta léitheoireachta saor in aisce do leanaí, a bhí ann in 2020 ón 15 Meitheamh go deireadh Lúnasa. I nDún na nGall, chuaigh *Réaltaí Samhraidh* ar líne i mbliana. I measc na n-imeachtaí bhí tráthanna na gceist, tóraíochtaí taisce agus seisiúin scéalaíochta ar líne agus club leabhar léamh os ard. Chuir roinnt leabharlanna seirbhís ar fáil do ‘Bhailiúchán Cosáin’, inar bhailigh leanaí pacáí d’Ealaíona agus Ceardaíocht a fágadh taobh amuigh de dhoras na leabharlainne áitiúla uair sa tseachtain. Ghlac leanaí i nDún na nGall páirt fosta sa chomórtas gearrscéalta náisiúnta dar teideal *An Unexpected Adventure*, agus bhí scéal ó leanbh amháin as Dún na nGall sa bhabhta ceannais. Ghlac 551 leanbh páirt i *Réaltaí Samhraidh* i nDún na nGall i mbliana, ag léamh breis agus 6,300 leabhar agus breis agus 7,000 ríomhleabhar, ríomh-chlosleabhar nó ríomhghreannán.

Féile Ealaíon agus Leabhar Leanaí Wainfest

B'é *Spraoi ó Chian* an téama do Wainfest i mbliana. Mhair an fhéile ón 3-11 Deireadh Fómhair. San áireamh i gclár athshamhlaithe fíorúil na féile bhí 63 imeacht le 8,174 rannpháirtí. Leanaí scoile ab ea 7,852 de na rannpháirtithe agus teaghlaigh ab ea 322 díobh.

Summer Stars Reading Adventure

Summer Stars is the free national reading programme for children, which, in 2020, took place from 15 June until end of August. In Donegal, *Summer Stars* went online this year. Events included quizzes, scavenger hunts and online storytelling sessions and a read-aloud bookclub. Some libraries also provided a ‘Pavement Pickup’ service, where children picked up Arts and Crafts packs left outside the door of their local library once a week. Children in Donegal also took part in the national short story competition entitled *An Unexpected Adventure*, with one Donegal child’s story in the final. 551 children took part in Summer Stars in Donegal this year, reading over 6,300 books and over 7,000 eBooks, eAudiobooks or eComics.

Wainfest Children’s Arts and Book Festival

The theme for Wainfest this year was *Fun from Afar*. The festival ran from the 3-11 October. The re-imagined virtual festival programme included 63 events with 8,174 participants. 7,852 of the participants were school children and 322 were families.

Family Time at Your Library

The year 2020 ended with a fun-filled packed programme of online stories, cookery, letter writing and elves as our *Family Time at your Library* Programme went online. Although this is a literacy based programme that aims to improve family literacy, it is also lots of fun for the family to enjoy together.

Bealtaine Festival of Creativity in Older Age

The planned programme for *Bealtaine* was organised, and the team – comprising the Library, Museum and Archives Services, and the Regional Cultural Centre – were working on preparing the brochure for print when lockdown happened. As a result, much of the programme had to be cancelled or, where possible, moved online. For example, the Library Service and Healthy Ireland at Your Library commissioned Maria Coleman to create a special Chair Yoga Video for Bealtaine festival 2020. This video was aimed at getting people active in a gentle yet effective manner.

Seachtain na hEolaíochta

Bhí *Seachtain na hEolaíochta* ann ar líne ón 8–15 Samhain, agus dhírigh téama na bliana seo *Ár dTodhchaí a Roghnú* ar an chaoi inar féidir leis an eolaíocht feabhas a chur ar ár saol inniu agus sa todhchaí. Cuireadh clár nuálaíoch, cruthaitheach, digiteach eolaíochta ar fáil, ina raibh deis ag leanaí caidreamh a dhéanamh leis na heolaithe Robert Winston, Norah Patten agus Mark Langtry. Sheol an FSS *Making the ‘Big Talk’ many small talks* ar líne an 10 Samhain. Foilsíodh an leabhrán mar chuid den chlár náisiúnta *Éire Shláintiúil i do Leabharlann*, agus ba thoradh é ar chomhoibriú ar dtús i nDún na nGall idir Seirbhís Óige Dhún na nGall, an tSeirbhís Leabharlainne agus Cur Chun Cinn agus Feabhsú Sláinte, FSS. Tá sé d’aidhm ag an leabhrán spreagadh agus tacaíocht a thabhairt do thuismitheoirí agus caomhnóirí comhrá sláintiúil a bheith acu lena leanaí faoina gcoirp, gnéasacht agus caidreamh trí raon de leabhair atá in oiriúint don aois a chur ar fáil trí líonra na leabharlann.

Science Week

Science Week took place online from 8–15 November, and this year’s theme *Choosing our Future* focused on how science can improve our lives today and in the future. An innovative, creative, digital programme of science was delivered, where children had the chance to engage with scientists Robert Winston, Norah Patten and Mark Langtry. The programme included eleven school events, which fifty-six schools registered for, and over 4,000 children participated. The family event was attended by seven families. A very successful Lego competition was held with thirty entrants from across Donegal.

National launch of Making the ‘Big Talk’ many small talks booklet

The HSE launched *Making the ‘Big Talk’ many small talks* online on the 10th November. The booklet was rolled out as part of the national Healthy Ireland at Your Library programme, and was a result of an original collaboration in Donegal between Donegal Youth Service, the Library Service and Health Promotion and Improvement, HSE. The booklet aims to encourage and support parents and guardians to have healthy conversations with their children about their bodies, sexuality and relationships by providing a range of age-appropriate books through the library network.

Tionscadal Digiteach Béaloideasa Colmcille 1500 do Scoileanna

Mar chuid de *Chlár Colmcille 1500* de chuid Chomhairle Contae Dhún na nGall, tá an tSeirbhís Leabharlainne, i gcomhpháirt le Libraries NI, ag obair le The Nerve Centre, Doire ar thionscadal digiteach ar shaol agus seanchas Cholmcille. Tá an Nerve Centre ag obair le 10 scoil ar an dá thaobh den teorainn. Is é an aidhm seanchas Cholmcille a athbheochan agus suim a athmhúscailt i mBailiúchán Béaloideasa na Scoileanna, trí leagan 21ú haois de na scéalta a chur ar fáil i bhformáid le beochan dhigiteach. Cuirfear an tionscadal i gcrích in Aibreán 2021.

Maoiniú na gCuntas Díomhaoin

D'éirigh le Seirbhís Leabharlainne Dhún na nGall cúnamh deontais 90% a fháil a d'fhaomhaigh an Roinn Forbartha Tuaithe agus Pobail (Ciste na gCuntas Díomhaoin) chun tacú le bearta a leagadh amach in *Ár Leabharlanna Poiblí 2022*. Chuir Comhairle Contae Dhún na nGall maoiniú meaitseála 10% ar fáil. Is iad seo a leanas na cúig thionscadal a roghnaíodh agus a faomhadh do Dhún na nGall:

1. *Calm Waters During the Storm: Donegal Tales from a Pandemic* – eagraíodh ceardlanna ar líne sa scríbhneoireacht chruthaitheach le pinsinéirí gníomhacha, agus tiomsaíodh agus cuireadh an saothar i gcló i leabhrán.
2. *Full STEAM ahead* – mheall ceardlann STEAM ar líne tuismitheoirí agus leanaí le linn Wainfest, agus trealamh á sholáthar ag an tSeirbhís Leabharlainne chun píosa beag róbatach a thógáil.
3. *Care Time at Bedtime* – ghlac tuismitheoirí agus leanaí páirt i seisiún 6 seachtaine, 30 nóiméad, de cheol agus gluaiseacht ag am codlata, le 'pacaí barróige' curtha ar fáil ag an tSeirbhís Leabharlainne.
4. Clár cuimsithe d'úsáideoirí leabharlainne atá dall agus a bhfuil lagú radhairc orthu – tá clár saincheaptha beartaithe d'imeachtaí leabharlainne d'úsáideoirí atá dall agus a bhfuil lagú radhairc orthu, lena n-áirítear ceol agus scéalaíocht.
5. *Tacaí Litearthachta Digití* – leis an chlár *Touch-Type Read and Spell (TTRS)* ar líne tugtar an deis do leanaí agus do dhaoine fásta feabhas mór a chur ar a scileanna léitheoireachta, scríbhneoireachta, clóscríbhneoireachta agus uimhríochta.

Colmcille 1500 Digital Schools Folklore Project

As part of Donegal County Council's *Colmcille 1500 Programme*, the Library Service, in partnership with Libraries NI, is working with The Nerve Centre, Derry on a digital project on the life and lore of Colmcille. The Nerve Centre is working with 10 schools on both sides of the border. The aim is to revitalise the folklore of Colmcille and revive interest in the Schools' Folklore Collection, by providing a 21st century version of the stories in a digitally animated format. The project will be completed in April 2021.

Dormant Accounts Funding

Donegal Library Service was successful in obtaining 90% grant assistance approved from the Department of Rural and Community Development (Dormant Accounts Fund) to support measures set out in *Our Public Libraries 2022*. Donegal County Council provided 10% match-funding. The five projects selected and approved for Donegal were:

1. **Calm Waters During the Storm: Donegal Tales from a Pandemic** - online creative writing workshops were held with active retirees, with related work collated and printed in a booklet.
2. **Full STEAM ahead** - a STEAM online workshop engaged parents and children during Wainfest, with kits provided by the Library Service to build a small robotic piece.
3. **Care Time at Bedtime** - parents and children participated in a 6 week, 30 minute, bedtime music and movement session, with 'cuddle packs' provided by the Library Service.
4. **Inclusion programme for blind and visually impaired library users** - a tailored programme of library events for blind and visually impaired users, including music and storytelling is planned.
5. **Digital Literacy Supports** - the **Touch-Type Read and Spell (TTRS)** online programme offers children and adults the opportunity to greatly improve their reading, writing, typing and arithmetic skills.

Clár Maoinithe Ioncaim le haghaidh Comhpháirtíocht Straitéiseach

Chuir Comhairle Contae Dhún na nGall maoiniú ioncaim €107,000 ar fáil do líonra an chontae d’eagraíochtraí ealaíon neamhspleácha – lena n-áirítear Ionad Ealaíon Balor agus Ealaíona Pobail Forbartha Balor, Bealach Féich; Ionad Ealaíon na Mainistreach, Béal Átha Seanaidh; Amharclann Ghaoth Dobhair; Artlink ag Dún Rí; An Gailearaí ag Áislann Ghaoth Dobhair; grúpa ealaíontóirí An Cosán Glas, Gort an Choirce; agus Summer Palace Press ag Cill Chartha.

Scéim Sparánachtaí Ealaíontóirí

Faoin chéad Scéim Sparánachtaí Ealaíontóirí, chuir an Chomhairle sparánachtaí €1,000 an ceann ar fáil do chúigear is daichead d’ealaíontóirí físe, ceoltóirí, cumadóirí, drámadóirí, scríbhneoirí agus déantóirí scannán gairmiúla an chontae. Thug na sparánachtaí, a bhí á gcomh-mhaoiniú ag Comhairle Contae Dhún na nGall agus Éire Ildánach, tacaíocht dhíreach le cur ar chumas ealaíontóirí a gcleachtas a choimeád agus aitheantas á thabhairt don méid a chuireann siad leis an tsochaí agus folláine, go háirithe sna hamanna seo nach raibh a leithéid ann riamh cheana.

Strategic Partnership Revenue Funding Programme

Donegal County Council provided revenue funding of €107,000 to the county’s network of independent arts organisations – including Balor Arts Centre and Balor Developmental Community Arts, Ballybofey; Abbey Arts Centre, Ballyshannon; Amharclann Ghaoth Dobhair; Artlink at Fort Dunree; An Gailearaí at Áislann Ghaoth Dobhair; An Cosán Glas artists group, Gort a’Choirce; and Summer Palace Press at Cill Chartha.

Artist Bursary Scheme

Under its inaugural Artist Bursary Scheme, the Council provided bursaries of €1,000 each to forty five of the county’s professional visual artists, musicians, composers, dramatists, writers and film-makers. The bursaries, which were funded jointly by Donegal County Council and Creative Ireland, provided direct support to enable artists sustain their practice while acknowledging the vital contribution they make to society and well-being, especially in these unprecedented times.

Oíche Chultúir

Chuir Músaem Contae Dhún na nGall, an Leabharlann Lárnach, an tIonad Cultúrtha Réigiúnach agus Amharclann an Ghrianáin imeachtaí fisiciúla i láthair do lucht féachana beo a bhí sábháilte agus a chloígh leis na treoirlínte dochta ón rialtas.


I measc na n-imeachtaí bríomhara a cruthaíodh go speisialta don Oíche Chultúir bhí cúig ghearrscannán, a thaitin go han-mhór le daoine, ag cur na bithéagsúlachta chun cinn, a choimisiúnaigh an Oifig Oidhreachta; ceardlann do scríbhneoirí óga le rannpháirtithe as Dún na nGall agus Bostún; agus píosa speisialta a chruthaigh ambasadóir Dhún na nGall don Oíche Chultúir, *Little John Nee*. I measc na mbuaicphointí eile bhí *Seisiúin* den chéad scoth ag an Ionad Cultúrtha Réigiúnach, turas treoraithe le Gailearaí na Gléibe ar Theach na Gléibe, ócáid *Black, Traveller agus Roma Lives Matter* le Tionscadal Lucht Siúil Dhún na nGall; clár gearrscannán Artworks; agus sraith ceolchoirmeacha ó Mhná an Atlantaigh Fhiáin. Tá cuid mhór den ábhar seo ar fáil le feiceáil ar chainéal YouTube Chomhairle Contae Dhún na nGall. D'fhéach breis agus 12,000 duine ar an ábhar laistigh de sheachtain ón ócáid.

Culture Night

Despite challenges posed by COVID-19, *Culture Night* took place on Friday, 18 September. The event stands out as an example of the resourcefulness and creativity of the artists, venues and programmers who are dedicated to showcasing local culture. Donegal County Museum, the Central Library, the Regional Cultural Centre and An Grianán Theatre each presented physical events to live audiences that were safe and met the strict government guidelines.


The vibrant array of online events created especially for Culture Night included five particularly well received short films promoting biodiversity, commissioned by the Heritage Office; a young writers workshop with participants from Donegal and Boston; and a special piece created by Donegal's Culture Night ambassador, *Little John Nee*. Other highlights included the Regional Cultural Centre's excellent *RCC Sessions*, the Glebe Gallery's guided tour of Glebe House, the Donegal Travellers Project's *Black, Traveller and Roma Lives Matter* event; the Artworks film shorts programme; and the Wild Atlantic Womens' concert series. Much of this material is available to view on the Donegal County Council Youtube channel. Over 12,000 people had viewed the content within a week of the event.

Cé nach bhféadfaí taibhithe beo a bheith ann, chuir an fhéile clár suntasach ar líne i láthair ina raibh sraith drámaíochta ceithre pháirt san áireamh - *Drumshee Days*, *le Dark Daughter Productions* - a craoladh ar cheithre oíche Aoine as a chéile; chomh maith le sraith de cheithre ceolchoirm a chruthaigh Treehouse, le healaíontóirí as Dún na nGall agus Doire. Donegal Bay and Blue Stacks Festival

The 20th Donegal Bay and Blue Stacks Festival took place from 25 September-18 October 2020, while the county was in level 3 COVID-19 lockdown. Though no live performances could take place, the festival did present a significant online programme which included a four-part drama series - *Drumshee Days*, by *Dark Daughter Productions* - which was broadcast on consecutive Friday evenings over the festival; as well as a series of four concert performances created by Treehouse, featuring artists from Donegal and Derry. Singers Deborah Cunningham and Paul Martin, with pianist Evan McGarrigle, performed a wonderful programme of operatic gems from *La Traviata*, *Sweeney Todd* and *Candide* at Harvey's Point Hotel, Lough Eske; while a livestream broadcast hosted by poet Denise Blake from the Abbey Arts Centre featured novelists Elaine Feeney and Helen Cullen.

Public Art

The Arts Service advised and assisted the Donegal Roads Office to commission two major public art works under the *Per Cent for Art* Scheme, associated with capital works on the N56 at Coolboy to Kilmacrennan and at An Clochán Liath to Glenties, from artists Niall Bruton and Redmond Herryty respectively. The Council also partnered with Údarás na Gaeltachta to commission Polestar artist Locky Morris to create a new public art work for Áislann Ghaoth Dobhair, home to Leabharlann Phobail Ghaoth Dobhair and An Gailearaí.

Infheistiú i Saothair Nua Ealaíne a Chruthú i nDún na nGall

Ceann de na ról is tábhachtaí ag an tSeirbhís Ealaíon is ea spreagadh a thabhairt do chruthú agus cur i láthair saothair nua ealaíne sa chontae. Chuidigh an tSeirbhís Ealaíon le sé léiriú drámaíochta in 2020. Faoi dheireadh, rinneadh scannánú ar *Sister Black* le Margaret Hannon, ar chuir srianta COVID-19 i mí Iúil agus Deireadh Fómhair cosc air, agus chuir Amharclann an Ghrianáin i láthair ar líne é i mí na Samhna. Lean Maura Logue dá cur i láthair don Chónaitheacht san Ionad Cultúrtha Réigiúnach dá dráma *Housekeeper* i mí Bealtaine le taibhiú ar líne dá sraith drámaí *Drumshee Days* lena comhpháirtí ceoil David Ison, i Meán Fómhair agus Deireadh Fómhair. Cuidíodh le dhá léiriú eile – léiriú Balor Rep le Conal Gallen ar dhráma nua le Brian Walsh agus léiriú Workhouse Theatre ar *Philadelphia, Here I Come!* – agus iad á gcleachtadh agus, de bharr srianta COVID-19 cuirfear i láthair iad go luath in 2021.

D'éirigh le léiriú amháin, áfach, na dianghlásálacha COVID-19 a sheachaint. Bhí ocht léiriú, scartha go sóisialta, de *Alice In Murvagh*, cóiríú aisteach le Chloë Murphy den leabhar cáiliúil le Lewis Carroll, á léiriú ag Sarah Jane Woods agus á stiúradh ag Sinéad O'Donnell-Carey, a díoladh amach ag Foraíis Mhurbhach, thar dhá dheireadh seachtaine i mí Lúnasa.

Cuireadh chun Comhoibrithe – Ag Obair i gComhthéacsanna Idirchultúrtha

I mí an Mheithimh, sheol tionscadal Ilchineálachta Cultúrtha, ina raibh an tSeirbhís Ealaíon ina páirtí le Comhairle Contae Mhaigh Eo (príomhpháirtí) agus Comhairle Contae Bhaile Átha Cliath Theas, a fhoilseachán *Working In Intercultural Contexts – Guide for Local Authorities agus Cultural Providers*. Tá sé d'aidhm ag an treoir bheith mar fhoinsé spreagtha agus cúnamh d'údaráis áitiúla agus soláthraithe cultúrtha tosú ar an phróiseas conas, trí chomhairliúchán pobail, a d'fhéadfaidís forbairt a dhéanamh ar raon de sheirbhísí cultúrtha saincheaptha is mó a mheallfaidh daoine ó chúlraí éagsúla cultúrtha. Fuair an tionscadal maoiniú ó chlár na Comhairle Ealaíon *Cuireadh chun Comhoibrithe*.

Investing in the Creation of New Artistic Work in Donegal

One of the most important roles of the Arts Service is that of encouraging the creation and presentation of new artistic work in the county. Six drama productions were assisted by the Arts Service in 2020. Margaret Hannon's *Sister Black*, having fallen foul of COVID-19 restrictions in July and October, was eventually filmed and presented online by An Grianán Theatre in November. Maura Logue followed up her Regional Cultural Centre Residency presentation of her *Housekeeper* play in May with an online performance of her four-part *Drumshee Days* drama series with musical partner David Ison, in September and October. Two further shows – Balor Rep's presentation with Conal Gallen of a new play by Brian Walsh and Workhouse Theatre's production of *Philadelphia, Here I Come!* – were assisted in rehearsal and, due to COVID-19 restrictions will now be presented in early 2021.

One production however, did manage to avoid the COVID-19 lockdowns. *Alice In Murvagh*, a quirky adaptation by Chloë Murphy of the Lewis Carroll classic, produced by Sarah Jane Woods and directed by Sinéad O'Donnell-Carey, enjoyed eight socially distanced, sold-out performances at Murvagh Forest, over two weekends in August.

Invitation to Collaboration – Working In Intercultural Contexts

In June, the Cultural Diversity project in which the Arts Service partnered with Mayo (lead partner) and South Dublin County Councils launched its *Working In Intercultural Contexts – Guide for Local Authorities and Cultural Providers* publication. The guide aims to be a source of encouragement and help to local authorities and cultural providers to begin the process of how, through community consultation, they might develop a range of tailored cultural services that engage most effectively with people from culturally diverse backgrounds. The project was funded through the Arts Council's *Invitation To Collaboration* programme.

Amharclann an Ghrianáin

Dhruid Amharclann an Ghrianáin na doirse ar an 12 Márta 2020, mar fhreagra ar leathnú COVID-19. I ndiaidh a bheith dúnta ar feadh cúig mhí, d'athoscail an amharclann ag druidim le deireadh an tsamhraidh 2020 le *The Murrigan* – píosa drámaíochta do leanaí le Louise Conaghan – agus ceardlann samhraidh, *Acting Friel*, arna héascú ag Sean Donegan agus Tonya Sheina.

Ag Tacú agus ag Coimisiúnú Saothair Nua

Mar thoradh ar an dara ráig de COVID-19 ag druidim le deireadh Mheán Fómhair bhí gá le dúnadh eile, ach leanadh den obair ar an amharclannaíocht taobh thiar de na doirse dúnta. Chuir an Grianán deiseanna forbartha agus cuidiú léirithe ar fáil d'ealaíontóirí Dhún na nGall lena n-áirítear Patrick Quinn agus a dhráma *Revved*, ceoldráma nua le Séimí Campbell agus an dráma *Sister Black* le Margaret Hannon. An Grianán Theatre

An Grianán Theatre closed its doors on 12 March 2020, in response to the spread of COVID-19. To that point, the theatre had delivered a diverse programme featuring performances by Sharon Shannon, Neil Delamere, Jack Lukeman, Irish National Opera's *Hansel and Gretel*, Livin Dred's play *Trad*, featuring Seamus O'Rourke, and an immersive production of *Bugsy Malone*, performed by An Grianán Youth Theatre and On Cue Performing Arts.

After a five-month closure, the theatre re-opened in late summer 2020 with *The Murrigan* – a childrens' theatre piece by Louise Conaghan – and a summer workshop, *Acting Friel*, facilitated by Sean Donegan and Tonya Sheina.

Supporting and Commissioning New Work


A second COVID-19 wave in late September necessitated a further closure, but the work of theatre-making continued behind closed doors. As such, An Grianán provided development opportunities and production assistance to Donegal artists including Patrick Quinn and his play *Revved*, a new musical by Séimí Campbell and Margaret Hannon's *Sister Black* play. In addition, through its *Let's Make Some Noise* programme, the theatre awarded bursaries to Éirú Dance Company, Miranda Rosenberg, Lorcan Strain, Brenda Kelly and Orson Sterritt towards their creation of new work in 2020 and 2021. Furthermore, Sarah Jane Scott was commissioned to write a new play, as was Mairéad Ní Mhaonaigh whose new musical suite will be premiered at Letterkenny Trad Week in early 2021.

Clár Srutháin

Rinneadh suíomhanna agus sainchomharthaí aitheanta ar fud an chontae a thabhairt chun suntais i scannáin den scoth, ó Inis Eoghain, áit a ndearna Ryan Vail agus Ceolfhoireann Elma taibhiú ag Dún an Líonáin, go Leitir Ceanainn áit ar taifeadadh Iarla Ó Lionáird agus Steve Cooney i dTeach Rockhill agus na Henry Girls ag Castlegrove. In Le Sruth Líonta leis na Baird Nua-Aoiseacha rinneadh taifeadadh ar aistear álainn i gcurrach leis an scríbhneoir agus déantóir scannán Eoghan Mac Giolla Bhríde go hOileán Ghabhla, agus in Oíche Airneáil ag Dámhlann an Ghleanna taispeánadh tírdhreach álainn gharbh Ghaeltacht Iarthar Dhún na nGall, le filíocht le Cathal Ó Searcaigh agus ceol agus amhránaíocht le Maighréad agus Tríona Ní Dhomhnaill.

Earagail Arts Festival

With the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, it was clear that Earagail Arts Festival could not happen in its traditional format in 2020. In response, the festival developed its innovative *Srutháin* ('small streams') online programme of commissioned, pre-recorded filmed works and performances, which ran from 9-26 July. This provided the festival with an opportunity to reach and engage with audiences from all over the world.

Srutháin Programme

Iconic locations and landmarks around the county were highlighted in cinematic quality, from Inishowen where Ryan Vail and Elma Orchestra performed at the stunning Leenan Fort, to Letterkenny where Iarla Ó Lionáird and Steve Cooney were recorded at Rockhill House and The Henry Girls performed at Castlegrove. Na Baird Nua-Aoiseacha's Le Sruth Líonta captured a beautiful currach journey by writer and film-maker Eoghan Mac Giolla Bhríde to Oileán Ghabhla, while Oíche Airneáil at Dámhlann an Ghleanna displayed the landscape of the West Donegal Gaeltacht in all its rugged beauty, accentuating the poetry of Cathal Ó Searcaigh and the music and song of Maighréad and Tríona Ní Dhomhnaill.

Other online and streamed highlights included commissions and documentary films featuring Fídil, Na Mooneys, Éiríú Dance Company, Citadels of The Sun, visual artist Christy Keeney and the Glebe House and Gallery.

Camchuairt Bheo Amharclainne

Nuair a cuireadh deireadh le roinnt mhaith de na srianta a bhain le COVID-19 in Iúil 2020, bhí áthas ar eagraitheoirí na féile sraith amháin d'imeachtaí faoin aer a óstáil, le lucht féachana fisiciúil, an seó mealltach *The Tilt of The Sky* le Little John Nee, agus scaradh sóisialta ann. Thug an seó taistil amharclainne cuairt ar Mhálainn, Cúil Dabhcha, Leitir Ceanainn, Gort an Choirce, Dún Fionnachaidh agus Ráth Bhoth, ag críochnú le taibhiú a díoladh amach sa ghairdín i dTeach Ráth Maoláin. Buaicphointe ab ea ócáid fhisiciúil dheiridh na féile don ealaíontóir, na pátrúin agus foireann na féile i samhradh ina raibh idirghníomhaíocht shóisialta agus eispéireas traidisiúnta na féile go mór ar iarraidh.

Public Engagement

Srutháin events were enjoyed by over 14,000 patrons around Ireland, the United Kingdom, the United States, India, Germany, France, China, The Netherlands, Australia and Canada. In addition, the Festival was delighted to team up with Ireland's No.1 local radio station, Highland Radio, for a special simulcast of four *Srutháin* events - The Henry Girls, Iarla Ó Lionáird and Steve Cooney as well as Little John Nee's radio play *The Jumpin' Inn* and *The Ghostlight Sessions* with Joshua Burnside and Kate O'Callaghan at the Balor Arts Centre.

Live Theatre Touring

With the lifting of many of the COVID-19 related restrictions in July 2020, the festival was delighted to host one series of outdoor events with physical audiences, Little John Nee's engaging, socially-distanced show, *The Tilt of The Sky*. The pop-up touring theatre show visited Malin, Culdaff, Letterkenny, Gort a'Choirce, Dunfanaghy and Raphoe, culminating in a sold-out performance on the lawns at Rathmullan House. The festival's closing, physical event marked a real high for the artist, patrons and festival staff in what was a summer starved of social interaction and the traditional festival experience.

Regional Cultural Centre

Rated as ‘one of the finest arts facilities in the country’ by The Irish Times, the RCC has presented a full programme of high-quality arts and community activities since it opened in 2007. The programme is made possible by annual funding from the Arts Council, Donegal County Council and project funding from a variety of sources.

B'é an tIonad Cultúrtha Réigiúnach an chéad eagraíocht ealaíon in Éirinn lena chlár oibre a thionú le díriú ar mheáin dhigiteacha agus ar líne le linn céimeanna tosaigh na paidéime COVID-19.

Cuireadh ceolchoirmeacha rialta i láthair ar líne i rith na bliana, ina raibh raon taibheoirí ó Iar-Thuaisceart na hÉireann. Thug na ceolchoirmeacha seo tacaíocht airgeadais riachtanach do líon mór ceoltóirí agus rinne siad siamsa do lucht féachana ar fud an chontae agus níos faide anonn. Bhain breis agus 150,000 duine taitneamh as an chlár ceolchoirmeacha ar líne ón Ionad Cultúrtha Réigiúnach in 2020, agus tá athrú ar ár lucht féachana rialta i bhfad amach ón aimsiú traidisiúnta, le pobail an diaspóra ar fud an domhain i gcaidreamh le ceoltóirí Dhún na nGall trínár n-ábhar ar líne.

Bringing the Best Local and International Music to Donegal

The RCC, one of the most highly regarded and versatile music venues in the country, continued its music development programme in partnership with Earagail Arts Festival and the Donegal Music Education Partnership. The 2020 music programme began in style with a highly successful Letterkenny Trad Week, which saw multiple sold out performances by a selection of the finest traditional musicians in the world. The programme continued with a selection of folk, classical and rock concerts in February and early March but went ‘online’ after COVID-19 restrictions were introduced.

Using Online as our Stage

The RCC was the first arts organisation in Ireland to pivot its work programme to focus on digital and online mediums during the initial stages of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Regular online concerts were presented throughout the year, featuring an eclectic range of performers from the North West of Ireland. These concerts served to provide vital financial support to a large number of musicians and to entertain audiences throughout the county and much further afield. Over 150,000 people have enjoyed the RCC’s online 2020 concert programme, and our regular audience has diversified beyond its traditional reach, with diaspora communities across the world engaging with Donegal musicians through our online content.

These concerts ‘stood out from the crowd’ because of exemplary production values and a high standard of music.

Innovation: Virtual Artist-in-Residencies

The RCC developed and launched Ireland's first series of 'virtual' artist residencies as a response to the national closure of cultural venues. These commissions saw a wide range of artists deliver work through social media platforms and the RCC's website. Examples of RCC Virtual Artist-in-Residence include theatre performers Little John Nee and Maura Logue, digital artist Joe Fahy, songwriter Sarah Cullen, stone sculptor Redmond Herrity, musician Seamus McGuire, photographers Omar Yashruti, Vukašin Nedeljković, Declan Devlin and Dragana Jurišić, and many more.

Between March and December 2020, over 178 artists, musicians and creative sector workers were commissioned by the RCC to create and/or perform work as part of its general programme.

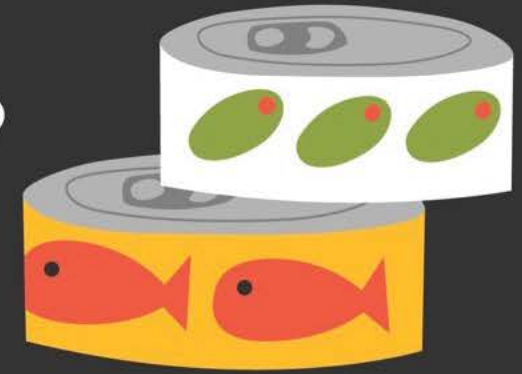
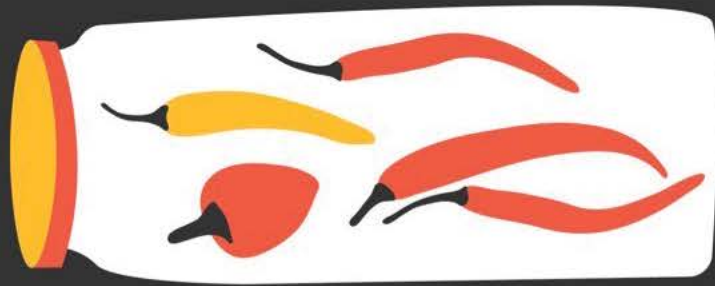
RCC Young Artists

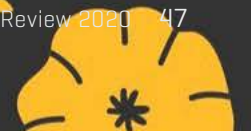
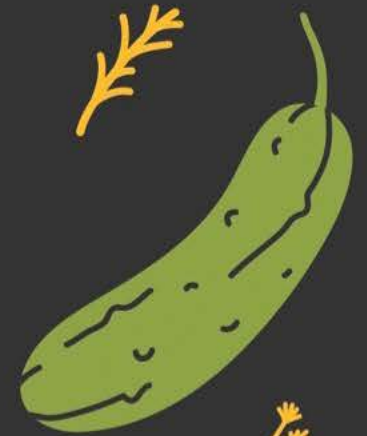
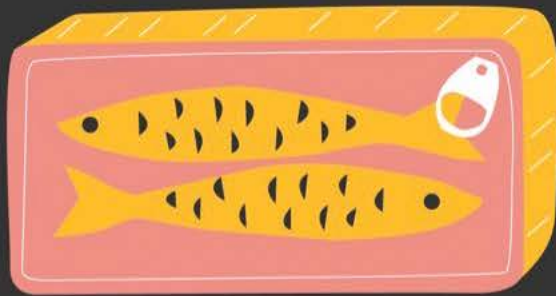

Visual Arts

Although pandemic restrictions meant that galleries were only permitted to be open to the public for five months of the year, the RCC ensured that a high-quality physical visual arts programme was presented for these months, featuring international and leading local artists in a series of solo and group shows.

Three large-scale exhibitions were produced in RCC Gallery 1 during 2020.

1. **The Yalta Game** – curated by Declan Sheehan and featuring artists Susan MacWilliam, Myrid Carten and historic works by James Glass.
2. **Over Nature** – curated by Valeria Ceregini and featuring work by Shane Finan, Beata Piekarska-Daly, Mary O’Connor, Louis Haugh, Guillaume Combal and Kathy Herbert.
3. **PLASTIC** – curated by Science Gallery Dublin, and featuring work by over 20 Irish and international artists and designers.

Our Gallery 2 and Foyer spaces hosted solo exhibitions from Donegal based English artists Sarah Lewtas and Liz Doyle, and leading Lettekenny artists Peadar McDaid and Philip Mackey.

Donegal Music Education Partnership (DMEP)

The DMEP is based in the RCC, and the two organisations work closely together, including the joint promotion of RCC concerts and the facilitation of workshops to accompany the Music Network concert series. The DMEP account for a significant proportion of the RCC's activities, including regular weekly classes and rehearsals for various youth and adult ensembles. During COVID-19 restrictions, these classes were moved to online platforms.

RCC Peace IV Projects

Tales of the Troubles:

A Documentary and Media Project featuring Children and Grandparents from both sides of the Border.

We might have had multiple lockdowns and countless restrictions but it didn't stop school kids from across Donegal, Derry and Tyrone partaking in fun and educational online training sessions with Donegal media trainers Póca Productions. The workshops involved learning to use smartphones, tablets and iPads as video cameras, storyboarding their films, looking at interview techniques and plenty of other important skills that might lead to future successful careers in the film industry.

These workshops also encouraged participants to film interviews with their grandparents or parents and capture memories of their life growing up in the North West during the troubles. After the workshops, film director Keith O'Grady and his crew conducted professional follow up interviews with a number of participants and will now begin to make a new documentary film with all the amazing stories.

The documentary film will make its online premiere in February as part of Rathmullan Film Festival and physical screenings at the Regional Cultural Centre, Letterkenny and The Nerve Centre, Derry, once COVID-19 restrictions allow.

CINE Project

The Museum continued its work on the *Connected Culture and Natural Heritage in a Northern Environment [CINE]* project, a collaborative digital heritage project between partners from Norway, Iceland, Ireland and Scotland and funded by the *Northern and Arctic Periphery Programme [ERDF]*. In the spring, facilitator Guy Barriscale worked with the community of Inch to gather stories, images and artefacts relating to the history of the island. Using the material collected, and in collaboration with our partners in Ulster University, the Museum created www.inchheritage.org, a virtual exhibition which showcases the history and heritage of Inch Island. Following this case study, a co-production best practice manual was developed entitled *Meitheal* coproductionguide.com. During Heritage Week, in August, the Museum launched a new website www.virtualstcatherines.net which allows people to visualise the built heritage of St Catherine's Church and graveyard in Killybegs from a new perspective. A further output of the *CINE* project is www.cinecommunities.org which provides a series of 'getting started' guides for a range of digital tools to assist communities in creating and presenting their heritage.

Decade of Centenaries

The Museum wrote and produced a booklet on the theme of the Decade of Centenaries entitled *From Conflict to Division: County Donegal 1919-1925*. The booklet explores the impact of the War of Independence, Partition, and the Civil War on people and communities in County Donegal. It is available both online and in hard copy.

Voices from the Past: - Donegal County Museum, the Regional Cultural Centre and the Museum and Heritage Service of Derry City and Strabane District Council in association with *Dark Daughter Productions*, created six short video pieces highlighting the experiences of women from different backgrounds during the revolutionary period (1919-1925).

Both these projects were supported by the Department of Tourism, Culture, Arts, Gaeltacht, Sport and Media under the *Decade of Centenaries 2012-2023 Initiative*.

Tionscadal Reimagine le Fondúireacht Ailtireachta na hÉireann

Mar chuid de *Reimagine Letterkenny*, cuireadh comharthaí sealadacha agus marcóirí bealaigh chun an nasc fisiciúil idir an Músaem, an Amharclann agus an tIonad Cultúrtha Réigiúnach a chur chun cinn. Beidh an fhorbairt amach anseo ar dhorchla cultúrtha a nascann na foirgnimh seo ina chuid den phróiseas máistirphleanála do Leitir Ceanainn, arna mhaoiniú tríd an Choiste Athghiniúna agus Forbartha Uirbí.

Stair á Cruthú – Eispéiris COVID-19 Dhún na nGall a bhailiú

Sheol Rannán Cultúir Chomhairle Contae Dhún na nGall an tionscadal, *Stair á Cruthú – Eispéiris COVID-19 Dhún na nGall a bhailiú*, chun scéalta faoin saol le linn na Paidéime COVID-19 a ghabháil, a dhoiciméadú agus a chaomhnú. Bhí an Rannán Cultúir ag iarraidh eispéiris laethúla faoin saol le linn na paidéime a ghabháil, ó raon leathan de dhaoine le jabanna éagsúla, róil phobail éagsúla agus suíomhanna teaghlaigh éagsúla. Iarradh ar an phobal a scéalta a roinnt i bhformáid ar bith amhail litreacha, dialanna, scríbhneoireacht chruthaitheach, líníocht, grianghraif agus dialanna físe. Bhí an Músaem ag lorg rudaí fosta a bhaineann le COVID-19 lena n-áirítear comharthaíocht PPE, póstaer, bileoga etc.

Re-imagine Project with the Irish Architectural Foundation

Throughout the year, the Museum collaborated with An Grianán Theatre and the Regional Culture Centre (RCC) in Letterkenny on *Reimagine*, an Irish Architecture Foundation project, supported by the Creative Ireland Programme's National Creativity Fund. *Reimagine* is a community-led architecture and design programme, which brings together local communities, architects, designers and planners to develop projects which will enhance the local built environment. As part of *Reimagine Letterkenny*, temporary signage and way finding markers were installed to promote the physical linkage between the Museum, the Theatre and the RCC. The future development of a cultural corridor linking these buildings will also form part of the master planning process for Letterkenny, funded through the Urban Regeneration and Development Fund.

History in the Making – Collecting Donegal's COVID-19 experiences

The Culture Division of Donegal County Council launched the project, *History in the Making – Collecting Donegal's COVID-19 Experiences*, to capture, document and preserve stories of life during the COVID-19 Pandemic. The Culture Division sought to capture the first-hand everyday experiences of life during the pandemic, from a wide variety of people with different jobs, community roles and family situations. The public were asked to share their experiences in any format including letters, diaries, creative writing, drawings, photographs and video diaries. The Museum also requested objects that relate to COVID-19 including PPE signage, posters, leaflets etc.

Exhibitions and Events

The Museum opened the exhibition, *The Railways of County Donegal*, in August, in association with the Archives Service. The exhibition explores the history of the Londonderry and Lough Swilly Railway, the County Donegal Railways and The Great Northern Railway, and features the photographs of A.M. Davies, who travelled the lines during the 1950s and 1960s. In February, the Museum hosted the exhibition, *Naming The Children*, in association with the Raphoe Justice & Peace Group, the Connemara Peace Group and Veterans for Peace Ireland. School workshops were held with Conflict Textiles Curator, Roberta Bacic and as part of the *Peace IV Echoes of the Decade* project. In February, the Museum organised a workshop for Post Primary History Teachers on the history and heritage resources available in the Culture Division. The Museum welcomed Robert Owen-Jones, Head of Mission at the Australian Embassy, in March. In December, the Museum launched the project *UnCover and ReDiscover Your Locality* in collaboration with the Donegal Volunteer Centre. The project encourages participants to explore the heritage of their own locality and share what they discover with the Museum. The Museum also augmented its online offering throughout the year including exhibitions and educational material on a variety of subjects. Colmcille 1500

Fuair Músaem Contae Dhún na nGall dhá dheontas ón Roinn Turasóireachta, Cultúir, Ealaíon, Gaeltachta, Spóirt agus Meán do thaispeántas chun Colmcille 1500 a cheiliúradh in 2021. Faoi scéim *Comhoibriú le Tuaisceart Éireann* na bliana 2020, bronnadh €15,000 mar pháirtmhaoiniú ar thaispeántas in 2021 a dhearadh agus a sheachadadh, i gcomhar le Seirbhís Músaem Chomhairle Chathair Dhoire agus Cheantar an tSraitha Báin. Cuireadh tús leis an obair ar dhearadh agus forbairt an taispeántais, *Colmcille – Man & Myths*, a bheidh ar siúl sa Mhúsaem ó Mheán Fómhair 2021 go Feabhra 2022. D'éirigh leis an Mhúsaem fosta deontas a fháil faoi *Scéim na Músaem Réigiúnach* chun teicneolaíocht dhigiteach a cheannach is féidir a úsáid mar chuid den taispeántas ar Cholmcille.



Colmcille 1500

Donegal County Museum was awarded two grants by the Department of Tourism, Culture, Arts, Gaeltacht, Sport and Media towards an exhibition to celebrate Colmcille 1500 in 2021. Under the 2020 *Co-operation with Northern Ireland Scheme*, €15,000 was granted to part-fund the design and delivery of an exhibition in 2021, in association with Derry City and Strabane District Council's Museum Service. Work began on the design and development of the exhibition, *Colmcille – Man & Myths*, which will be hosted in the Museum from September 2021 to February 2022. The Museum was also successful in obtaining a grant under the *Regional Museums' Scheme* to purchase digital technology that can be incorporated within the Colmcille exhibition.

Archives Service

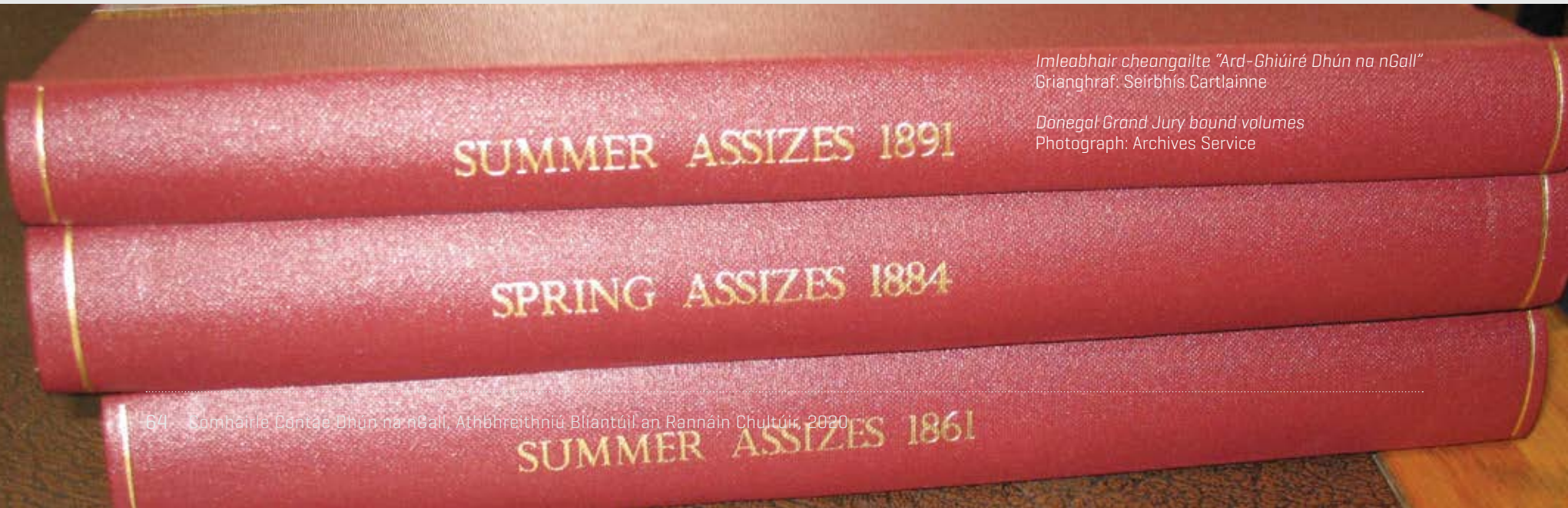
The Archives Service seeks to preserve and make accessible the archival heritage of the people of County Donegal for present and future generations. It does this through the acquisition, cataloguing, conserving and secure storage of collections of public and private origin which relate to the history and culture of Donegal, and through the provision of public access to its archives. The Archives Service works in partnership with many groups and organisations.

Donegal Grand Jury Collection Online

Due to COVID-19, the Archives research room was closed for much of 2020. In order to increase access to its most popular collections and resources, the Archives Service uploaded significant material onto its website. *The Donegal Grand Jury Collection* [1753 to 1898], the Archives' oldest public collection, was uploaded and became accessible to an online audience worldwide. *The Grand Juries* were the predecessor bodies of modern local authorities and had a wide variety of public functions, including construction and maintenance of public roads and bridges, dispensaries, courthouses, schools and the County Jail. *The Donegal Grand Jury Archive* includes presentments, accounts, minutes of meetings, correspondence and photographs. Digitíú ar Bhailiúchán na gComhairlí Ceantair Tuaithe

Cruthaíodh deich gComhairle Ceantair Tuaithe [RDCanna] ar fud Chontae Dhún na nGall faoin Acht Rialtais Áitiúil 1898. Bhí siad freagrach as tithíocht áitiúil, bóithre, soláthar uisce, séarachas agus neart feidhmeanna eile. Tá tábhacht leis na miontuairiscí ar chruinnithe na RDCanna don staidéar ar Dheich mBliana na gCéad Bliain. Le maoiniú seachtrach ó Éire Ildánach agus Deich mBliana na gCéad Bliain, rinneadh leabhair na miontuairiscí RDC ó 1917 - 1925 a dhigitíú in 2020

Digitization of Rural District Councils Collection

Ten Rural District Councils [RDCs] were created across County Donegal under the 1898 Local Government Act. They were responsible for local housing, roads, water supply, sewerage and many other functions. The minutes of meetings of the RDCs are significant for the study of the Decade of Centenaries. With Creative Ireland and Decade of Centenaries external funding, the RDC minute books from 1917 - 1925 were digitized in 2020.

Peace IV: The Echoes of the Decade

A joint Archives and Museum Peace IV funded project entitled *The Echoes of the Decade*, under the ‘Building Positive Relations’ strand, was rolled out in 2020. It includes engagement with young people on the history and legacy of Ireland’s revolutionary years, 1912 – 1923. Following initial workshops with Transition Year students, the project had to go online or be delivered remotely following the closure of schools from mid-March. Alarnagh Barrett McGinley, appointed project coordinator in January, designed and rolled out digital resources for teachers and students and also set up the Facebook Group page: *Echoes of the Decade*, which involved history themed challenges. In September 2020, the project resumed remotely with primary school students, with regular live engagement. This involved a series of workshops, presentations and discussions with Archives and Museum staff, as well as with external history and heritage specialists and artists. The project will continue into early 2021.

As part of the *Echoes of the Decade* project a professional oral historian, Regina Fitzpatrick, was contracted to carry out interviews with 13 older people on the subject of the legacy of the decade of centenaries. This part of the *Echoes* project was completed in December 2020.

Among the acquisitions in 2020 were primary school collections; a 19th century photograph album relating to Lord George Hill and family; documents of the naturalist D.J. Among the collections catalogued were: the Clonleigh Parish Emergency Committee, the Orr and Cochrane families of Strabane and Lifford; and the Dennis Phelan papers, as well as a number of school collections.

Historic Towns Initiatives

Donegal County Council's application for Ramelton to the *Historic Towns Initiative* was successful and was awarded €290,000 in funding from The Heritage Council and the Department of Culture, Heritage and the Gaeltacht. The initiative was prepared and managed by the Heritage Officer and the Conservation Officer, in partnership with the Ramelton Georgian Society, Dedalus Architecture and local owners and residents. The initiative supported conservation works to 14 historic properties along Castle Street, Back Lane, the Market Cross and Bridge Street, that included roof and chimney repairs, installation of cast-iron rainwater goods, reinstatement of timber sash windows and doors, application of lime render, the repair of historic shopfronts using traditional materials and informed by best conservation practice.

At the Irish Planning Institute Awards in Dublin in February 2020, the *Historic Towns Initiative* for Church Lane, Letterkenny (2019) won the *President's Highly Commended Project Award*. The initiative was a cross-directorate partnership between the Heritage Office and Conservation Office, in partnership with the Letterkenny Cathedral Quarter Committee, Dedalus Architecture and property owners. The Historic Towns Initiative experience on Church Lane was presented at the Historic Towns Initiative national workshop in January.

Donegal County Council’s *Thatch Repair Grant Scheme* won the Chambers Ireland *Excellence in Local Government Award* in the ‘Heritage and Built Environment’ category in November. The award recognises the best local authority initiative to promote public interest in, and knowledge, appreciation and protection of local heritage. The Heritage Office and the Conservation Office manages the cross-directorate scheme to provide specialist advice to owners on the conservation of thatch and to allocate funding for small-scale thatch repairs under conservation supervision. The public response to the scheme has been overwhelming again this year and the scheme has supported 26 thatch repair projects.

Supporting Built & Archaeological Heritage

As part of the implementation of the *County Donegal Heritage Plan* and the *Creative Ireland programme*, the Heritage Office commissioned Dr. Breandán Mac Suibhne to undertake a study of ‘The Laurels’ – playwright Brian Friel’s mother’s home in Glenties – to place the building in its social, cultural and historical contexts. In association with the Brian Friel Trust, the Heritage Office supported the conservation and repair of The Laurels’ timber sash windows and doors. Funding was provided by the Department of Housing, Local Government and Heritage under the *Community Monuments Fund*, managed by the Conservation Office and the Heritage Office, for conservation works to Rathmullan Abbey, a conservation plan for Killydonnell Friary and for a research and monitoring project on St. Mura’s Cross Slab, Fahan. As part of the implementation of the County Heritage Plan, the Heritage Office provided part-funding for the *Ballyshannon Conservation Plan* and conservation reports on St. Naul’s Church and graveyard in Inver and the ‘Wooden Bridge’ in Dunlewey.

Oideachas agus Feasacht

Thug an Chomhairle Oidhreachta, i gcomhpháirtíocht leis an Oifig Oidhreachta agus le hIonad Oideachais Dhún na nGall, cuireadh do bhreis agus 70 bunscoil i gContae Dhún na nGall páirt a ghlacadh sa tionscadal píolótach nua don *Chlár Fíorúil Oidhreachta i Scoileanna* – clár fíorúil ocht seachtaine de sheisiúin réamhthaifeadta agus idirghníomhacha beo maidir le gnéithe den oidhreacht do leanaí agus múinteoirí. Mar chuid de Wainfest, agus i gcomhar le Seirbhís Leabharlainne an Chontae, thug an Oifig Oidhreachta urraíocht do Éanna Ní Lamhna gabháil do cheardlanna *Gnáthóga Ildánacha* do Leanaí thar thréimhse ceithre seachtaine i mí na Samhna. Mar ullmhúchán do chomóradh 1,500 bliain ó rugadh Naomh Colmcille in 2021, rinne an Oifig Oidhreachta coimisiúnú ar threoir fuaime oidhreachta 50-nóiméad dar teideal *St. Colmcille's Donegal: a journey through his homeland*, agus leabhar dathúcháin bunaithe ar bheatha Cholmcille agus ar oidhreacht Cholmcille i gContae Dhún na nGall.

Bhí *Seachtain Náisiúnta na hOidhreachta* ann ó 15-23 Lúnasa agus, d'ainneoin na paindéime COVID-19, tugadh faoi 35 tionscadal oidhreachta i gContae Dhún na nGall. Is iad an Chomhairle Oidhreachta agus Oifigí Oidhreachta na nÚdarás Áitiúil a dhéanann comhordú ar Sheachtain na hOidhreachta. Ag na Gradaim Oidhreachta Náisiúnta 2020 i mí Dheireadh Fómhair, bhain trí ghrúpa oidhreachta lonnaithe i nDún na nGall gradaim náisiúnta, agus i mí Feabhra, bhain dhá ghrúpa oidhreachta lonnaithe i nDún na nGall gradaim náisiúnta ag Gradaim Náisiúnta na hOidhreachta 2019.

Education & Awareness

The Heritage Council, in partnership with the Heritage Office and the Donegal Education Centre, invited over 70 primary schools in County Donegal to participate in the new national pilot for the *Heritage in Schools Virtual Programme* – a virtual eight-week programme of pre-recorded and live interactive sessions on aspects of heritage for children and teachers. As part of Wainfest, and in association with the County Library Service, the Heritage Office sponsored Éanna Ní Lamhna to undertake virtual *Creative Habitats* Workshops for Children over a four-week period in November. In preparation for the 1,500th commemoration of the birth of St. Colmcille in 2021, the Heritage Office commissioned a 50-minute audio heritage guide entitled *St. Colmcille's Donegal: a journey through his homeland*, and a colouring book based on the life of Colmcille and Columban heritage in County Donegal.

National Heritage Week took place from 15-23 August, and despite the COVID-19 pandemic, 35 heritage projects were undertaken in County Donegal. Heritage Week is coordinated by The Heritage Council and Local Authority Heritage Officers. At the National Heritage Awards 2020 in October, three Donegal-based heritage groups won national awards, and in February, two Donegal-based heritage groups won national awards at the National Heritage Awards 2019.

Fuair Comhairle Contae Dhún na nGall maoiniú €27,841 ón tSeirbhís Páirceanna Náisiúnta agus Fiadhúlra sa Roinn Cultúir, Oidhreacht agus Gaeltachta faoi mhaoiniú don *Phlean Gníomhaíochta Náisiúnta Bithéagsúlachta* d'údaráis áitiúla do (i) an dara bliain de thionscadal *Cuirliún Pórúcháin na hÉireann a Rianadh le Cairde Éanlaith Éireann*, (ii) measúnú agus mapáil gnáthóg ar 20 reilig stairiúil atá faoi chaomhnóireacht Chomhairle Contae Dhún na nGall; agus (iii) leabhrán a thairgeadh dar teideal *Wildlife in Buildings* i gcomhpháirtíocht le Comhairle Contae Chiarraí agus Cairde Éanlaith Éireann. I gcomhpháirtíocht leis an Oifig Oidhreacht, lean Cairde Éanlaith Éireann den rialú ar Fheannóga chun an Pilibín Pórúcháin a chaomhnú ar Thoraigh.

Cuireadh fáilte iontach mór roimh leabhrán saor in aisce dar teideal *Garraíodóireacht don Bhithéagsúlacht*, a d'fhoilsigh Oifigí Oidhreacht Údarás Áitiúil. Wildlife and Biodiversity Initiatives

Donegal County Council secured €27,841 in funding from the National Parks and Wildlife Service of the Department of Culture, Heritage and the Gaeltacht under the *National Biodiversity Action Plan* funding for local authorities for (i) the second year of a Tracking Irish Breeding Curlew project with BirdWatch Ireland, (ii) habitat assessments and mapping of 20 historic graveyards in the guardianship of Donegal County Council; and (iii) the production of a booklet entitled *Wildlife in Buildings* in partnership with Kerry County Council and BirdWatch Ireland. In partnership with the Heritage Office, BirdWatch Ireland continued corvid control of Hooded Crows for the conservation of Breeding Lapwing on Tory Island.

There was an extraordinary response to the publication of the free booklet entitled *Gardening for Biodiversity*, produced by Local Authority Heritage Officers. The free 40-page booklet, written by Juanita Browne and illustrated by Barry Reynolds, details potential projects and actions to help wildlife of all kinds. As part of Culture Night and the implementation of the County Heritage Plan, the Culture Division has produced a series of five, five-minute videos entitled *Biodiversity in Your Back Garden* that draws upon local expertise and experience of natural heritage specialists and enthusiasts in County Donegal to share their advice on making our gardens, green spaces or towns more wildlife friendly. Local Authority Heritage Offices and Biodiversity Offices in partnership with the National Biodiversity Data Centre continued to sponsor the annual *Local Authority Pollinator Award* as part of the *Tidy Towns Competition* to encourage local groups to implement pollinator-friendly actions in their towns and villages. In May, the Heritage Office undertook a four-week *Connecting People & Nature* biodiversity radio campaign on Ocean FM and Highland Radio, in partnership with the Heritage Offices of Sligo County Council and Leitrim County Council. Local Authority Heritage Offices also supported *Stories from the Waterside* – a story-telling competition run by *Local Authority Waters Programme*.
