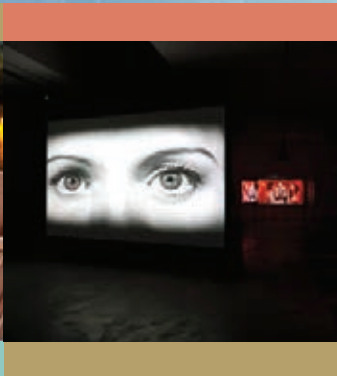
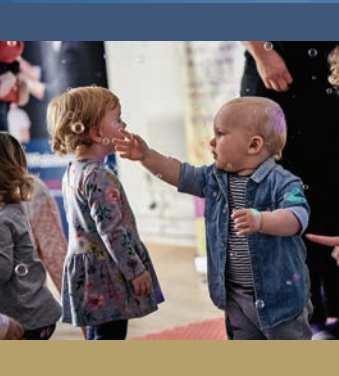

Forbairt an Lucht Rannpháirtíochta

Rinneadh suirbhé bunlíne forbartha lucht rannpháirtíochta Thuaidh-Thiar a sheoladh i gcomhar le Comhairle Chathair Dhoire & Cheantar an tSratha Báin mar chuid de chlár oibre Éire Ildánach 2019. Tá dhá ghné ag baint leis sin, suirbhé daonáirimh i measc 2400 aosach, a bhfuil 1,000 duine díobh lonnaithe i nDún na nGall, agus anailís ar shonraí maidir le ticéid a fuarthas ó eagraíochtaí agus ó ionaid. Déanfar anailís ar thorthaí an tsuirbhé sa bhliain 2020 agus, ina dhiaidh sin, ullmhófar clár píolótach. Is tionscnamh straitéiseach é seo agus bainfear úsáid as chun cinntí a threorú i dtaca le bearta a dhéanfar amach anseo.

Creative Ireland Programme

Audience Development

A North-West audience development baseline survey, in partnership with Derry City & Strabane District Council, formed a major part of the Creative Ireland 2019 work programme. There are two elements: a population survey of 2400 adults, 1000 of which are in Donegal, and ticket data analysis from organisations and venues. The results of the survey will be analysed in 2020, following which a pilot programme will be drawn up. This is a strategic initiative that will guide decisions on future direction.

Scéim Deontais Cultúir agus Cruthaitheachta

Spreag an scéim deontais seo comhoibriú idir pobail agus speisialtóirí oidhreachta, ealaíontóirí, gairmithe cultúir agus/nó tionscail chruthaitheachta. Bronnadh ceithre dheontas déag chun tacú le raon leathan tionscadal lena n-áirítear taifeadadh seanchais, fótagraiméadracht déantán, tionscadal do scoileanna maidir le crosa arda agus ómós digiteach don cheannródaí ríomhaireachta Kay McNulty.

Tionscnaimh Eile

Chomh maith leis sin, thacaigh Éire Ildánach le cuid mhór tionscnamh éagsúla eile i nDún na nGall, lena n-áirítear máistir-ranganna scannánaíochta do dhaoine óga, Scéim Dheisithe Ceann Tuí dar teideal *A Stitch in Time, cór 'Ceol le Chéile'*, Fáinní Thulach Dhónaill a thabhairt go Dún na nGall, agus scála agus gnéithe nua a chur le cláir le linn Wainfest, Sheachtain na hOidhreachta, Fhéile Bhá Dhún na nGall & na gCruach Gorm, agus Oíche Chultúir.

Cruinniú na nÓg – gníomhú, déanamh, cruthú

Is é atá i *gCruinniú na nÓg* ná lá náisiúnta saorchruthaitheachta do leanaí agus do dhaoine óga. I ndiaidh gairm oscailte agus i ndiaidh measúnú a dhéanamh, ar próiseas é a raibh baill de chuid Chomhairle na nÓg páirteach ann, roghnaíodh 31 imeacht a reáchtáladh i 21 ionad i mbailte agus i sráidbhailte ar fud Dhún na nGall. I measc na gceardlann a bhí ann áiríodh Big Top, Damhsa Afracach & Comhaimseartha, Safari Feamainne, Scríobh Amhrán, Scríbhneoireacht Chruthaitheach, Réaltacht Fhíorúil, Cultúr na Seapáine, Fuáil, agus An Ucailéile do Thosaitheoirí. Fuarthas aiseolas dearfach ó rannpháirtithe agus ó éascaitheoirí agus cuirfear moltaí a fuarthas san áireamh sna pleananna don bhliain 2020.

Culture and Creativity Grants Scheme

This grants scheme encouraged cooperation and collaboration between communities and heritage specialists, artists, culture professionals and/or creative industries. Fourteen grants were awarded to support a wide range of projects including seanachas recording, photogrammetry of artefacts, a high crosses schools project and a digital tribute to computer pioneer Kay McNulty.

Other Initiatives

Creative Ireland supported many other varied initiatives in Donegal including, amongst others, Film masterclasses for young people, *A Stitch in Time Thatch Repair Scheme*, *Ceol le Chéile* choir, bringing the Tullydonnell Rings to Donegal, and adding scale and new elements to programmes during Wainfest, Heritage Week, Donegal Bay & Bluestacks Festival and Culture Night.

Cruinniú na nÓg – doing, making, creating

Cruinniú na nÓg is a national day of free creativity for children and young people. Following an open call, and evaluation, which included members of the Youth Council, 31 events were selected which took place in 21 locations in 12 towns and villages across Donegal. Workshops included Big Top, Afro & Contemporary Dance, Seaweed Safari, Songwriting, Creative writing, Virtual Reality, Japanese Culture, Sewing, and Beginners Ukelele. Feedback from participants and facilitators was positive and recommendations will be factored into plans for 2020.

Cultural Corridor

The Council was successful in its application to the Irish Architecture Foundation's *Reimagine...* programme to create a Cultural Corridor in Letterkenny linking the County Museum, the Regional Cultural Centre and An Grianán Theatre. Phase II will take place in 2020. *Reimagine ...* is funded by Creative Ireland under the National Creativity Fund.

Study Visit

The local Creative Ireland team undertook a study visit in Dublin which included the new Museum of Literature Ireland (MoLI), the Little Museum of Dublin, and the EPIC Irish Emigration Museum.

Other Creative Ireland programmes

Other Creative Ireland programmes also bring benefits to Donegal, including the *Creative Schools and other Creative Youth initiatives* that reach many local children and young people, as well as the National Creativity Fund supported Age & Opportunity Artist in Residence in a Care Setting scheme in which Killybegs Community Hospital was successful.

Seirbhís Leabharlainne

Cuireann Seirbhís Leabharlainne Dhún na nGall rochtain ar fáil ar líonra náisiúnta ina bhfuil os cionn 333 leabharlann agus os cionn 15 mhilliún ítim stoic agus, chomh maith leis sin, ina bhfuil bailiúchán náisiúnta r-Leabhar agus r-Chlosleabhar, nuachtán, irisí, ábhar tagartha, agus cúrsaí teanga agus foghlama. Maidir leis an ghréasán sin i nDún na nGall, áiríonn sé 13 leabharlann - 8 leabharlann phobail agus 4 leabharlann bhrainte - agus is í an Phríomh-Leabharlann, atá suite i Leitir Ceanainn, croílár na seirbhíse. Forlíonann ocht bpointe for-rochtana pobail 'Taobh Tíre' agus Leabharlann Taistil Trasteorann an Líonra. I rith na bliana 2019, tugadh 307,550 chuairt ar Leabharlanna Dhún na nGall, agus fuarthas 307,550 ítim ar iasacht, is é sin le rá, i mbrainsí nó ar líne.

Library Service

Donegal Library Service provides access to a national network of over 333 libraries and over 15 million items of stock as well as a national collection of eBooks and eAudiobooks, online newspapers, magazines, reference material, language and learning courses. The network in Donegal includes 13 libraries - 8 community libraries and 4 branch libraries, with Central Library in Letterkenny at its core. Eight Taobh Tíre community outreach points and a Cross Border Mobile Library supplement the network. During 2019, there were 379,550 visitors to Donegal Libraries, with 307,550 items borrowed in branch or online.

Deireadh a chur le fíneálacha

Bhí lúcháir ar an tSeirbhís Leabharlainne a fhógairt gurbh amhlaidh, le héifeacht ón 1 Eanáir 2019, nach mbeadh ar bhaill na leabharlann fíneálacha a íoc a thuilleadh i leith ítimí thar téarma agus nach mbeadh aon fhíneálacha a bhí inioctha á mbailiú. Ó tharla go raibh deireadh le fíneálacha tugadh spreagadh do gach duine den phobal Rún Athbhliana a dhéanamh clárú nó athchlárú lena leabharlann áitiúil. Tá deireadh a chur le fíneálacha leabharlainne i measc na ngníomhartha atá ann sa straitéis náisiúnta dar teideal *Ár Leabharlanna Poiblí 2022 - Pobail a Spreagadh, a Cheangal agus a Chumasú*.

Féile na Bealtaine maidir le Cruthaitheacht i measc Daoine Scothaosta

Tá Féile na Bealtaine, a reáchtáiltear i mí na Bealtaine gach bliain, tar éis teacht chun bheith ar an chomhfhéile ealaíon is mó dá bhfuil ann in Éirinn. Bhí 95 imeacht ann i mbliana in áiteanna ar fud an chontae. Ba é ba théama do Bhealtaine 2019 na 'Fáilte Isteach' agus bhí raon ilchineálach taibhiúchán, coimisiún, cónaitheachtaí agus tionscadal san áireamh sa chlár. I measc bhuaicphointí na féile áiríodh seisiún Teiripe IMAGE in éineacht le McElhinney's Department Store, Patrick Gildea Hairdressing agus Sculpt Make Up Studio. Chomh maith leis sin, bhain rannpháirtithe in imeachtaí Bhealtaine sult as cuairteanna chuig an Dún Riabhach agus chuig Caisleán Ghleann Bheatha. Chuaigh ealaíontóir cáiliúil Dhún na nGall, Ann Quinn, i mbun cónaitheacht sé seachtaine in Ionad Cúraim Lae Chumann Tithíochta Habinteg i Leifear. Is é an ceiliúradh uathúil sin i measc na nglúnta ar fad a fhágann gur féile speisialta í gach bliain.

Removal of fines

The Library Service was delighted to announce that, from 1st January 2019, library members no longer had to pay fines on overdue items, and no existing fines were being collected. With fines abolished, all members of the community were encouraged to make a New Year's Resolution to connect or reconnect with their local library. The removal of library fines for library users is one of the actions in the national strategy *Our Public Libraries 2022 – Inspiring, Connecting and Empowering Communities*.

Bealtaine Festival of Creativity in Older Age

Bealtaine, held each May, has grown into Ireland's largest co-operative arts festival. This year there were 95 events in many venues all over the county. The theme of Bealtaine 2019 was 'Be our Guest' and the programme included a diverse range of performances, commissions, residencies and projects. Festival highlights included an Image Therapy session with McElhinney's Department Store, Patrick Gildea Hairdressing and Sculpt Make Up Studio. Bealtaine participants also enjoyed visits to Fort Dunree and Glenveagh Castle. Renowned Donegal artist Ann Quinn undertook a six-week residency in the Day Care Centre in Habinteg Housing Association, Lifford. It is this unique celebration across generations that make the festival special each year.

Gradaim Aitheantais do Leabharlanna Aoisbháúla

I mí Dheireadh Fómhair, chuir an tAire Forbartha Tuaithe agus Pobail, Michael Ring, tús oifigiúil le Clár na nGradam Aitheantais do Leabharlanna Aoisbháúla i Leabharlann Shráid Chaoimhín i mBaile Átha Cliath. Bhronn an tAire Ring a Cairt Aoisbhá don Phríomh-Leabharlann agus do Leabharlann na Rosann ar Chomhairle Chontae Dhún na nGall. Tá gnéithe aoisbháúla curtha san áireamh ina seirbhísí ag an dá leabharlann sin e.g. líon níos mó suíochán aoisbháúla a chur ar fáil. Sa Chairt Leabharlainne Aoisbháúla, leagtar amach tiomantas na leabharlainne i leith an *Chláir Náisiúnta Aoisbhá*.

Age Friendly Library Recognition Awards

In October, the Minister for the Department of Rural and Community Development, Michael Ring, officially launched the *National Age Friendly Libraries Recognition Programme* in Kevin Street Library, Dublin. Minister Ring presented Donegal County Council with its Age Friendly Charter for Central Library and Leabharlann Phobail Na Rosann. Both libraries have put in place various age-friendly elements to the service e.g. provision of more age-friendly seating. The Age Friendly Library Charter outlines each library's commitment to the *National Age Friendly Programme*.

1. Físeáin bheoite chun acmhainní ar líne a chur chun cinn
2. Clár maidir le Neamhord de chuid Speictream an Uathachais
3. Clár Uilechuimsitheachta d'úsáideoirí Iagamhairc
4. Paca Fáiltithe Leabharlainne Ilteangach

Ba é ab aidhm do gach tionscadal ar leith ná an caidreamh láithreach le gníomhaireachtaí agus le grúpaí áitiúla, agus forbairt a dhéanamh ar ghníomhaireachtaí agus ar ghrúpaí nua, d'fhonn rannpháirtíocht níos mó ag pobail imeallaithe atá faoi bhuntáiste a bhfuil sé deacair teacht orthu a éascú agus deiseanna a thabhairt do gach úsáideoir chun páirt a ghlacadh i bhfoghlaim ar feadh an tsaoil trí sheirbhísí a chur ar fáil a forbraíodh i gcomhar le comhpháirtithe náisiúnta agus le comhpháirtithe áitiúla.

Dormant Accounts Funding

During 2019, Donegal Library Service was successful in getting 75% grant assistance approved from the Department of Rural and Community Development [Dormant Accounts Fund] to support measures set out in *Our Public Libraries 2022*.

Donegal County Council provided 25% match-funding. The four projects selected, approved and implemented for Donegal were:

1. Animated Videos to promote online resources
2. Autism Spectrum Disorder friendly programme
3. Inclusion Programme for Visually Impaired users
4. Multi-lingual Library Welcome Pack

Each project aimed to: build on existing and develop new relationships with local agencies and groups to facilitate greater engagement with hard-to-reach, marginalised and disadvantaged communities; and provide opportunities for all users to engage in lifelong learning through the delivery of services developed in collaboration with national and local partners.

Lainseáil Seirbhíse Nua dar teideal ‘Tábla Draíochta’

Is i mí na Bealtaine a lainseáladh an tseirbhís nua dar teideal Tovertafel sa Phríomh-Leabharlann i Leitir Ceanainn agus i Leabharlann Phobail Ghaoth Dobhair. Is é atá in Tovertafel, nó Tábla Draíochta, ná nuáil dhuaisbhuaiteach de thionscnamh na hÍsiltíre a bhfuil cáil uirthi maidir lena cur chuige ceannródaíochta i leith cúraim. Cuimsíonn an teicneolaíocht teilgeoir idirghníomhach solais do dhaoine ar a bhfuil néaltrú agus do dhaoine a bhfuil míchumais foghlama acu. Ceapadh é chun gníomhaíocht de chineál fisiciúil, sóisialta agus cognaíoch a spreagadh. Is é atá i gceist leis na cluichí ná sraith beochaintí idirghníomhacha solais a theilgtear ar aon tábla chun an intinn a spreagadh agus chun inspioráid a thabhairt do dhaoine a bhfuil neamhoird chognaíocha orthu chun bheith gníomhach. Ceapadh na cluichí chun spreagadh a thabhairt do dhaoine i leith rannpháirtíocht instinneach rud a chothóidh taitneamh agus a chruthóidh ócáidí a mhairfidh i gcuimhne daoine muinteartha agus cúramóirí. Baineann na cluichí uilig le taitneamh agus le hiontas.

Launch of ‘How to’ Videos promoting library online services

The Library Service commissioned a series of short animated instructional videos demonstrating how to access library online resources including eBooks, eAudiobooks, eMagazines and eNewspapers. These online resources, amongst others, are all free and available 24/7 for library members. The videos, which were officially launched in December, aim to reach out to communities in Donegal to promote the use of online library services by demonstrating how to download related apps and borrow items online.

New ‘Magic Table’ Service Launched

The new Tovertafel service in Central Library, Letterkenny and Leabharlann Phobail Ghaoth Dobhair was launched in May. The Tovertafel, or Magic Table, is an award winning innovation from The Netherlands, which is renowned for its cutting edge approach to care. The technology is an interactive light projector for those living with dementia and those with learning disabilities. It has been designed to stimulate physical, social and cognitive activity. The games consist of a series of interactive light animations which are projected on any table to motivate the mind, and to inspire those living with cognitive challenges to be active. The games are engineered to encourage instinctive participation, inviting enjoyment and creating treasured moments with family members and carers. The games are all about enjoyment and wonder.

Ionad Faisnéise Europe Direct

Is é is cuspóir d'ionad Faisnéise Europe Direct atá lonnaithe sa Phríomh-Leabharlann i Leitir Ceanainn, agus don ionad satailíte i Leabharlann Phobail Ghaoth Dobhair, ná teacht éasca ar fhaisnéis faoin Aontas Eorpach a chur chun cinn agus plé, díospóireacht agus aiseolas a spreagadh ar leibhéal an phobail trí fhaisnéis, imeachtaí agus gníomhaíochtaí a chur ar fáil. Ba bhliain toghcháin í fosta i dtaca le Parlaimint na hEorpa de agus d'eagraigh an t-ionad imeachtaí feasachta vótálaithe do mhic léinn Institiúid Teicneolaíochta Leitir Ceanainn agus, chomh maith leis sin, eagraíodh imeachtaí a bhain le deiseanna staidéir, oibre deonaí agus fostaíochta san Aontas Eorpach. D'óstáil an t-ionad imeacht idirphlé saoránach fosta maidir leis na sé thosaíocht pholaitiúla atá ag Coimisiún nua an Aontais Eorpaigh.

Éire Shláintiúil ag do Leabharlann

Tá *Éire Shláintiúil ag do Leabharlann* ina chuid de thionscnamh náisiúnta lena soláthraítear raon acmhainní, seirbhísí agus tacaíochtaí chun feasacht ar chúrsaí sláinte a chur chun cinn. Leanadh de '*Éire Shláintiúil ag do Leabharlann*' a chur i bhfeidhm i nDún na nGall sa bhliain 2019 agus réachtáladh 23 imeacht a bhain le réimsí na meabhairshláinte, na gníomhaíochta fisiciúla agus an bhia shláintiúil. I measc na n-imeachtaí ar éirigh leo áiríodh caint dar teideal *Bully Proof Kids* a thug an tOllamh Stella O'Malley agus caint a thug an Dr Mary O'Kane maidir le déileáil le hábhair inní i measc páistí. Réachtáladh ceardlanna fosta maidir le Feasacht ar Néaltrú, Cothú agus Bainistíocht Struis.

Europe Direct Information Centre

The objective of the Europe Direct Information Centre based in Central Library, Letterkenny and satellite centre in Leabharlann Phobail Ghaoth Dobhair, is to promote easy access to information about the EU, and to stimulate discussion, debate and feedback at a grassroots level through information provision, events and activities. The centre focuses on the geographical location of Donegal and the Gaeltacht areas nationally. In 2019, the centre had over 8,300 personal contacts with EU Citizens from Donegal on topics ranging from agriculture to workers rights. It was also an election year for the European Parliament and the centre organised voter awareness events for students in the LYIT, as well as events on opportunities for studying, volunteering and working in the EU. The centre also hosted a citizen's dialogue event on the six political priorities of the new EU Commission.

Healthy Ireland at your Library

'*Healthy Ireland at your Library*' is part of a national initiative providing a range of resources, services, and supports that promote health awareness. The implementation of '*Healthy Ireland at your Library*' continued in Donegal in 2019 with 23 events in the areas of mental health, physical activity and healthy eating. Successful events included talks by Professor Stella O'Malley on *Bully Proof Kids*, and Dr Mary O'Kane on dealing with childhood anxieties. Workshops were also held on Dementia Awareness, Nutrition and Stress Management.

Work Matters ag do Leabharlann

Tá ‘*Work Matters ag do Leabharlann*’ ina chlár náisiúnta leabharlainne a bhfuil sé mar chuspóir aige tacú le fostaíocht agus le fiontraíocht sa phobal áitiúil trí rochtain a chur ar fáil ar fhaisnéis agus ar acmhainní ardchaighdeáin. Sa bhliain 2019, ghlac an tseirbhís Work Matters i Leitir Ceanainn páirt i Seachtain Fiontraíochta Áitiúil agus d’óstáil sí ceardlann maidir le *Branding Basics for Small Business & Startups*, agus chuidigh siad le níos mó ná 170 duine chun go mbeadh teacht acu ar oiliúint, ar thairseacha fostaíochta agus ar fhaisnéis ghnó agus ar acmhainní taighde.

Ceart Chun Léitheoireachta

I gcomhar le heagraíochtaí comhpháirtíochta, ullmhaíonn agus comhordaíonn Seirbhís Leabharlainne Dhún na nGall Plean Gníomhaíochta bliantúil áitiúil dar teideal *Ceart chun Léitheoireachta* agus oibríonn siad in éineacht leis na comhpháirtithe sin ar mhaithe leis an phlean sin a chur i gcrích.

I measc bhuaicphointí na bliana 2019 áiríodh *Spring into Storytime* i rith mhí Aibreáin, clár léitheoireachta *Réaltaí an tSamhraidh* i rith mhíonna Iúil agus Lúnasa agus lainseáil leagan 2 de *Babbling Babies: multi-lingual nursery rhyme* and action song book i mí Dheireadh Fómhair. Reáchtáladh tionscadail eile in éineacht le comhpháirtithe líonra lena n-áirítear *Bookworm Babies*, *Word Monsters* agus *Creating Lifelong Readers* agus, chomh maith leis sin, clár in éineacht le scoileanna áitiúla, amhail *Battle of the Books*. Tá comhpháirtíochtaí thar a bheith tábhachtach maidir le cur i bhfeidhm gach gné de chlár *Ceart chun Léitheoireachta* Dhún na nGall. Tá sé mar aidhm ag gach clár agus ag gach tionscadal atá sa Phlean Gníomhaíochta spreagadh a thabhairt i leith nósanna léitheoireachta agus grá don léitheoireacht a chothú. Tá roinnt buaicphointí breise liostaithe anseo.

Work Matters at your Library

‘*Work Matters at your Library*’ is a national library programme with the objective to support employment and entrepreneurship in the local community by providing access to high quality information and resources. The service targets job seekers and young entrepreneurs at an early stage of their business development. There are five library locations across the county that have a dedicated hot desk where patrons can access IT and printing facilities as well as an extensive range of relevant books and online resources. In 2019, the Work Matters service in Letterkenny took part in Local Enterprise Week and hosted a workshop on *Branding Basics for Small Business & Startups*, and helped over 170 people access training, jobs portals and business information and research resources.

Right to Read

Donegal Library Service, with partner organisations, draws up and coordinates an annual local *Right to Read* Action Plan and works with those partners towards its implementation.

Highlights during 2019 have included *Spring into Storytime* sessions during April, the *Summer Stars* reading programme during July and August, and the launch of version 2 of *Babbling Babies: multi-lingual nursery rhyme* and action song book in October. Additional projects with network partners include *Bookworm Babies*, *Word Monsters* and *Creating Lifelong Readers*, as well as programmes with local schools such as *Battle of the Books*. Partnerships are critical to implementing all elements of the *Donegal Right to Read* programme. All programmes and projects included in the Action Plan aim to encourage reading habits and to foster a love of reading. Some additional highlights are listed overleaf.

Chomh maith leis sin, cuireann an fhéile deiseanna ar fáil do pháistí, do mhúinteoirí agus do thuismitheoirí nascadh a dhéanamh le léitheoireacht, le cultúr agus leis na healaíona.

Wainfest Children's Arts and Book Festival

Wainfest Children's Arts and Book Festival ran from 5th - 13th October and attracted an audience of over 11,400. The festival theme for 2019 was 'Expect to Connect' and related to the development of libraries as digital learning centres. The festival provides opportunities for children, teachers and parents to connect with reading, culture, the arts and heritage.

The Library Service received funding from the Department of Rural and Community Development, through the Dormant Accounts Fund, to develop an Autism Spectrum Disorder [ASD] friendly programme of events during Wainfest. This allowed for ASD-tailored events like Yoga, Lego workshops and relaxed theatre performances.



Read DL

Read DL

The *Read DL* 2019 committee brought Donegal a collective reading adventure from 28th February - 11th April. The objective of Read DL was to get as many people reading a book from a particular author at the same time, therefore building a sense of community while also promoting literacy and the joy of reading. The book chosen for 2019 was *Mr Stink* by author David Walliams; a heart warming and funny tale filled with love, life and surprising secrets.

Individuals, families, groups and schools could register by visiting the website www.readdonegal.com, and were kept up to date through social media channels. Partaking agencies were: Donegal ETB, HSE, Parentstop, School Completion Programme (SCP), Home School Community Liaison (HSCL), LYIT, and Donegal County Council Library Service. 56 schools, 13 post-primary schools and 5 Youthreach centres participated in Read DL 2019.

National roll out of Healthy Conversations booklet

During 2019, the Library Service worked with the HSE, Donegal Youth Service and the Libraries Development Unit on reviewing and developing the *Sammy the Caterpillar* Guide and related book list in preparation for a national roll-out as part of the *Healthy Ireland at your Library* programme.

The *Sammy Guide* was developed by Donegal Youth Service and the Library Service, supported by the HSE Health Promotion and Improvement, and launched in Donegal during 2018. The project aimed to encourage and support parents and guardians to have healthy conversations with their children about their bodies, sexuality and relationships by providing a range of age-appropriate books through the library network.

Culture Night

Letterkenny's participation for the eleventh time in National Culture Night on 20th September, generated over 7,300 visits – the highest level of engagement recorded to date – to over 50 diverse, family friendly, free events in 27 cultural facilities.

Culture Division contributed immensely to the programme. Among the highlights were Little John Nee's *Waiting On A Train* performance at Letterkenny Bus Station, presented by the County Museum; Jessica Harkin's magic show at the Central Library; poet Annemarie Ní Churreáin's reading at Letterkenny Courthouse; Mockingbird Theatre's *Waiting On Tables for Godot* at An Grianán Theatre Café; and Inishowen Carnival Group's *Cybertribe* at Letterkenny Town Park.

Culture Night in Letterkenny was co-ordinated and presented by Donegal County Council Culture Division, with the support of the Department of Culture, Heritage and the Gaeltacht, the Arts Council and Creative Ireland.

Investing in the Creation of New Artistic Work in Donegal

One of the most important roles of the Arts Service is that of supporting the creation and presentation of new artistic work in the county.

An Cosán Glas artists group presented their Loinnir illuminated sculpture trail at Teach Bhaile Chonaill, An Falcarrach, 20th -21st July . An audience of over 1,600 local people and visitors enjoyed 30 artworks by 17 artists, on the site where the project was first developed in 1995.

Two new theatre productions and a one-act opera, were also assisted by the Arts Service. In October, the *Balor Repts'* production of Martin Jim McFadden's autobiographical work, *Don't Go There*, on the difficult subject of alcohol addiction, was extremely well received in Ballyshannon and Ballybofey while *Dark Daughter Productions'* latest show, *The Housekeeper*, enjoyed full houses in Bundoran and Ballyshannon.

Glasgow-based, Letterkenny composer Derek Ball's new opera, *The Giant of Doon Rock*, was performed at the RCC in September.

Irish Aerial Dance Festival

The 10th Irish Aerial Dance Festival was presented by the partnership of *Fidget Feet Aerial Dance Company*, An Grianán Theatre and Donegal County Council, where 200 dancers, from Ireland and overseas, travelled to Donegal for the event.

An evolving feature of the Festival is its importance as a showcase platform for new Irish and international aerial dance work, with Irish company Kat & Dawg Productions' new work, *By A Thread*, inspired by survivors' stories from the Magdalene laundries, being a particular stand out.

4th Lughnasa International Friel Festival

The Lughnasa International Friel Festival is a celebration of the work of renowned playwright Brian Friel, who resided in Greencastle from the late 1960s until his death in October 2015.

The fourth Friel Festival took place this year in Donegal, Derry and Omagh, from 9th – 18th August. Festival partners included Arts Over Borders, Donegal County Council and An Grianán Theatre.

The Donegal programme included promenade performances of *Faith Healer* in community halls in Edeninfagh, Glenties, and Ardara; rehearsed readings of *The Yalta Game* at St. Eugene's Hall, Moville; a series of outdoor readings of excerpts from *Homer's Odyssey* at beach locations at Dunfanaghy, Culdaff, and Rathmullan and the Lyric Theatre, Belfast's elemental presentation at Malin head of Samuel Beckett's *Waiting for Godot*. Participating artists included Cathy Tyson, Greta Scacchi, Paul McGann, Sean McGinley, Marie Mullen, Frankie McCafferty, Amelia Bullmore, Dearbhla Molloy and Patrick Bergin.

Invitation To Collaboration – Cultural Diversity & Bingo Wings

The Arts Service completed two projects with Local Authority Arts Service partners in Mayo, Limerick, Kerry and South Dublin, funded through the Arts Council's *Invitation To Collaboration* programme.

The Service partnered with Donegal Intercultural Platform to deliver an *Intercultural Arts in Action* programme of community consultation events to ascertain the cultural support needs of new minority ethnic communities in Donegal. The ensuing Report, containing 37 recommendations, was launched on Culture Night.

Bingo Wings was an aerial dance residency and performance project which took place in September and October. Delivered by Fidget Feet Aerial Dance Company, the project saw dancer-in-residence Stephanie Townsend work for six weeks in schools, day centres and arts spaces in Letterkenny, the Finn Valley and Inishowen, culminating in two performances by Fidget Feet of their spectacular *Bingo Wings* show at An Grianán Theatre in October.

Earagail Arts Festival

The 31st Festival promoted 418 performances in 28 venues, across 16 towns, villages and islands between 10th-28th July, with more than 300 artists, performers, community participants, academics and specialists from Ireland, UK, India, USA, Sudan, Lithuania, Germany and Haiti.

Programme Highlights

Among the highlights of 2019's festival were – the world premier of *Citadels of The Sun*, a collaboration of Irish and Indian folk music and theatre spectacle; Cathal McGinley's epic *Ealaín ón gCladach* exhibition and installation at the RCC; festival performances by the legendry Horslips at McGrory's, Culdaff; the Donegal Choir of Ages with Moya Brennan at An Grianán Theatre, and the *No Borders, No Nations* spoken word programme in the Hides at the Inch Wildfowl Reserve, Burt.

Festival Residencies

The Festival deepened its commitment to emerging artists by initiating three new residencies. *AtticAscent* was a five day music production residency at Attica Studios, An Tearmann; *Na Mic Ua gCorra* was a new dance residency with Breandán De Gallá's Ériú company at Amharclann Ghaoth Dobhair; while the residency with LUXe coincided with the company's creation of the processional element of the *Citadels of The Sun* commission.

Hub Weekends

The consolidation of hub weekends continued with the Wild Atlantic Weekend of street arts and music in Moville and Culdaff, the Donegal International Folk & Roots Weekend in Letterkenny and the Mór Music and Arts Trail on Oileán Árainn Mhór.

An Grianán Theatre

An Grianán Theatre celebrated its 20th anniversary in this year. As such, the Board and Staff, with *Blu Zebra Consultants*, undertook a strategic review and business plan with four key priorities: to become a hub for creativity in Donegal and the North West; to support the development of artists and creatives; to further embed the theatre in the heart of the community; and to make a difference.

In-House Productions

An unprecedented five in-house productions were created, of which John D. Ruddy's *Manny Man Does the History of Ireland* and Guy Le Jeune's *Songbirds* enjoyed national tours.

Most ambitious was the production of William Shakespeare's *The Winter's Tale* at Ballymacool Park, Letterkenny and Greencastle. Funded by Creative Europe, it featured over 40 performers, a banquet and a Foyle Ferry crossing from Greencastle to Magilligan.

The nationwide tour of Carol Moore's *Experience of Being* was also supported, while An Grianán Youth Theatre presented *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland* at Glenveagh for Cruinniú na Óg.

Over 150 performances, across all the art forms, were hosted. Drama highlights included Druid Theatre's *Furniture* and Fidget Feet's *Bingo Wings*. Visiting international legends included Lou Grant star Ed Asner, *Only Fools and Horses'* John Challis and Manchester poet, John Cooper Clark.

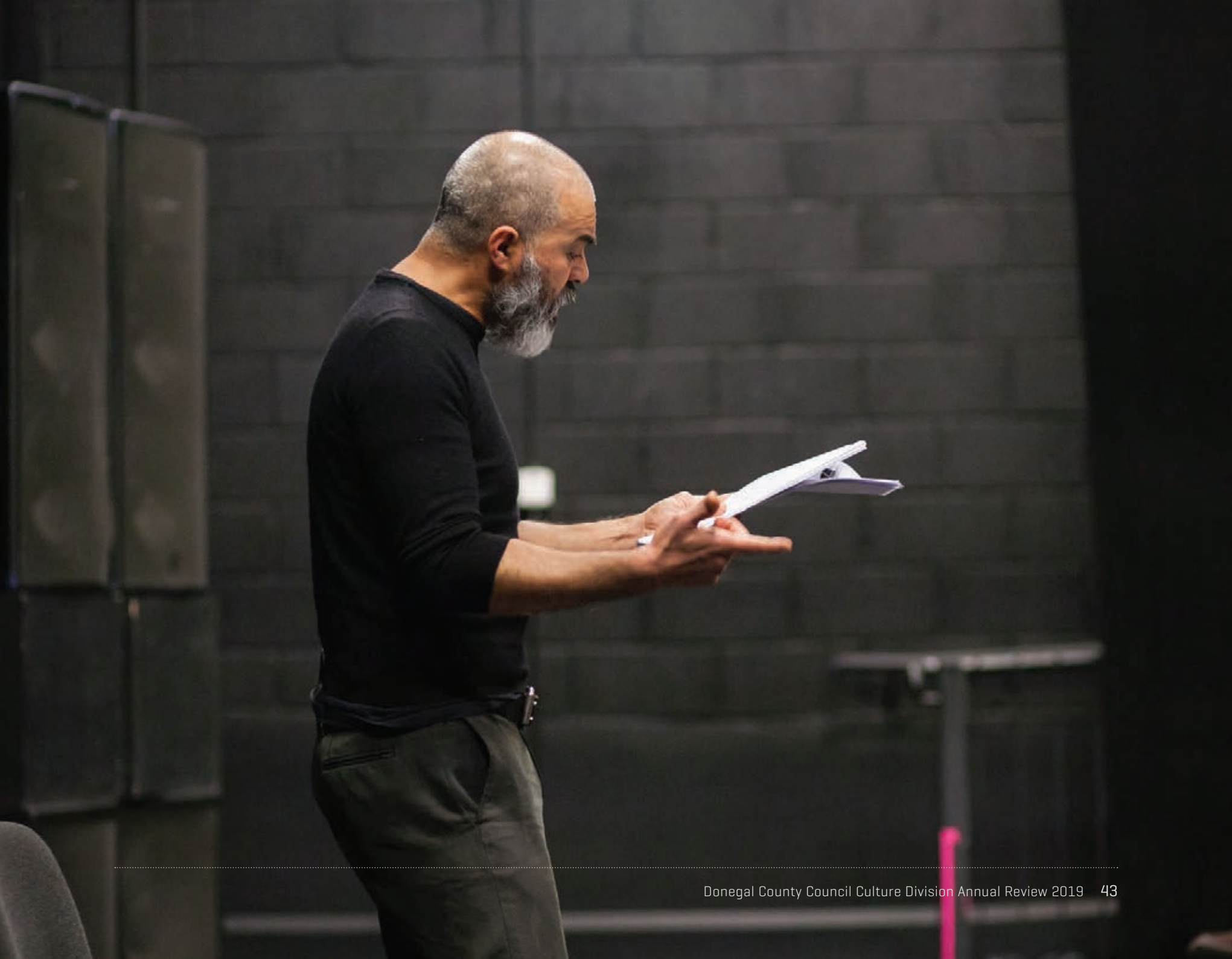

Cuireadh tús iontach le clár ceoil na bliana 2019 trí bhíthin Sheachtain Cheoil Thraidisiúnta Leitir Ceanainn ar éirigh go han-mhaith leis agus a raibh cuid de na ceoltóirí traidisiúnta is breátha ar domhan páirteach ann agus, maidir le sé cinn de na seónna, níor fágadh aon ticéad gan díol. Sa chuid eile den bhliain bhí 60 ócáid ceoil eile ann le linn beagnach 40 imeacht eile agus cineálacha éagsúla ceoil ann lena linn, lena n-áirítear Hip Hop Meiriceánach agus ceol Raga Indiach.

D'ullmhaigh an tlonad Cultúir Réigiúnach Féile Ceoil Tíre agus Sean-Nóis Dún na nGall i gcomhar le Féile Ealaíon an Earagail i mí Iúil agus mheall siad lucht féachana ó áiteanna ar fud na hEorpa agus na Ríochta Aontaithe le haghaidh an imeachta ceithre lá.

Ba bhliain mhaith í an bhliain 2019 fosta i dtaca le saol an cheoil san Iarthuaisceart agus d'óstáil RCC lainseáil albam de chuid roinnt ceoltóirí áitiúla amhail *In Their Thousands*, *Great White Lies*, Terry Monaghan, Ryan Vail agus *Orchestra Elma* [Buaiteoir Dhuaisalbam Thuaisceart Éireann don Bhliain 2019].

Bringing the Best Local and International Music to Donegal

The RCC, one of the most highly regarded and versatile music venues in the country, continued its music development programme in partnership with the Donegal Music Education Partnership and Earagail Arts Festival. It presented a select year-long programme of almost 40 national and international classical, folk, jazz, world and alternative music concerts.

The 2019 music programme began in style with a highly successful Letterkenny Trad Week, which saw 6 sold out performances by a selection of the finest traditional musicians in the world. The year continued with 60 acts performing at nearly 40 separate events, ranging from American Hip Hop to Indian Raga music.

The Regional Cultural Centre produced Donegal International Folk and Roots Festival in association with Earagail Arts Festival in July and attracted audiences from across Europe and the U.K. for the 4 day event.

2019 was also strong year for the North West music scene, with the RCC hosting album launches for several prominent local acts such as *In Their Thousands*, *Great White Lies*, Terry Monaghan, Ryan Vail and *Elma Orchestra* [Winner of Northern Ireland Prize Album of the Year 2019].

Visual Arts

The RCC has continued to work with both leading international and local Irish artists through a series of 20 solo and group shows in 2019. Gallery 1 hosted 4 major contemporary art exhibitions produced by the RCC and partners alongside our annual LYIT Graduate Show, Leaving Certificate & Junior Certificate Exhibition - 'Súile na nÓg', and a pop culture show which saw the FAI take over the gallery space for 10 days to showcase Ireland's soccer history.

Our Gallery 2 and Foyer spaces hosted over a dozen solo and group shows featuring over 100 artists. One of these exhibitions, Richard Noble's - *Yesterday, Today and Tomorrow*, really captured the public's imagination with visiting groups traveling the breadth of Ireland to see his photographs of celebrities such as Clint Eastwood, Bob Dylan and Cher alongside beautiful portraits of Donegal's natives.

Bíonn baint shuntasach ag Comhpháirtíocht Oideachais Ceoil Dhún na nGall le gníomhaíochtaí RCC, lena n-áirítear ranganna agus cleachtaí rialta seachtainiúla le haghaidh ensembles éagsúla óige agus aosach.

Ealaíona Oideachais agus Pobail

Chomhordaigh RCC agus Leabharlann Chontae Dhún na nGall Féile na Bealtaine do dhaoine scothaosta inar eagraíodh os cionn 10 imeacht ar fud an chontae, rud a rinneadh i gcomhpháirtíocht le Seirbhísí Cultúir Chomhairle Chontae Dhún na nGall, le hAostacht & Deiseanna agus le heagraíochtaí do dhaoine scothaosta. Chomh maith leis sin, baineadh úsáid as an Ionad le haghaidh ceardlanna agus imeachtaí rialta leanúnacha a sheolann eagraíochtaí cultúir, oideachais, forbartha pobail agus sláinte ar fud na bliana. D'éagraigh an RCC imeachtaí do scoileanna, do pháistí agus do theaghlaigh san Ionad agus ar fud an chontae in éineacht le comhpháirtithe éagsúla. I measc bhuaicphointí RCC i leith Wainfest 2019 do pháistí i mí Dheireadh Fómhair áiríodh ceithre sheó amharclainne, Ceardlann Scannánaíochta Fóin Chliste agus Pictiúrlann Tiomáin Isteach do Phaistí.

Donegal Music Education Partnership

The Donegal Education and Training Board's (ETB) Donegal Music Education Partnership (DMEP) is based in the RCC and the two organisations work closely together, including the joint promotion of RCC concerts and the facilitation of workshops to accompany the *Music Network* concert series. The DMEP account for a significant proportion of the RCC's activities, including regular weekly classes and rehearsals for various youth and adult ensembles.

Education and Community Arts

The RCC and Donegal County Library coordinated the Bealtaine festival for older people, which featured over 100 events countywide, in partnership with Donegal County Council Cultural Services, Age & Opportunity, and older people's organisations. The Centre was also the venue for regular and ongoing workshops and events held by cultural, educational, community development and health organisations throughout the year. The RCC organised school, children's and family events in the Centre and countywide with a range of partners. The RCC highlights of the 2019 Wainfest for children in October included four theatre shows, a Smart Phone Filmmaking Workshop and a Kids Drive-In Movie Theatre.

Seirbhís Mhúsaem

Déanann Comhairle Contae Dhún na nGall, tríd an tSeirbhís Músaem, caomhnú agus ceiliúradh ar chomhchuímhne an chontae agus a chuid pobal, trí dhéantáin a bhaineann le stair Dhún na nGall a chaomhnú, a chur ar taispeáint agus léirmhíniú a thabhairt ina leith. Oibríonn an Músaem i gcomhar le daoine aonair, grúpaí agus eagraíochtaí éagsúla le feabhas a chur ar rochtain agus ar rannpháirtíocht san oidhreacht agus lenár n-oidhreacht chultúir a chur chun cinn agus a chaomhnú.

Museum Service

Through the Museum Service, Donegal County Council preserves and celebrates the collective memory of the county and its communities, by preserving, displaying and interpreting artefacts related to the history of Donegal. The Museum works with a wide variety of individuals, groups and organisations to improve access to, and participation in, heritage, and to promote and preserve our cultural inheritance.

Sa bhliain 2019, osclaíodh spás nua ilfheidhme sa Mhúsaem. Is féidir raon fairsing imeachtaí agus gníomhaíochtaí poiblí a reáchtáil sa spás sin, amhail ceardlanna, cruinnithe agus léachtaí. Fuarthas páirtmhaoiniú do na hoibreacha trí *Scéim Chaipitiúil Ealaíon agus Cultúir 2016-2018* a riarann an Roinn Cultúir, Oidhreachta agus Gaeltachta.

Tionscadal CINE

Lean an Músaem ar aghaidh lena chuid oibre ar *thionscadal CINE*, ar tionscadal digiteach comhoibríoch é atá á reáchtáil ag comhpháirtithe as an Iorua, as an Íoslainn, as Éirinn agus as Albain agus a fhaigheann maoiniúchán ó *Chlár an Imill Thuaisceartaigh agus Artaigh*. I gcomhar le comhghleacaithe in Ollscoil Uladh, d’eagraigh an Músaem roinnt imeachtaí agus ceardlann le linn Chruinniú na nÓg, na Seachtaine Oidhreachta agus Oíche Chultúir chun aird a tharraingt ar an tionscadal. I mí na Samhna, chomhóstáil an Músaem agus Ollscoil Uladh an cúigiú cruinniú comhpháirtithe agus d’áirigh sé sin cuairt ar Eaglais N. Cairtriona agus ar an reilig sna Cealla Beaga.

New multi functional space in Donegal County Museum

In 2019, a new multi-functional space opened in the Museum. This new space can accommodate a wide range of public events and activities, such as workshops, meetings and lectures. The works were part funded through the *Arts and Culture Capital Scheme 2016-2018* under the Department of Culture, Heritage and the Gaeltacht.

CINE Project

The Museum continued its work on the *CINE project*, a collaborative digital heritage project between partners from Norway, Iceland, Ireland and Scotland and funded by the *Northern and Arctic Periphery Programme*. The Museum along with colleagues in Ulster University organised a number of events and workshops during Cruinniú na nÓg, Heritage Week and Culture Night to highlight the work of the project. In November, the fifth partner meeting was co-hosted by the Museum and Ulster University and included a visit to St Catherine’s Church and graveyard in Killybegs.

Taisce Óir Thulach Dhónaill Ar Taispeáint

I rith na bliana 2019, d'oibrigh an Músaem go dlúth le hArd-Mhúsaem na hÉireann chun cur ar taispeáint *Thaisce Óir Thulach Dhónaill Íochtarach* i nDún na nGall a éascú. Reáchtáladh an taispeántas sa tréimhse idir an 19 Samhain agus an 30 Samhain. Thug 3,300 duine cuairt ar an taispeántas, lena n-áirítear beagnach 1,000 páiste scoile. D'éascaigh foireann an mhúsaem uaireanta oscailte breise chun a chumasú don oiread daoine agus ab fhéidir cuairt a thabhairt ar an taispeántas. Ba iad clár *Éire Ildánach* agus an Roinn Cultúir, Oidhreacht agus Gaeltachta a pháirtmhaoinigh taispeántas na bhFáinní Óir.

Chomh maith leis an taispeántas a eagrú, d'eagraigh an Músaem clár imeachtaí chun aird a tharraingt ar sheandálaíocht Dhún na nGall. Reáchtáladh ceardlanna do pháistí i rith Wainfest, mar shampla, sraith cainteanna ar ábhair amhail Geofhóiréinsic, Corpáin Phortaigh agus an Taisce Óir, mar aon le seimineár dar teideal '*Seandálaíocht: An tAm atá Caite san Am i Láthair*', a seoladh san Ionad Cultúir Réigiúnach ar an 19 Deireadh Fómhair.

Tullydonnell Gold Hoard on Display

Throughout 2019, the Museum worked closely with the National Museum of Ireland to facilitate the display of the *Tullydonnell Lower Gold Hoard* in Donegal. The exhibition took place between 19th - 30th November. 3,300 people visited the exhibition, including nearly 1,000 school children. Museum staff facilitated extra opening hours to enable as many people as possible to visit. The display of the Gold Rings was part-funded by the Creative Ireland programme and the Department of Culture, Heritage and the Gaeltacht.

In association with the exhibition the Museum organised a programme of events highlighting the archaeology of Donegal. There were children's workshops during Wainfest; a series of talks on subjects such as Geoforensics; Bog Bodies and the Gold Hoard; and a seminar, '*Archaeology: Our Past in the Present*', held in the Regional Cultural Centre on 19th October.



Deich mBliana na gCuimhneachán

Ar fud na bliana 2019, lean an Músaem dá chuid oibre i leith comóradh a dhéanamh ar Dheich mBliana na gCuimhneachán. Ar an 10 Aibreán, i dTeach an Chontae, Leifear, i gcomhar leis an tSeirbhís Chartlainne, d’eagraigh an Músaem comóradh céad bliain ar chruinniú stairiúil na Chéad Dála. Mar chuid den chomóradh, d’fhorbair an Músaem taispeántas beag dar teideal ‘Dún na nGall, Olltoghchán 1918 agus an Chéad Dáil’. I mí an Mheithimh, lainseáil an Músaem an 5ú heagrán de Leabhar Onóra Chontae Dhún na nGall ina liostaítear gach duine de chuid mhuintir Dhún na nGall a fuair bás sa Chéad Chogadh Domhanda.

Decade of Centenaries

Throughout 2019, the Museum continued its work to commemorate the Decade of Centenaries. On 10th April, in the County House, Lifford, the Museum, in association with the Archives Service, organised a centenary commemoration of the historic meeting of the First Dáil. As part of the commemoration, the Museum developed a small exhibition entitled ‘Donegal, the 1918 General Election and the First Dáil’. In June, the Museum launched the 5th edition of the County Donegal Book of Honour which lists all those from Donegal who died in the First World War.

Re-imagine Project with the Irish Architectural Foundation

Donegal County Museum is collaborating with An Grianan Theatre and the Regional Culture Centre in Letterkenny on ‘Reimagine...’ an Irish Architecture Foundation project supported by the Creative Ireland Programme’s National Creativity Fund. ‘Reimagine...’ is a community-led architecture and design programme, which brings together local communities, architects, designers and planners to develop projects which will enhance the local built environment. The Letterkenny project will focus on developing a pedestrian ‘cultural corridor’ to better link the Museum, the Theatre and the RCC. The project is co-funded by the IAF and Donegal County Council.

Ba í an Roinn Cultúir, Oidhreachta agus Gaeltachta a d'ullmhaigh an taispeántas mar chuid de Dheich mBliana na gCuimhneachán.

Ó mhí Iúil go mí na Nollag, mar chuid d'Fhéile Ealaíon an Earagail, rinneadh bailiúchán uathúil péintéireachtaí uiscadhatha agus léaráidí le Donal MacPolin a chur ar taispeántas i gcomhar le Seirbhís Chartlainne an Chontae. Trí na saothair ealaíne sin faightear cur síos agus léargas ar áilleacht ár gcuid bád traidisiúnta agus ar an traidisiún tógála bád ar chósta na hÉireann ar traidisiún é atá ag dul i léig.

I mí Lúnasa, mar chuid de dheireadh seachtaine chothrom 50 bliain bhunú Féile Ceoil Tíre Leitir Ceanainn, d'óstáil an Músaem taispeántas earraí cuimhneacháin a raibh baint acu leis an Fhéile. I measc na nithe a bhí ar taispeántas áiríodh grianghraif, cláir, bileoga agus ticéid as bailiúcháin Sally Blake agus Billy Watson.

Ar fud na bliana, d'óstáil an Músaem roinnt taispeántas a fuarthas ar iasacht ó eagraíochtaí eile. Exhibitions

From April to June, the Museum hosted a fascinating exhibition '100 years of Women in Politics and Public Life 1918 - 2018' which shone a spotlight on the women who have contributed significantly to Irish political and public life over the past 100 years. The exhibition was produced by the Department of Culture, Heritage and the Gaeltacht as part of the Decade of Centenaries programme.

From July to December, and as part of the Earagail Arts Festival, the Museum, in association with the County Archives Service, exhibited Dónal Mac Polin's unique collection of watercolour paintings and illustrations. These artworks document and highlight the splendour of our traditional boats and the disappearing boat-building tradition around the Irish coast.

In August, as part of the 50th anniversary weekend to celebrate the original Letterkenny Folk Festival, the Museum hosted an exhibition of memorabilia relating to the Festival. The material on display included photographs, programmes, leaflets and tickets from the collections of Sally Blake and Billy Watson.

Throughout the year, the Museum hosted a number of exhibitions on loan from other organisations. These included; *World War I: Ireland's Humanitarian Effort* in association with St John's Ambulance; *The Devouring* in association with Derry City and Strabane District Council; *Facing Change* in association with *Genio*; and *The Clady Hydro Electric Scheme* in association with the ESB.

An Clár Imeachtaí agus For-rochtana

Collaborative projects:

First Dáil Centenary

The Archive Service collaborated with other services in organising a special Council event for the Centenary of the First Dáil. The event was launched by An Cathaoirleach, Councillor Seamus Ó Domhnaill on 10th April. Historian Anthony Begley spoke of the historical significance of the centenary. The Archives and Museum produced a travelling exhibition and bilingual booklet entitled: *Donegal, the 1918 General Election and the First Dáil; Dún na nGall, Olltoghchán 1918 agus an Chéad Dáil*, detailing the historic events and providing biographies of all four elected men. The exhibition travelled widely throughout the county during the year.

Celebrating the history of Irish local government, Ag Ceiliúradh Stair Rialtas Áitiúil na hÉireann

The Archives Service partnered with other members of the Local Government Archivists and Records Managers group [LGARM] in producing a major travelling bi-lingual exhibition to celebrate 120 years of democratic local government: *Celebrating the History of Irish Local Government, Ag ceiliúradh stair Rialtas Áitiúil na hÉireann*. It was funded by the Department of Housing, Planning & Local Government and each local authority involved. Each panel tells a part of the story of the achievements of local authorities throughout 20th and early 21st century Ireland.

Taispeántas: Donal MacPolin

Exhibition: Donal MacPolin

In 2018, traditional boat builder and artist, Donal MacPolin, donated his lifework of illustrations, photographs and documentation, to the County Archives. The entire collection was exhibited at the County Museum as part of the Earagail Arts Festival in 2019. This was a joint project of the Museum, Archives, Heritage Office, RCC, and the Earagail Arts Festival.

Donegal Connect / Genealogy

The Archives Service took part in the Donegal Connect festival in October. Culture Division staff gave genealogy workshops in Donegal PSC and in Central Library, Letterkenny. The Archivist gave a similar workshop with Derry City Archives in Strabane in November.

Culture Division produced a publication, *Your Donegal Family: A Guide to Tracing your Donegal Ancestors*, aimed at assisting researchers in tracing their family history.

Exhibition: Orange Hall Newtowncunningham

Assistance was provided to the Orange Hall; and Rural District Council minute books were loaned for an exhibition regarding east Donegal and the Decade of Centenaries.

Creative Ireland

The County Donegal 1916 Education Pack was reprinted and the Decade of Centenaries education pack was in part translated with *Creative Ireland* funding.

Digitisation Projects

The Collection of Joseph Murray (War of Independence activist) was uploaded on the Council Archives web pages. The Board of Guardians digitised archives were uploaded to the *Find My Past* website as part of our collaborative project. These are now freely accessible to view at Donegal County Libraries.

Festivals and events

The Archives Service was 20 years old in 2019, and outreach activities featured largely this year.

The Service took part in the festivals of Bealtaine, Culture Night and Heritage Week. Reminiscences and talks included: Active Age Dungloe; Lifford Friday Club; Portnoo, Inver, Carrigart and Creeslough day centres; Men’s Shed Castlefin; and Raymoghly History Group. Talks given included *20 Collections, 20 Years of Donegal County Archives, Starvation and Survival: Inishowen Workhouse during the Great Famine and Donegal & the First Dáil* - for the public in the County Museum; for the West Inishowen History Group (two talks), Malin Head History & Heritage group, and for the Colgan Heritage Weekend in Carndonagh. The archivist gave a lecture as part of a series of events for the renowned *Coming Home* Famine Exhibition in the Cultúrlann in Derry in February.

The Archives Service managed Donegal County Council's deposited non-current records and made recommendations regarding the preservation of archives and disposal of records. Records management queries were dealt with and records were surveyed and deposited.

The Archivist managed records storage areas in Kiltroy Letterkenny, and in the Three Rivers Centre and worked on making the Archives research room facilities more accessible for researchers and the office more suitable for staff.

Heritage Ireland 2030

The Department of Culture, Heritage & the Gaeltacht started the process to prepare a new National Heritage Plan [*Heritage Ireland 2030*] that will direct heritage priorities, resources and funding for the next decade. It solicited the assistance of Heritage Offices around the country to help organise information events and encourage submissions. The Culture Division held two public information events in February. Donegal was the county with the most number of submissions per capita in Ireland. The Department of Culture, Heritage & the Gaeltacht hosted the *Heritage Ireland 2030* information event in Dublin Castle in May to update people on progress towards the preparation of the new National Heritage Plan and five Heritage Officers (including the County Donegal Heritage Officer) were invited to give lightning presentations to an audience of about 300 people on the needs of the heritage sector.

Chuir an Oifig Oidhreachta agus an Oifig Chaomhantais tús le *Scéim Deisithe Ceann Tuí* chun comhairle speisialtóireachta a chur ar fáil d'úinéirí maidir le caomhnú a ndéanmhas ceann tuí agus chun maoiniúchán a leithroinnt ar mhaithe le deisiúcháin bheagscála ceann tuí a dhéanamh faoi mhaoirseacht chaomhantais. Chomh maith le cinn tuí stairiúla a shainaitheint agus a chaomhnú, chuir an scéim faisnéis thábhachtach ar fáil faoi ábhair/mhodhanna ar ghnách iad a úsáid, faoi thuíodóirí áitiúla agus faoi na dúshláin atá ann d'úinéirí tí ceann tuí. Fuarthas freagra ollmhór ón phobal agus thacaigh an scéim le 12 thionscadal deisithe ceann tuí.

Mar chuid de Chur i bhfeidhm Phlean Oidhreachta Chontae Dhún na nGall, choimisiúnaigh an Oifig Oidhreachta DNK Media chun físeáin ghearra a ullmhú maidir le scileanna traidisiúnta tógála i gContae Dhún na nGall, lena n-áirítear tuíodóireacht a dhéanamh, deisiú saifhuinneog agus úsáid moirtéil aoil.

D'ullmhaigh an Oifig Oidhreachta an leabhrán dar teideal *Donegal Traditional Shop Fronts & Signage* leis an ailtire agus leis an chraoltóir Orla Murphy. Bíonn tionchar mór ag éadanais siopa, ina n-aonar agus in éineacht lena chéile, ar charachtar, ar cháilíocht agus ar tharraingteacht áite ina hiomláine. Déanann an leabhrán tagairt don dea-chleachtas agus spreagann sé idirghabhálacha cuí, íogaire, eolasacha i ndáil lenár gcuid éadanas siopa, lenár gcomharthaí dúchasacha agus lenár sráid-dreacha stairiúla.

Built Heritage Initiatives

The Heritage Office and the Conservation Office initiated a *Thatch Repair Grants Scheme* to provide specialist advice to owners on the conservation of their thatched structures and to allocate funding for small-scale thatch repairs under conservation supervision. As well as identifying and conserving historic thatch, the scheme yielded important information on thatching materials/methods, local thatchers and the challenges facing thatch homeowners. The public response to the scheme was overwhelming and the scheme supported 12 thatch repair projects.

As part of the implementation of the County Donegal Heritage Plan, the Heritage Office commissioned DNK Media to produce short videos on traditional building skills in County Donegal included thatching, sash window repair and the use of lime mortar.

The Heritage Office produced the *Donegal Traditional Shop Fronts & Signage* booklet by architect and broadcaster Orla Murphy. Shopfronts, both individually and collectively, have a major impact on the overall character, quality and attractiveness of place. The booklet draws upon best practice and encourages appropriate, sensitive and informed interventions in relation to our traditional shopfronts, vernacular signage and historical streetscapes.

Tionscnamh na mBailte Stairiúla

D'éirigh le hiarratas Chomhairle Chontae Dhún na nGall chuig Tionscnamh na mBailte Stairiúla maidir le Lána an hEaglaise i Leitir Ceanainn agus, i mí an Mháirta, bhronn an Chomhairle Oidhreacht agus an Roinn Cultúir, Oidhreacht & Gaeltachta maoiniúchán €200,000 ina leith. Ba iad an tOifigeach Oidhreacht agus an tOifigeach Caomhantais, i gcomhpháirtíocht le Coiste Cheantar Ardeaglais Leitir Ceanainn, le Dedalus Architecture agus le húinéirí agus cónaitheoirí áitiúla, a d'ullmhaigh agus a bhainistigh an tionscnamh. Thacaigh an tionscnamh le hoibreacha caomhantais i ndáil le seacht maoin lena n-áirítear deisiú dín agus simléir, suiteáil earraí iarainn theilgthe uisce báistí, athbhunú saifhuinneog agus doirse adhmaid, rindreáil aoil nó pointeáil aoil, agus deisiú éadanais siopa stairiúil trí ábhair thraidisiúnta a úsáid agus trí dhea-chleachtas caomhantais a chur i bhfeidhm. Bhí an maoiniúchán a bhronn an Chomhairle Oidhreacht ar an leithroinnt ab airde a bronnadh i dtaca leis na sé bhaile in Éirinn a fuair maoiniúchán. Mar chuid de 'Oíche Chultúir', d'eagraigh Coiste Cheantar Ardeaglais Leitir Ceanainn turas siúil dar teideal *Cónaitheoirí Lána na hEaglaise* i gcomhair leis an Oifig Oidhreacht agus leis an Oifig Chaomhantais.

Lainseáil an Iniúchta ar Oidhreacht Chultúir Cholm Cille

D'fhreastail os cionn 80 duine ar lainseáil an Iniúchta ar *Oidhreacht Chultúir Cholm Cille* in Ionad Oidhreacht Cholm Cille i nGartán agus bhí os cionn 50 duine i láthair ag an lainseáil sa Halla Cathrach i nDoire ag deireadh mí Feabhra. Mar chuid de na himeachtaí lainseála áiríodh cur i láthair ag Neil Jackman, ag Abarta Heritage agus ag an Dr. Brian Lacey. San iniúchadh sin, leagtar amach láithreáin thábhachtacha, áiteanna thábhachtacha, réada thábhachtacha agus ábhair chartlainne thábhachtacha oidhreacht atá bainteach le N. Colm Cille agus soláthraítear moltaí le haghaidh chomóradh na bliana 2021 ar chothrom 1,500 bliain bhreith an naoimh a bheidh á réachtáil ar bhonn comhairliúcháin le páirtithe leasmhara éagsúla. Historic Towns Initiative

Donegal County Council's application for Church Lane, Letterkenny to the Historic Towns Initiative was successful and was awarded €200,000 in funding from The Heritage Council & the Department of Culture, Heritage & the Gaeltacht in March. The initiative was prepared and managed by the Heritage Officer and the Conservation Officer in partnership with the Letterkenny Cathedral Quarter Committee, Dedalus Architecture and local owners and residents. The initiative supported conservation works to seven properties including roof and chimney repairs, installation of cast-iron rainwater goods, reinstatement of timber sash windows and doors, application of lime render or lime pointing, and the repair of a historic shopfront using traditional materials and informed by best conservation practice. The funding awarded by the Heritage Council was the largest allocation of the six towns in Ireland awarded funding. As part of 'Culture Night', the Letterkenny Cathedral Quarter Committee in association with the Heritage Office and Conservation Office presented a '*Residents of the Church Lane*' walking tour.

Launch of Audit of Columban Cultural Heritage

Over 80 people attended the launch of the *Audit of Columban Cultural Heritage* in the Colmcille Heritage Centre, Gartan and over 50 people attended the launch in The Guildhall, Derry in late February. The launch events included presentations by Neil Jackman, Abarta Heritage and Dr. Brian Lacey. The audit sets out key heritage sites, places, objects and archives associated with St. Colmcille and provides suggestions for the 1,500th commemoration of his birth in 2021 based on consultations with a variety of stakeholders. Education & Awareness

National Heritage Week took place from 17th - 25th August and was a tremendous success. Heritage Week is coordinated by The Heritage Council and Local Authority Heritage Officers and there were over 120 events taking place for Heritage Week in County Donegal with over 20 events organised or hosted by the Culture Division. The Heritage Office produced the highly-popular, pocket-sized *County Donegal Heritage Week Event Guide* and it was launched by Cllr. Nicholas Crossan, Cathaoirleach, Donegal County Council on 1st August in the County Museum. The Donegal Education Centre, National Parks & Wildlife Service, Inland Fisheries Ireland and the Heritage Office ran the *Learning Through The Landscape* CPD Course for Primary Teachers in Glenveagh National Park in early July. As part of Wainfest and in association with the County Library Service, the Heritage Office sponsored Éanna Ní Lamhna to undertake Creative Habitats Workshops for Children in Lifford, St. Johnston, Dungloe, Falcarragh & Stranorlar in October.



Tionscnaimh maidir le Fiadhúlra

I gcomhpháirtíocht le Cairde Éanlaith Éireann, fuair an Oifig Oidhreachta €15,154 ón tSeirbhís Páirceanna Náisiúnta & Fiadhúlra le haghaidh tionscadal trí bliana dar teideal *Tracking Irish Breeding Curlew* d'fhonn tuiscint níos fearr a fháil ar éiceolaíocht an speicis seo atá i mbaol agus chun cuidiú leis an speiceas a chaomhnú amach anseo. Is é an Crotach an t-aon speiceas amháin de chuid na hÉireann atá ar Liosta Dearg an Aontais Idirnáisiúnta um Chaomhnú Dúlra (IUCN), is é sin le rá, liosta na speiceas atá faoi bhagairt. I gcomhpháirtíocht leis an Oifig Oidhreachta, rinne Cairde Éanlaith Éireann rialú coirbhídeach ar an Charóg Liath ar mhaithe le caomhnú na bPilibíní Pórúcháin ar Thoraí. Is lapaire meánmhéide é an Pilibín agus tá sé liostaithe mar speiceas Liosta Deirge is ábhair imní ó thaobh caomhantais de in Éirinn.

Fuair an Oifig Oidhreachta €9,416 ón tSeirbhís Náisiúnta Páirceanna & Fiadhúlra chun measúnachtaí gnáthóige a choimisiúnú agus chun mapáil a dhéanamh ar 15 reilig stairiúla eile atá faoi chúram Chomhairle Chontae Dhún na nGall.

Wildlife Initiatives

The Heritage Office, in partnership with BirdWatch Ireland, secured €15,154 from the National Parks & Wildlife Service for a three-year project on *Tracking Irish Breeding Curlew* to better understand this endangered species' ecology and help to conserve them in the future. The Curlew is Ireland's only red listed species on the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) list of threatened species. In partnership with the Heritage Office, BirdWatch Ireland undertook corvid control of Hooded Crows for the conservation of Breeding Lapwing on Tory Island. Lapwing is a medium-sized wader which is a red listed species under the Birds of Conservation Concern in Ireland.

The Heritage Office secured €9,416 from the National Parks & Wildlife Service to commission habitat assessments and mapping of a further 15 historic graveyards in the guardianship of Donegal County Council.

I gcomhar leis an Ionad Náisiúnta le Sonraí Bithéagsúlachta, choimircigh Oifigí Oidhreacht & Oifigí Bithéagsúlachta Údarás Áitiúil Gradam Bliantúil na nÚdarás Áitiúil i leith Pailneoirí mar chuid de chomórtas na *mBailte Slachtmhara* chun spreagadh a thabhairt do ghrúpaí áitiúla gníomhartha pailneoir-bháúla a chur i bhfeidhm ina gcuid bailte agus sráidbhailte. Bhuaigh Bailte Slachtmhara Bhun Cranncha *Gradam Náisiúnta na mBailte Slachtmhara i leith Pailneoirí* den chéad uair agus bhuaigh siad *Gradam Bailte Slachtmhara d'Údarás Áitiúla i leith Pailneoirí* do Réigiún an Iarthuaiscirt & an Iarthair i gCatagóir na mBailte Móra den tríú bliain i ndiaidh a chéile.

Donegal County Council signs up to All-Ireland Pollinator Plan

Donegal County Council became the seventeenth local authority on the island of Ireland to sign-up to the *All-Ireland Pollinator Plan* in November. Under the agreement, Donegal County Council has committed to consider the *All-Ireland Pollinator Plan* in its policies, plans and management decisions and has committed to undertake a number of actions each year to help pollinators. Local Authority Heritage Offices & Biodiversity Offices, in partnership with the National Biodiversity Data Centre, sponsored the annual Local Authority Pollinator Award as part of the *Tidy Towns* competition to encourage local groups to implement pollinator-friendly actions in their towns and villages. Bunrana Tidy Towns won the *National Tidy Towns Pollinator Award* for the first time and the regional *Tidy Towns Local Authority Pollinator Award* for the North West & West Region in the Large Town Category for the third year in a row.
