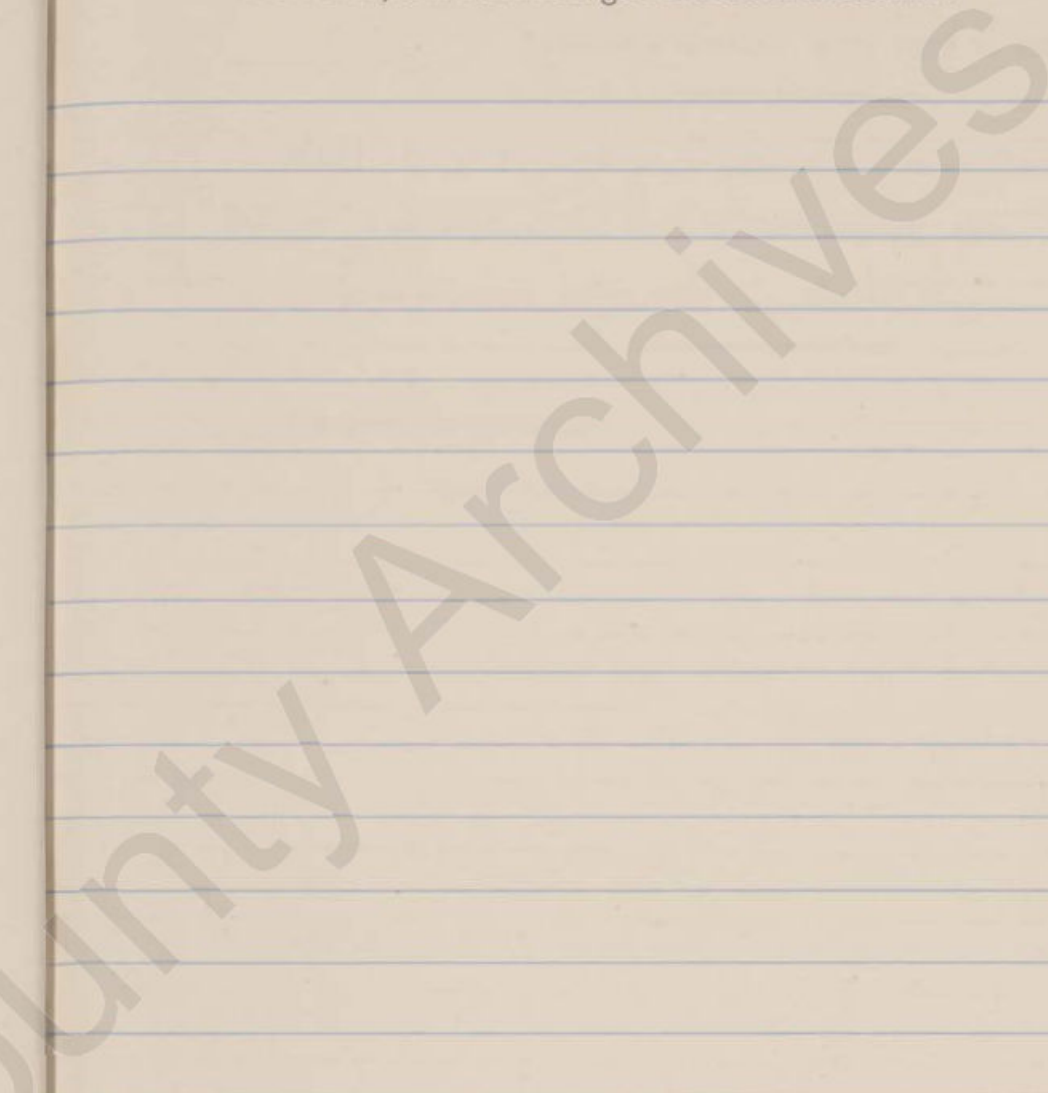

Dr. Hamilton then goes on to say that before arriving at a definite conclusion on the matter the water would require to be analysed and asks instructions as to whether he will send a sample to the Analyst in the meantime he suggests that the owner of the premises be required to cease using the pump there being no necessity for doing so, as there is a town water supply in Bundoran.

Dr. Hamilton further suggests that proper closets be fitted in these premises instead of the old pane pattern the cisterns for which at present supply both houses and closets.

The owner of premises above referred to, to be notified to have the pump closed, and proper closets fitted.

Mr. A. H. Reid Solicitor Bullyhannon wrote as follows, date 21<sup>st</sup> June '01

"I am instructed by Mr. John Doherty, Mr. Mary Doherty and Mr. Thos. J. Gorman to bring under the notice of the Council the following matter at their next meeting.

My clients live alongside the Bradoque river which flows under the Bridge in the centre of the town of Bundoran, a considerable quantity of sewerage matter is now being discharged into the river to the detriment in many ways of those living in the neighbourhood thereof and to such an extent as to endanger health. I would mention among other sewers one communicating with six new houses built alongside the Church, also a sewer running from the direction of late James Hamilton's premises and a sewer belonging to Sanitary Authority.

I have to request your Council as the Sanitary Authority to forthwith take steps to stop this pollution of said river by prohibiting the discharge of all sewage into same.

I would refer you to 3<sup>rd</sup> Sec. of the Rivers Pollution Act 1876 which gives the Sanitary Authority power to compel person to abstain from committing this offence, also to Sec. 6 of said Act which enables my Clients to compel the Sanitary Authority to act in the matter if they are unwilling or neglect to do so."

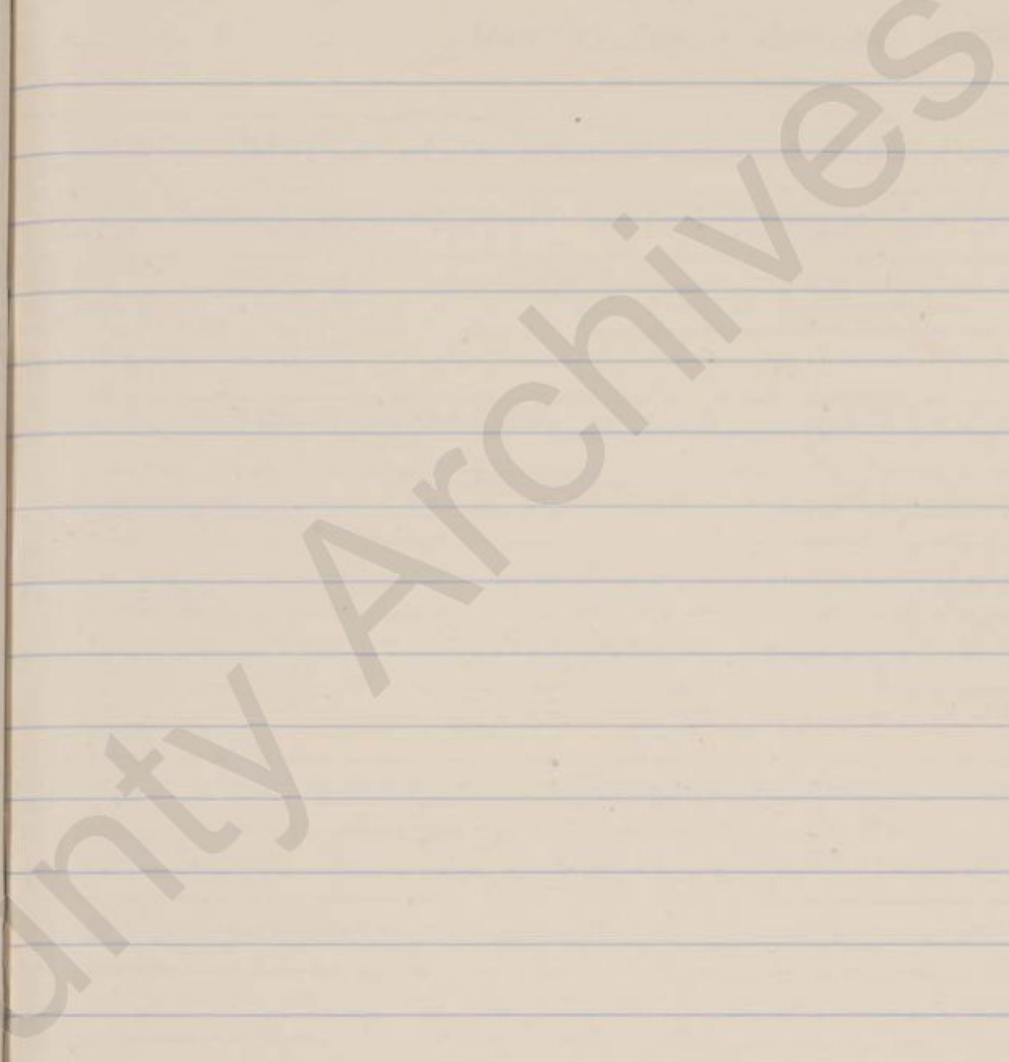

referring to the Council's application for the Board's sanction to the loan of £1900 required by the Council for the purposes of an Improvement Scheme authorized by the Public Health (Ireland) No 1 Rural District Labourers' Order, the Board sanction the loan, the amount to be issued in instalments (the first to be £800) and the repayment to be spread over a period of 50 years.

From Local Govt. Board date 22<sup>nd</sup> Aug 1901  
referring to minutes of Council of 10<sup>th</sup> inst. and previous correspondence on the subject, the Local Government express their sanction to the proposed increase of the salary of Sanitary Sub Officer Higgins from £10 to £16 a year.

to the minutes of Council of 10<sup>th</sup> inst. enclosing extracts

from the report of their Medical Inspector Dr. Mc Carthy relating to the sanitary condition of the Public Health No 1 Rural District and requesting the careful consideration by the Council of the matters referred to in the report, and their observations thereon. As regards the duties of Sanitary Sub Officers the Board request that the attention of those Officers may be drawn to the terms of art 17 of the Board's Sanitary Order of 3<sup>rd</sup> May 1900, strict compliance with which will be expected from them in future. A copy of the Board's Model regulations respecting dairies, powerhouses and Mill-shops is enclosed for the guidance of the Council in order that they may consider with propriety the question of adopting them in the District.

The Board further state that the Council should also give their careful attention to the sewerage of Ballinacree and especially to the water supply to this village having regard to the Inspector's remarks on these matters.

With regard to the registration of Lodging Houses the Board point out that the provisions of Sec. 87 of Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878 are mandatory and should be enforced, and a copy of Model Bye Laws as to such premises is enclosed for the Council's information.

In conclusion the Local Govt. Board urge the Council in the interests of Public Health to consider the question of adopting the provisions of the Infectious Diseases (Notification) and the Infectious Diseases Prevention Act in the Rural District.
