The Clerk submitted the following Report:—

The Clerk reported the County Council had not furnished the quarterly instalment on demand due on the 1st January; that he had written the Local Government Board on the matter and received a reply that they were in communication with the Irish Government in connection with the payment of grants from the Local Taxation Account direct to this Council.

Messrs Wilson and Simms, Solicitors, reported results of criminal injury applications.

The Hon. Sec. of Lifford Local Committee wrote asking the Council to pay an overdraft due to the Bank by the committee who had charge of the lighting of Lifford before matter was taken up by the Council. He pointed out that the original committee had handed over to the Council two

500 candle power lamps free of cost ^{for} which the committee had paid about £15 each.

Ordered that Local Government Board be asked if they will approve of payment of this contract.

In pursuance of notice of motion Mr Sheldon proposed that the present War Bonus allowed to Sanitary Sub-officers G. Alexander and J. S. Alexander be made permanent increases of salary. This was seconded by Mr Campbell and passed unanimously.

The Chairman reported that the Local Government Board had written they had no power by which they could accede to the Council's request to retain the District as a separate Rural District when the townlands comprised therein have been transferred to Shamoket Union.

On the motion of Mr Sheldon seconded by Mr Campbell it was unanimously decided to ask the Local Government Board to take the necessary steps to have an Act of Parliament passed amending Sec. 6 of the Public Health Act 1878 and giving them power to retain existing Rural District Councils on the alteration of Union boundaries.
