Buncrana Halloween Parade Sunday 26th October 2025 6:45pm – 8:00pm

Notice is hereby given that Donegal County Council intends to make an Order to have the following road closed to traffic on the dates indicated to facilitate the Buncrana Halloween Parade.

Road to be Closed:

The route being closed is the L-5256-0 (Nailors Row), R-238-9 (Cockhill Road/Upper Main Street/Market Square/Lower Main Street/St. Orans Road) and R-238-51 (St. Marys Road) from its junction with the L-5266-0 (Castle Park) to its junction with the L-1086 (Church Street).

Alternative Routes:

Alternative routes for through traffic are via L-1086 (Aileach Road and Shore Road) L-1096-0 (Cahir O' Doherty Avenue) L-5266-0 (Castle Park) and L-1006-0 (Causeway Road) L-1126-2 (Pairc Mór) L-5026-1 (Marian Park) L1126-0 (Mc Carters Road) L1066-0 (Looking Glass Brae) back to the R-238.

Persons wishing to object to the closure should submit objections in writing to the Roads & Transportation Section, Donegal County Council, County House, Lifford before **4.30pm on Monday 29**th **September 2025.**

In the event of objections being made to the granting of proposed road closures, the Council reserves the right to make the details of the objections available to the licence applicant where it considers it necessary in order to fully consider the validity of any of the objections received.
