Disbursements

Estimates for Year 1916-17.

On the motion of Councillor Hanna, seconded by Councillor
Wm. Rodgers, the Secretary's Estimates for the Service
of the Finance Year ending 31st March, 1917, as
adopted by the Finance Committee at a meeting held
on the 7th day of February, 1916 were (without
amendments) unanimously confirmed, and it
was resolved to strike Rates for Sewer Charges
and Repairs Charges respectively, for the said Finance
Year, in accordance with the figures contained in
Form 15 and Form 16 - Public Bodies Order, 1904.

The Council also determined the
amounts to be demanded from Bundoran, Omrawan
& Letterkenny Urban District Councils
