(1) New Streets and Buildings (2) Water Supply (3) Non Acceptance of Office (4) Management of Affairs of the Council (5) Cleaning of Townways etc (6) Prevention of Nuisance etc, and requesting to be furnished with two printed copies of each of the Codes. The Solicitor instructed the printer to proceed with the printing of 100 copies and the posters as directed by the Council.

Letter from Mr. Charles Doherty Rate Collector addressed to the Chairman requesting the Council for an increase of poundage for collection of second moiety of Rates

The record of work performed by the Sanitary Sub. Officers from the 6<sup>th</sup> November 1916 to the 2<sup>nd</sup> December 1916 was submitted and showed 49 premises had been visited and inspected.

The Council had under consideration the payment of the sum of £60.9.4 to the Inishowen Rural District Council as per agreement between the Rural District Council and the Urban Council for the transfer of the 33 Labourers Cottages to the Urban Council from the 1<sup>st</sup> October 1916 60.9.4 being the 1<sup>st</sup> Monthly due on the 1<sup>st</sup> December 1916.

It was decided to issue Paying Order for same (with to hold same until he get the agreement.)
