Mr. Funston tendered to build the cottages "according to plan and specification and to the satisfaction of the Architect."

With regard to the fences it is set forth in the Specification as follows:

"The different sites about one acre each, are to be enclosed with a substantial fence 3 ft. 6 inches high, if of stone at least 18 Inches thick, and if of sods, to be from 3 to 4 ft. thick, and closely covered with sods and good strong quicks."

From Mr. Funston, Contractor for building Labourers Cottages date 26th July 1902.

Acknowledging receipt of Clerk's letter in reference to fences around Labourers Cottages, and stating that he has built no sod fences where stones were easily available. The stones for cottages have he says cost him 1/10th per ton at Ballyshannon, and 2/- per ton at Belleek, In two places he got quarries raised and drew with his own men and horses and found them equally ^{as} dear. In conclusion he says he is prepared to build the fences with stone if the Council allow the price of the stones.

At the price of stones above mentioned it would take £20- to fence an acre.

work already done by Mr. Funston, and report to the Council thereon.

3. At Ballinacarrick there should be reserved out of the plot as now fenced a right of way to a well which is used by the people of that neighbourhood. The gate erected here and that at the cottage in Sminver are too weak for their dimensions and are not up to the design subsequently submitted to us by Mr. Monaghan the Architect.

The cottages at Bolyhore are in a forward condition. Generally we think it would have been a better arrangement to have erected the privy and ashpit outside the yard enclosure, with the door of the privy from the yard so placed as not to be directly opposite the back door of the cottage in each case. We also consider that smaller panes of glass would have been more useful for the cottages, without reducing the dimensions of the windows. If it could be managed without increasing the expenditure very much, we would recommend that the cottages to be hereafter erected and not included in present contract should be so constructed as to afford more accommodation for those intended to inhabit them.

A copy of the Board's Model Regulations as to Dairies, Cowsheds and Milkshops is enclosed and the Board suggest that the Council should adopt these or a similar code. With regard to the Inspector's observations on the Common Lodging Houses in the District the Board point out that the Provisions of Secs 87 & 91 of the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878 with respect to the registration of, and the making of Bye-laws for the regulation of such Lodging Houses are mandatory. In conclusion the Local Government Board would urge the Council in the interests of the public health to consider the question of providing a properly equipped disinfecting apparatus for use in the District and also the desirability of adopting the provisions of the Infectious Diseases (Notification) Act 1889, and the Infectious Diseases (Prevention) Act 1890.

The several matters referred to in Dr. McCarthys report will be considered by the Council.

From Local Government Board date 18th Sept 1902. referring to the entry on Minutes of 6th Inst relating to the borrowing powers of the Area of Charge for Expenses incurred in connection with the Improvement of Bundoran the Board state that on the figures furnished in the Minutes the Local borrowing powers of the Area in question under Sec 238 (2) of Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878 is £6914..16.0 and as the outstanding liabilities are stated to be £4237..10.0 the available borrowing power

in respect of the Area appears to be £2,677..6.0.

The Committee appointed by the Council to take into consideration the question of Bundoran Sewerage reported as follows.

The Committee met at Bundoran on Monday 22nd inst. Mr. J. Steadman M.E. County Surveyor attended, and there were also present several members of the Bundoran Improvement Committee, including Messrs John Condon, P. Daly, Chas. Meenan, A.W. Berry and Joseph Curack. Mr Steadman explained the alternative schemes suggested by him in his report already considered by the Council - The matter was fully discussed and it was un-animously agreed that Mr Steadman should be instructed to prepare plans, Specification and Estimate for a thorough drainage scheme for the town, carrying the entire sewage of the place to a point near the Bradoque river on the sea side of the street where a tank must be constructed to receive it, the escape from the tank to be carried to a point agreed on where it is believed it can hereafter cause no annoyance.

The members of the Committee of the Council were impressed and fully satisfied with the explanations given by Mr Steadman of the future workings of his scheme, and they recommend that all necessary steps be taken immediately to procure the sanction of the Local Government Board.

The report of the Committee and the recommendations contained therein were unanimously adopted by the Council. Mr Steadman M.E. to be instructed accordingly -

Scheme as reckless inasmuch as it included a number of Applicants who are not qualified under the Labourers' Acts. The evidence of the Clerk of the Council went to show that there had not been sufficient investigation as to the truth of the representations. The Inspector points out that sites 30 and 31 on Ordnance Sheet 109 in Bundoran Elector Division do not adjoin a public road and the Board state that having regard to the provisions of Sec. 3 of the Act of 1886, it will be necessary for the Council to obtain the written consents of the owners and occupiers of the plots in question to the taking thereof to enable the Board to include the sites in the Provisional Order. As regards site 36 on Ordnance Sheet 107 in Bundoran Electoral Division the Occupier has agreed to repair at his own expense, and to the satisfaction of the Council and their Engineer an existing thatched ^{Cottage} house on his land with an allotment of $\frac{3}{4}$ of an acre attached, and to let it to an Agricultural Labourer on terms similar to those fixed by the Council for Cottages provided under the Labourers' Acts.

The Inspector recommends that this offer be accepted, and under the circumstances the Board will insert a clause

in the Provisional Order to the effect that the taking of the original site shall not be proceeded with, if within a period of six months from the time the Order becomes absolute, the Occupier carries out his agreement. The Board state in conclusion, that subject to the satisfactory arrangement of the matters above referred to, the Board will give directions for the preparation of a Provisional Order confirming the Scheme to the extent recommended by the Inspector."

The Contractor for the erection of Labourers Cottages wrote informing the Council that he has finished seven cottages according to contract and is prepared to hand them over any day, he has also four more in course of erection, two of them slated, one nearly ready for the roof and the fourth being built.

It was ordered that application be made to the Board of Works for an instalment of £800., being the second instalment of the loan under Part I of the Provisional Order, as compensation for the plots taken as sites for cottages has now to be paid.
