# IC 01/23 Minutes of Meeting

On the proposal of Cllr. Mac Giolla Easbuig, seconded by William Boyle, the Committee agreed the Minutes of the meeting held on the  $8^{th}$  November 2022 in Dungloe Public Service Centre.

# IC 02/23 Blueways Presentation

Charlie Boyle from CXEI made a detailed presentation to the Committee in relation to a feasibility and development plan for a Blueway to the Small Islands to link up with the Arranmore/Burtonport Blueway.

The following items were addressed during the presentation:

- Reversal of decreasing population levels
- Methodology
- Principle Motivators
- Barriers to participation
- Policy context
- Community Led Tourism recommendation

Noirín Uí Mhaoldomhnaigh provided the Committee with further information on the Blueway Project and Tourism promotion on Arranmore and the necessity to incentivise entrepreneurship on Islands.

The representatives from CXEI and Comhar na nOileáin agreed with the request from William Boyle to include Owey island within the feasibility study.

Members unanimously praised the Blueway Initiative and all those involved in progressing the project to date.

Cllr. Mac Giolla Easbuig proposed that Council Staff and Members convene a further meeting in relation to Blueways.

## IC 03/23 Arranmore Island

Noirín Uí Mhaoldomhnaigh commended the high standard of roadworks on the Island and requested assistance from the Council on the following items:

- Road projects at Upper Leabgarrow to Stacamór Pier, Cloghcorr and Ballard to Loch na Muc.
- Provision of a barrier on the Lighthouse road.
- Provision of plastic recycling facilities.
- Repairs to deck of both Aphort Pier and Polawaddy slipway.
- Extension of Aphort slipway.
- Repair of Stacamór pier and installation of crane.
- Upgrade of Aphort pier crane.
- Conversion of ferry pier crane from diesel to electric.

## IC 04/23 Tory Island

Marjorie Uí Chearbhall requested the assistance of the Council to progress projects as follows:

- Magheroarty pier study.
- Completion of helipad surface.
- Repair of steps to facilitate safe access to the ferry.
- Confirmation regarding service/department with responsibility for coastal protection / sea wall.
- Upgrade to playground.
- Relocation of storage containers.
- Provision of shelter for ferry passengers.
- Provision of fence around recycling centre.

Cllr. Mac Giolla Easbuig expressed disappointment that there has been no development regarding the provision of a new boat for Tory Island and also highlighted concerns regarding issues pertaining to the Magheroarty toilet facility within the Údarás building.

Cllr. Ó Fearraigh repeated previous requests for an upgrade and provision of an adequate Fire Service on Tory Island. He also requested the tarring of the Car Park at Magheroarty.

Cllr. McClafferty requested the Council to seek a meeting with the relevant Minister regarding the provision of a coastal protection wall and also highlighted the necessity for toilet facilities on all Islands.

# IC 05/23 Gola Island

Eddie Joe Mc Gee requested Council Services to incorporate the following items into their workplans:

- Provision of public convenience
- Port a Chruinn pier works
- Provision of additional fire extinguishers
- Repair of water pipe
- Repair of road to the back of the Island.

Mairín Uí Fhearraigh requested the repair of the electronic counter on the pier.

## IC 06/23 Owey Island

William Boyle expressed frustration that the provision of lighting and repair of railings on the pier remain outstanding.

The Marine Engineer undertook to expedite both the above issues as a matter of urgency.

## IC 07/23 Rutland Island

Laird Dinsmore highlighted the absence of running water on the Island and the negative impact on development/repopulation. He also recommended the implementation of an Emergency Evacuation Scheme and associated contact numbers.

Cllr. Mac Giolla Easbuig stated that substantial monies have been invested in a pier on Rutland and requested details regarding claims of private ownership.

# IC 08/23 Small Islands

Máirín Uí Fhearraigh requested assistance from the Council on the following issues:

- Village Renewal Schemes and repair to old houses.
- Repair of roads on Inis Caorach.
- Status of crane on Inisboffin.
- Provision of ring buoys at Kitty Archie's Pier.
- Provision of swim shelter at Magheragallon and Gola Piers.
- Update on status of National Islands Strategy.
- Offshore Wind Project update.

The Committee recommended the availability of a barge / small ferry to facilitate the transportation of goods to the small islands a couple of times per year.

# IC 09/23 Masterplan

Cllr. Mac Giolla Easbuig requested the Council to liaise with An Roinn, Údarás and Island Co-ops to commence a Masterplan for sustainable Development on Arranmore and at Magheroarty.

# IC 10/23 Priority Projects

On the proposal of Cllr. Gallagher, seconded by Cllr. Molloy, the Committee recommended the preparation of a prioritised list of all Island Projects and the circulation of status updates in advance of Island Meetings. The Director undertook to arrange preparation of this list.

# IC 11/23 Road Service

The Roads Engineer informed the Committee that a grant allocation of €100,000 has been allocated to Donegal County Council for Local Improvement Schemes on Islands. He further advised that the Local Improvement Scheme is open for receipt of applications throughout the year. The Roads Engineer acknowledged the receipt of submission of Island Road Projects and undertook to compare

same with the Island's Policy. Seamus Rodgers requested the Council to take over the Doctor's Road on Arranmore.

# IC 12/23 Marine Service

The Committee noted the Report circulated at the meeting and presented by the Marine Engineer regarding the status of Marine works throughout the County.

# IC 13/23 Any other Business

Seamus Rodgers paid a warm tribute to Cllr. Ian McGarvey following his recent retirement.

Seamus Rodgers also expressed condolences to Cllr. Ó Fearraigh following a recent family bereavement.

The Committee expressed their sympathy to John McCafferty, Arranmore Representative following the passing of his sister.

Seamus Rodgers commended the charitable achievements of Paddy Connaghan from Arranmore who won the World Open Water Swimming Association Man of the Year Award.
