Cllr. John O'Donnell

- 2) Calling on this Council to investigate the sharp corner at the Isle of Roy Crossroads in Downings due a high number of accidents at this corner.
- 3) Calling on this Council to install a speed ramp and street light at the start of Coppers Road Milford to slow traffic and also light this area up at night.
- 4) Calling on this Council to prioritise funding for the Old Abbey Graveyard in Kilmacrennan.

- 5) Calling on the Council to repair the footpath outside number 9 Lower Ard O'Donnell.
- 6) That the council provide a pedestrian crossing at the Ark Medical Centre to the Community Centre.

- 7) That extra safety signage be placed on the "High Glen Road" from Drummond National School to The Diamond in Ballyare warning of junction ahead, just before the junction at the diamond as the exit is on a crest and traffic who are unfamiliar with this area are in danger of exiting onto the road without realising the junction exists.
- 8) That the Council investigates an issue in front of 260 and 261 Bridgend Ramelton where during periods of heavy rain either due to an underground spring or a blocked drain, water is coming through the tarmac and running down to the main road. This has not only damaged the tarmac in the area but in periods of cold weather is turning into Black ice which is providing a potential hazard for pedestrians and motorists.
- 9) That this Council undertakes work to clean up the area around the lane from the Port Road to the Boxing Club in Letterkenny including the steps and surrounding area.
