Cllr. Ciaran Brogan

- 2) That this Council bring forward a report on their plans for the now Council owned buildings (former IDA) regarding future use of these units.

Cllr. Gerry McMonagle

- 3) That our Roads Section as a matter of urgency reviews the current lay out of the Crossroads Junction at Killyclug and take whatever steps are necessary to improve the safety of the Junction.
- 4) That our Roads section carry out an inspection of the walkway and footpath connecting the High Road via John Mc Laughlin Way and RCC with the Port Road with a view to cleaning and tidying the route to make it more attractive for pedestrians to use.
- 5) That our Housing/Roads section carry out an inspection of the road gullies at the car park in front of houses 1 - 5 Abbey Park and take whatever steps are necessary to clear them and prevent the ongoing flooding of the Carpark.

- 6) That the Council provide further public lighting on the Glencar Road.
- 7) That the Council investigate the flooding of some gardens in the Fairways estate in Letterkenny.
- 8) That the Council again consider safety measures at the Killyclug-Killylastin Crossroads.

- 9) That the Engineer deals with a dangerous Junction at Mc Adoos on the Fanannoughan / Ray/ Drumherrive Road.
- 10) That this Municipal District by all means available to them investigate the possibility of providing a Major Hospital in the North West to deal with the ongoing deficit for Medical Procedures.
- 11) That our Marine Section deals with the subsidence that has happened at The Quay, Ramelton.

- 12) That this Council ensures that the housing estates in Oldtown, Leck, Lismonaghan and on the Rahan Road be included in the plans for the extension of the Town Bus routes.
- 13) That this Council seek extra funding to increase the number of staff on the ground in the Housing Maintenance Section in this Municipal District.
- 14) That this Council liaise with the Gardaí and the residents and the business people who live along the road from the Snug Bar to Fr. Mc Loone Terrace regarding safety measures and in particular excessive speeding.

Cllr. Michael McBride

- 15) That Donegal County Council issue a statement as a matter of urgency detailing the current status of the proposed MICA scheme and advise all MICA homeowners who have been approved for remedial works or full rebuilds when they can expect to recoup the money they paid for tests on their homes and when will Donegal County Council be in a position to commence the payment of rent allowance so desperate families can start planning their futures. It is important that all timelines and proposed timelines are included.
- 16) That Donegal County Council investigate all possible flood mitigation solutions for the River Swilly and cost the preferred option so the town of Letterkenny is not stripped of valuable development lands which are in close proximity to the town centre and the campus of Letterkenny IT (soon to be part of the Atlantic Technological University) as a matter of urgency.

- 17) That the junction (crossroads) that lies between the Swilly Inn Bar and Manor Motors on the main road from Newtowncunningham to Manorcunningham have the lighting upgraded as this junction is very dark and has had many accidents in recent years. This junction is also used as a drop off and collection point for school buses and a proper bus stop should be considered for this junction which would enhance the safety of all road users.

- 18) That this Council address the major safety concerns at Educate Together National School Kilty as a matter of urgency please. i.e. the lack of safety signage.
- 19) That this Council engage with Irish Water to have the ongoing issue of un drinkable bad quality water resolved for the residents of Leitir Beag Crievesmith Letterkenny please.
- 20) That this Council address the issue of poor lighting from Glencar Roundabout up towards Chestnut Grove area please.
