- 2) That we include the upgrade to the footpaths at Dr McGinley Road Estate on our Three-Year Footpath Programme as they are in need of repair.
- 3) That our Housing Section revisit and complete the remedial works agreed for Fairgreen Hill including the completion of the Green area, fixing of fencing and walls in the estate and upkeep of the general appearance of the empty houses in the estate.
