TRANSBOUNDARY NOTIFICATION PUBLIC NOTICE.

(In accordance with Article 132 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001
(as amended))

Further Environmental Information has been received by Donegal County Council from the Department for Infrastructure, Northern Ireland in relation to the following proposed development: the A5 Western Transport Corridor (A5WTC), Co. Tyrone, Northern Ireland which is subject to environmental impact assessment and appropriate assessment and has potential Transboundary effects. The Further Environmental Information received consists of:

- An Environmental Statement Addendum (ESA 2019) and accompanying Non-Technical Summary (NTS Rev'B) Revised Non-Technical Summary, and
- Report of Information to Inform an Appropriate Assessment Special Area of Conservation (SAC) Watercourses covering: River Foyle & Tributaries SAC, Owenkillew River SAC and River Finn SAC,
- Report of Information to Inform an Appropriate Assessment covering Tully Bog SAC,
- Report of Information to Inform an Appropriate Assessment Special Protection Areas (SPA's) covering: Lough Foyle SPA, Lough Swilly SPA, and Lough Neagh & Lough Beg SPA, and
- Report of Information to Inform an Appropriate Assessment Ramsar Sites covering: Lough Foyle Ramsar Site and Lough Neagh & Lough Beg Ramsar site.

The development:

Proposal: The general effect of the project will be to construct 85 kilometres of new trunk road from just south of Derry at New Buildings, passing through Strabane and close to Newtownstewart, Omagh, Ballygawley and Aughnacloy.

Location: County Tyrone, Northern Ireland.
