Wear proper steel-toed footwear covered by "Yak Tracks". Always grit where you are working first. Where practicable reverse up a hill and operators to work above the vehicle. Operators to be aware of on coming traffic and to stand in a safe place to allow vehicles past. Ensure an experienced operator drive all plant and machinery in the snow.
