<b>Development Summary</b>	<p>Donegal County Council proposes to widen and improve the alignment of the R263 &amp; L-1195 roads between the Towns of Kilcar &amp; Carrick. The priority of the junction between the R263 &amp; L-1195 will also change based on traffic count validation.</p> <p>Mainline improvements will commence approximately 300m south of the L-1165 junction with the R263 along the L-1195. Side road improvements of the R263 will commence approximately 270m south of the existing R263 junction with the L-1195 along the R263 leading to Kilcar village. An offline culvert / bridge replacement will also be constructed to replace Cashleens bridge.</p>
