CONDITIONS OF ROAD CLOSURE

1. Applications shall be made **in writing to Donegal County Council, Roads Central, County House, Lifford, Co. Donegal** , a minimum of six weeks prior to the proposed closure date , to allow for processing of applications.
2. The applicant must complete all sections of the application form in full.
3. A map of the proposed road closure area to be submitted with the application form.
4. A copy of the applicants public liability insurance policy, to the value of 6.5million minimum, to be submitted with the application, indemnifying Donegal County Council against all claims, proceedings, liabilities, losses or expenses of whatever nature, however arising, in connection with the road closure for the period and times during which the road closure is in place.
5. Donegal County Council, before temporarily closing a road must give **at least two weeks notice** of its intention to do so in one or more newspapers circulating in the area.
6. A minimum of **three days** must be allowed for receipt of objections to the proposed road closure
7. A further Final Notice , giving details of the road closure and alternative routes must be inserted in a local newspaper **at least seven days** in advance of the road closure.
8. A copy of the Final Notice , with any conditions imposed, will be forwarded to the applicant **at least seven days** prior to the date of the road closure.
9. Donegal County Council's advertising costs relating to both Initial and Final Notices will be payable by the applicant prior to the event taking place .
10. Any breach of these conditions may result in the withdrawal of the Temporary Road Closure Approval.
